


























The Old Way of Thinking


The Massacre at Wounded Knee



YEARS OF WAR AND GOVERNMENT SUPPRESSION DECIMATED THE REMAINING INDIANS OF THE WEST. THE BUFFALO, ON WHICH THEIR FOOD, SHELTER, AND EVEN RELIGION DEPENDED, SUFFERED THE SAME FATE, DECLINING FROM 60 MILLION TO FEWER THAN 100 BY 1889. MOURNING THE DEMISE OF THEIR PEOPLE, THE THEFT OF THEIR LANDS, AND THE DESTRUCTION OF THEIR WAY OF LIFE, THE INDIANS TURNED TO A NEW

SPIRITUAL MOVEMENT: THE **GHOST DANCE**, A BLEND OF INDIAN MYSTICISM AND CHRISTIANITY TAUGHT BY THE PAIUTE HOLY MAN **WOVOKA**. THE SIOUX ADOPTED THE RITUAL, WHICH PROMISED TO RESURRECT ALL THE INDIANS AND BUFFALO SLAIN BY THE WHITE INVADER. THE EARTH, THEY BELIEVED, WOULD BE DESTROYED AND RE-CREATED, THE WHITE MAN WOULD BE NO MORE, AND THE INDIANS WOULD REIGN ONCE AGAIN.
















































J. P. MORGAN

...THE SON OF A BANKER, SOLD RAILROAD STOCKS FOR GOOD COMMISSIONS. DURING THE CIVIL WAR HE BOUGHT 5,000 RIFLES FOR \$3.50 EACH FROM AN ARMY ARSENAL, THEN SOLD THEM TO A GENERAL IN THE FIELD FOR \$22 EACH. BY 1900, J. P. MORGAN CONTROLLED 100,000 MILES OF RAILROAD, HALF THE TRACK IN THE COUNTRY.



JOHN D. ROCKEFELLER

...STARTED AS A BOOKKEEPER IN CLEVELAND AND BOUGHT HIS FIRST OIL REFINERY IN 1862. BY 1870, HE SET UP STANDARD OIL OF OHIO AND MADE SECRET DEALS TO SHIP HIS OIL ON RAILROADS THAT GAVE HIM DISCOUNTS. IT DROVE HIS COMPETITORS OUT OF BUSINESS. BY 1899, HIS FORTUNE WAS ESTIMATED AT \$200 MILLION



JAY GOULD

...BORN POOR, BECAME ONE OF THE RICHEST AND MOST HATED MEN IN AMERICA THROUGH STOCK MANIPULATION, SPECULATION, BRIBERY, AND A STRANGLEHOLD ON SOUTHWESTERN RAILROADS. HIS STRIKEBREAKING LED TO THE 1886 DEMISE OF THE KNIGHTS OF LABOR. HE BOASTED: "I CAN HIRE ONE-HALF OF THE WORKING CLASS TO KILL THE OTHER HALF."

























The Pullman Strike



GEORGE PULLMAN TRIED TO SOLVE HIS LABOR PROBLEMS BY BUILDING A COMPANY TOWN OUTSIDE CHICAGO THAT HE NAMED AFTER HIMSELF. HE CHARGED HIGH RENTS AND CONTROLLED EVERY ASPECT OF HIS WORKERS' LIVES. HE CALLED THEM "MY CHILDREN." IT WAS A VERSION OF THE INDIAN RESERVATION SYSTEM. ON MAY 11, 1894, CHICAGO WORKERS OF THE PULLMAN PALACE CAR COMPANY STRUCK TO PROTEST WAGE CUTS AND THE FIRING OF UNION REPRESENTATIVES.













EUGENE VICTOR DEBS WAS THE YOUNG LEADER OF THE AMERICAN RAILWAY UNION (A.R.U.).





THE SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR

IN THE LATE 1890S, CUBA WAS A HOTBED OF REBELLION, AS POOR BLACK PEASANTS JOINED WEALTHY NATIVE-BORN WHITES TO LIBERATE THE CARIBBEAN ISLAND FROM THE GRIP OF FOUR CENTURIES OF SPANISH OCCUPATION. IT WAS AN UNEASY ALLIANCE, FREED FROM THE SHACKLES OF SLAVERY BUT NOT RACISM OR EXPLOITATION, BLACKS SAW A FREE CUBA, CUBA LIBRE, AS THEIR PATH TO EQUALITY. REVOLUTIONARY WHITES FEARED A TAKEOVER BY THE BLACK MAJORITY BUT KNEW THAT INDEPENDENCE COULD NOT BE WON WITHOUT THEM.




