## Superhero/Super-villain Character Development Rubric

Students must determine a social issue they want to address (can be real or made up), e.g. global warming or bullying. They must develop two characters, a super-villain and superhero. The super-villain creates the societal problem. The superhero saves the world from the societal problem.

They then complete the compare-contrast online map. The students must come up with 3 (three) ways these characters are alike, i.e., things they have in common. They must come up with 4 (four) aspects of their characters that set them apart, i.e., their differences.

Students will turn in a printed copy of the compare-contrast online map, a paragraph explaining the social issue they are addressing, and make a drawing of their characters or their characters' logos. (The paragraph and drawing can be on the same sheet.) Each student will present to the class.
