

Vimwiki 1.1.1 Quick Reference

Open, convert or search wiki [normal and cmdline mode]

`\ww` / `n\ww` open index file of the main/*n*-th wiki
 :VimwikiIndex (for the current wiki)

`\wt` / `n\wt` open the main/*n*-th index file in a *n* tab
 :VimwikiTabIndex (for the current wiki)

`\ws` list and select from available wikis
 :VimwikiUISelect

:Vimwiki2HTML convert current page to HTML

:VimwikiAll2HTML convert all pages to HTML

:VWS /*pattern*/ search current wiki
 :VimwikiSearch /*pattern*/

Follow or modify wiki links [normal and cmdline mode]

`Enter` follow (or create) wiki link
 :VimwikiFollowLink

`Shift+Enter` / `Ctrl+Enter` split/vert. split and follow
 :VimwikiSplitLink / :VimwikiVSplitLink

`Backspace` go back to the previous wiki link
 :VimwikiGoBackLink

`Tab` / `Shift+Tab` find next/previous link
 :VimwikiNextLink / :VimwikiPrevLink

`\wd` / `\wr` delete/rename the current wiki page
 :VimwikiDeleteLink / :VimwikiRenameLink

Headers, lists, tables, diary [normal and cmdline mode]

`=` / `-` increase/decrease header level

`Ctrl+Space` toggle a todo-list item on/off
 :VimwikiToggleListItem

:VimwikiGenerateLinks .insert all available links here

:VimwikiTable *cols rows* create table

`gqq` / `gww` align table

`Alt+Left` / `Alt+Right` shift column left/right
 :VimwikiTableMoveColumnLeft / ... Right

`\w\w` / `n\w\w` . open today's diary page for main/*n*-th wiki
 :VimwikiMakeDiaryNote (for the current wiki)

`\w\t` / `n\w\t` ... open today's diary in a tab/*n*-th wiki
 :VimwikiTabMakeDiaryNote (for the current wiki)

`Ctrl+Down` / `Ctrl+Up` .. open next/previous day's diary
 :VimwikiDiaryNextDay / :VimwikiDiaryPrevDay

Text styles [inline]

`*text*` bold **text**

`_text_` italic *text*

`~~text~~` strikethrough ~~text~~

`,,sub,,text^super^` sub_{text}^{super}

``code`` monospaced code

Headings and breaks [inline]

`= text =` header level 1

`== text ==` header level 2

`:`

`==== text ====` header level 6

..... (*empty_line*) paragraph break

`
` line break

`----` horizontal line

Lists, tables, quotations and code blocks [multiline]

`* item` bulleted list

`- item` bulleted list

`# item` numbered list

`term:: definition` definition list

`|text|text|...|text|` table row

`|---+---+---|` table header separator

`<!-- text -->` comment, not shown in HTML

`text` (*four_spaces*) block of quoted text

`{{ code code ...code }}` block of code

Internal links, external links and images [inline]

`TextText` WikiWord link

`!TextText` not a WikiWord link

`[[Text text]]` link with an arbitrary name

`[[Text| Desc]] / [[Text][Desc]]` ... with descr.

`[[file:///C:/book.pdf]]` link to a local file

`http://abc.org/page.html` plain link to a URL

`[http://.../hp.htm My Home Page]` ... with descr.

`[[images/pic.png]]` local image

`URL/pic.jpg / [[URL/pic.jpg]]` . external image

`[[URL/pic.jpg| desc]]` image with description

`[[URL/pic.jpg| comment|]]` with alternate text

`[[URL/pic.jpg| text|width:150px;]]` with alt. text and size

`[[URL/pic.jpg| height:120px;]]` without alternate text

`[URL/pic.jpg URL/thumb.jpg]` thumbnail link

`[[URL/pic.jpg| URL/thumb.jpg]]` thumbnail link

Placeholders affecting HTML output [inline]

`%toc Text` table of contents with optional title

`%title Text` use this title instead of the filename

`%nohtml` do not convert to HTML

Folding, text objects and operators [normal mode]

`zo` / `zc` / `[z` / `]z` .. open/close current fold/go to start/end

`zR` / `zM` / `zr` open/close all folds/reduce by one level

`ah` / `ih` . a section segment with/without trailing empty lines

`a\` / `i\` a cell/inner cell in a table

`ac` / `ic` a column/inner column in a table

`vah` / `yah` / `cah` / `dah` .select/yank/change/delete section

let g:vimwiki_folding=0/1 ..... folding disabled/enabled
let g:vimwiki_camel_case=0/1 .. WikiWord auto-links off/on
let g:vimwiki_table_auto_fmt=0/1 .table auto-format off/on
let g:vimwiki_html_header_numbering=0/1/2
    .. numbering of headers in HTML off/on from level 1/on from level 2
let g:vimwiki_file_exts='ext1,...' ..... recognized
    extensions of local file links: pdf,txt,doc,rtf,xls,php,zip,rar,7z,html,gz
let g:vimwiki_valid_html_tags='tag1,...'
    .....recognized HTML tags: b,i,s,u,sub,sup,kbd,br,hr
Other g:vimwiki_opt with opt: hl_headers, hl_cb_checked, global_ext,