THE WAR ENDED WITH AN 1878 CEASE-FIRE. SPAIN RETAINED CONTROL OF CUBA. THOUGH SLAVERY WAS OFFICIALLY ABOLISHED IN 1886, LITTLE CHANGED FOR BLACKS.



IN THE U.S., PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR CUBA LIBRE WAS GROWING. THE DEMOCRATIC AND REPUBLICAN PARTIES DECLARED THEIR SUPPORT, BUT PRESIDENT GROVER CLEVELAND REFUSED TO AID THE REBELS.



WHEN WILLIAM MCKINLEY SUCCEEDED CLEVELAND, HE ALSO REFUSED TO OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZE THE INSURGENTS. LEGAL RECOGNITION WOULD HAVE ALLOWED THE U.S. TO GIVE THE REBELS AID WITHOUT SENDING IN AN ARMY. BUT HE FEARED IF THE REBELS WON THEY WOULD KEEP THE UNITED STATES OUT.



A YOUNG BRITISH OFFICER WROTE THAT SPANISH CRUELTY WAS LESS IMPORTANT THAN ANGLO-SAXON INTERESTS, WHICH REQUIRED THAT SPAIN KEEP CONTROL OF CUBA:





Death cast the shadow of his dark wings over the harbor Havana; the "Maine" sank; the nation wept, and the Journal mourns for the many poor fellows who perished with the ill-fated ship. Death in this form had not presented itself to the people in many years, so that when the evil tidings of the catastrophe came it cast a calamitous gloom over the land.

Men raved and women wept. Muttered curses "not loud but deep" were heard on every side. Spanish treachery, vengeance, retribution, were the subjects most in favor with the excited populace. Men thought awry. The great newspapers shrieked for war, for red, bloody war! The pulpit even advocated the unleashing of the war dogs. All this because there had been a great and useless sacrifice of human life.

If it could have been proven in the first moments of the excitement that it was an accident, tears and sorrow would have been manifest just the same; but the great horror that came with the thought that it was no accident and ought not to have taken place, would have been absent.


The public was horrified because it was unused to this particular form of horror. There are other forms that are just as horrible; where a hundred lives are sacrificed for every ten that went out of existence with the "Maine," but the horror has ceased to horrify, the public has grown used to the gruesome details and looks upon them with indifference and complacency.

The carnival of carnage that takes place every day, month and year in the realm of industry; the thousands of useful lives that are annually sacrificed to the Moloch of greed; the blood tribute paid by labor to capitalism, brings forth no shout for vengeance and reparation; no tear, except from the family and friends of the victims.

Trainmen and switchmen are murdered every day because of the non-equipment of the cars with a device that will reduce danger to life and limb to a minimum, and capitalism has been granted another two years to carry on the massacre. Machinists and engineers, firemen and conductors, and all other branches of the railroad service sacrifice their percentage of life and limb to the same insatiable Gorgon. Limbless children come in troops every year from factory and mine because the machinery has no protective hand rail or boxing to keep the victims from danger. Tribute is levied on old age and infancy by the corporate greed that refuses to equip street cars with a fender attachment. Death comes in thousands of instances to mill and mine, claims his victims and no popular uproar is heard, although it has been proven a thousand times that the sacrifice could have been avoided if proper and known precautions had been used.

The Journal joins in the popular sorrow for the loss of the "Maine," and regrets that so many lives, which under natural conditions would be profitably employed, have been lost with the ship. And while expressing sorrow it also expresses the hope that the day will not be far distant when it will be popularly considered that to lose life by accident in productive and distributive industry is just as noble and heroic as to lose it by accident on board a man of war. That to lose life by being drowned like a rat in a mine is just as worthy as being drowned like a rat in the hold of an ironclad. That to lose a limb by an exploding shell is no more worthy of national consideration than to lose one in a rolling mill. That to be blown up by a torpedo creates no more sorrow in the unfortunate's family than to be blown up by a boiler. That one should not be the hero of an apotheosis while the other goes to Eternity unhonored and unsung.

ANGERED BY A SERIES OF MINE EXPLOSIONS AND THE FEUDAL CONDITIONS OF THE MINING CAMPS WHERE THEY LIVED, 11,000 MINERS WENT ON STRIKE. THEY SET UP TENT COLONIES AFTER THEY WERE EVICTED FROM THEIR COMPANY-OWNED HOVELS. THE LARGEST - IN LUDLOW, COLORADO - HOUSED 1,000 MINERS AND FAMILY MEMBERS.







MONTHS BEFORE PEARL HARBOR, PRESIDENT FRANKLIN ROOSEVELT MISLED THE PUBLIC ABOUT CONFRONTATIONS BETWEEN U.S. WARSHIPS AND GERMAN SUBMARINES, ASSERTING THAT THE SUBS HAD LAUNCHED UNPROVOKED ATTACKS.

IN FACT, THE U.S. HAD BEEN WAGING AN UNDECLARED WAR WITH GERMANY IN THE NORTH ATLANTIC. UNDER THE MARCH 1941 LEND-LEASE PROGRAM THE U.S. BECAME "AN ARSENAL OF DEMOCRACY" TO PROTECT BRITISH AND AMERICAN MILITARY SHIPMENTS TO RUSSIA AND BRITAIN - IN VIOLATION OF THE NEUTRALITY ACT.

THOMAS A. BAILEY, A HISTORIAN SYMPATHETIC TO F.D.R., WROTE THAT ROOSEVELT "REPEATEDLY DECEIVED THE AMERICAN PUBLIC... HE WAS LIKE THE PHYSICIAN WHO MUST TELL THE PATIENT LIES FOR THE PATIENT'S OWN GOOD."





ANTI-LYNCHING LAWS WERE FILIBUSTERED IN THE SENATE. NO WONDER BLACK AMERICANS, LOOKING AT ANTI-SEMITISM IN GERMANY THAT YEAR, DID NOT SEE THEIR OWN SITUATION AS MUCH DIFFERENT.

THE NEWSPAPER LIED. E.H. HURST, A WHITE STATE LEGISLATOR AND LEE'S NEIGHBOR, HAD ASKED LEE TO MEET HIM AT A COTTON GIN TO TALK. INSTEAD, HURST GREETED LEE, A FATHER OF NINE, WITH A BULLET TO HIS BRAIN. AT TRIAL, HURST PLEADED SELF-DEFENSE; THE ALL-WHITE JURY ACQUITTED HIM.

IN THE 1970S, CONDITIONS ON THE PINE RIDGE RESERVATION WERE SQUALID.



THE PEOPLE OF PINE RIDGE TRIED TO OUST TRIBAL PRESIDENT DICKY WILSON, WHO RULED THE RESERVATION WITH AN IRON FIST. HE ABOLISHED ALL CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS AND WAS PROTECTED BY THE F.B.I. AND FEDERAL MARSHALS.

Your struggle for freedom and justice is our struggle. Our hearts are with you.


To the people of America: The delivery of these packages of food to the courageous people in Wounded Knee is being carried out by a number of Americans who have worked, and continue to work, to end American aggression in Indochina. We look on with horror and dismay as the U.S. government and President Nixon ignore the lessons of their failure in Vietnam and once again attempt to block the road to justice and self-determination for a freedom-loving people.

It is ironic that our actions are occurring during the concluding days of the Pentagon Papers trial in Los Angeles. Just as those Papers expose the lies and deception of our secret policies in Indochina, Wounded Knee exposes the treacherous treatment of the American Indian. The fight against these policies is becoming a fight against an unyielding and brutal government that makes the poor of the world the victims of its search for power and profit.


It is the responsibility of every patriotic American to contribute to the common goals of dignity and freedom. Our brothers and sisters at Wounded Knee have shown us once again that the poor in America become the strong and the just in struggle. Those of us in the anti-war movement have much to learn from them.

One lesson is to realize that the frustration and disillusionment we may at times feel are only the result of a misunderstanding of our real ability to affect the course of this country's policies. Wounded Knee shows us that no matter what the setbacks, just struggles are not stopped by any president or policy.

The buffaloes that gave life to the Sioux were killed by American rifles, just as the rice that gives life to the Vietnamese was destroyed by American chemicals and bombs. But the people of Indochina are moving steadily toward freedom and independence, and so too are the people who were the first Americans.
