
COLD READING THE FUTURE WITH NUMEROLOGY

INTRODUCTION

"Will I be happy?"

"Will my job change work out?"

"What will the next twelve months be like?"

"Will my marriage last?"

Every reader gets asked questions like these all of the time. It's not surprising, as the reader is supposed to "see all, and know all". It's strange though, that there is very little available for the cold reader on how to predict the trends of their clients lives.

Of course, many readers simply say the first thing that comes into their heads. "Yes, your marriage will improve dramatically. By next May you and he will be blissfully happy." What happens the next time the client turns up for a reading? The reader will have no idea what he said last time and may completely contradict his previous reading. Consequently, it is essential to have some sort of system. This allows you to instantly know exactly what you told the sitter on the previous occasion, and to amplify and expand on what you said last time.

The system I use is Numerology, and in this book I'll explain exactly how I use it in my readings. Numerology is an extremely simple method of divination. It can claim with some justification to be the oldest form of divination, and it is still extremely popular today. In fact, I think it is becoming more and more popular all the time. It has certainly been a very useful weapon in my arsenal for more than twenty years.

The main advantage of numerology is that it is extremely easy to do. Unlike astrology you do not need to know the exact time of birth. All you need is the date of birth. In fact, you can tell a great deal simply from the day and month.

When doing a reading people do not mind giving you their date of birth. Consequently, I usually ask for it. When doing Chinese numerology (the tictactoe system outlined in *Quick Readings with Numerology*) it is essential for the client to give you their date of birth to enable you to construct the chart.

There are many methods available to divine the date of birth magically, if you wish, but none of these are particularly impressive to the client. After all, he or she knows that you know everything, so naturally you must know their date of birth. (If I am doing it magically, I'll use a combination of "Star Seeker" and the "Cycle of Squares" from Astrology for the Psychic Entertainer. Alternatively, if I am working in a party-type situation, I might ask the person's partner for the day and month of birth.) However, 99.9% of the time I'll simply ask for it.

Using numerology you can tell the person an astonishing amount about their future trends. The nice thing is that no professional numerologist will be able to disagree with your findings. Also, as you will hopefully be using cold reading lines as well, you will be able to give a much more vivid and interesting account than most numerologists.

Chapter One

THE BASIC INFORMATION

In numerology, there are eleven numbers - one up to nine, plus eleven and twenty-two. Eleven and twenty-two are known as Master numbers in numerology. If you believe in reincarnation, the presence of these Master numbers indicate that you are an "old soul". You have already learned the easy lessons and now, in this lifetime, you will face some of the more demanding ones.

Each number has a meaning. To make the following more interesting and relevant to you, work out your Life Path number before proceeding. In numerology your Life Path number represents your purpose in life. It is the sum total of your day, month and year of birth brought down to a single digit (or eleven or twenty-two). You work it out by creating a simple sum. We will use the example of someone born on July 12th, 1973.

Month 7
Day 12
Year 1973
1992 and 1+9+9+2 = 21, and 2+1=3. This person's Life Path is 3.

We create a sum every time as it is possible to lose Master numbers when we simply add across. For instance, someone born on February 29th, 1944 has a Life Path of 22.

Month 2 Day 29 Year 1944

 $\overline{1975}$ and 1+9+7+5-22 (and, as this is a Master number, it does not get reduced to a 4).

If we had not created a sum, but had simply added up the numbers in a row, we would have lost the Master number: 2 + 2+9 + 1+9+4+4 = 31, and 3+1 = 4.

Here are the basic meanings of each number:

ONE This is the number of individuation and independence. The person has to learn to stand on his or her own two feet and achieve something. People with this number as a main one often start out in life by being dependent, and gradually become more and more independent as they mature. They have leadership potential and usually end up in the "number one" position, perhaps running their own business or managing someone else's. They have strong personal needs that have to be met. They are inclined to be self-centered, though this is often concealed behind a screen of charm. The keyword is INDEPENDENCE and ATTAINMENT.

TWO This is the number of tact and diplomacy. People with this number are easy to get along with. They co-operate and harmonize well with others. They are inclined to be sensitive and are intuitive. They often act as the "power behind the throne". They can never be a good "number one", but they do an excellent job in the number two position. They are extremely sensitive to the feelings of others. They make wonderful friends, giving and receiving much friendship and love. The keyword is TACT and DIPLOMACY.

THREE This is the number of self-expression. These people need to express themselves in some sort of way, ideally creatively. They are light-heatted, carefree, frivolous and skim over the surface of things. They make charming and delightful companions, but often lack motivation. They are full of ideas, but very few of them are ever achieved. They have a definite talent with words. They are usually wonderful conversationalists, though this gift is sometimes also expressed by writing, acting or singing. The keyword is CREATIVE SELF-EXPRESSION.

FOUR This is the number of system and order. People with this number work slowly and steadily towards their goals. They are plodders, rather than whizkids. They need to work within the confines they find themselves in. They can establish and maintain system and order. They are conscientious, patient and willing to work hard. They are serious, honest and loyal. However, they are also rigid and dogmatic in their approach. The keyword is LIMITATION and SYSTEM AND ORDER.

FIVE This is the number of freedom and variety. People with this number need something exciting ahead of them all the time. They are versatile, restless, impatient and enjoy travel. They often have difficulty with routine tasks. These people never really grow up. They are enthusiastic, but get distracted very easily and end up trying to do twenty things at the same time. Once they find the right thing for them, and this is usually in their middle years, their progress can be astonishing. The keyword is CONSTRUCTIVE USE OF FREEDOM.

SIX This is the number of home and family responsibility. These people care for others, particularly people who are close to them (family, in a wide sense of the word). They are natural humanitarians and are good at balancing and defusing difficult situations. They often accept much more than their fair share of responsibility. They are loving, appreciative, generous and are always willing to help. They usually love children and relate well to them. Consequently, they make good teachers. The keyword is HOME AND FAMILY RESPONSIBILITY.

SEVEN This is the number of analysis and wisdom. These people are quiet, often shy, and like to look beyond the surface of things. They are good with 'the details of things, and are frequently interested in technology and spirituality. They grow in knowledge and wisdom all the way through life. They are a little bit "different" and this can make it hard for them to make friends easily or to fit into a group. The advantage of this is that it gives them access to unique solutions. They are introspective and reserved. The keyword is UNDERSTANDING and SPIRITUALITY.

EIGHT This is the number of money and finance. People with this number want to be involved in large scale undertakings, and they also want to receive their due financial reward. They will work long and hard to achieve their financial goals. Once they have reached these goals, they can then be very generous. These people are rigid and often stubborn. They are also ambitious, capable and confident. They have good business skills and keep their feet firmly on the ground. The keyword is MONEY and MATERIALISM.

NINE This is the number of the humanitarian. These people enjoy helping others. At times they may resent the fact that they always seem to be giving, yet get back very little in return. In time they realise that their greatest pleasure comes in giving without thought of any reward. They need to make sure that they do not get imposed upon by everyone and become other people's "door mats". They are idealistic, sensitive, refined and romantic. They are also creative and easily hurt by others. The keyword is HUMANITARIANISM.

ELEVEN This is the number of illumination and inspiration. People with this number have access to all sorts of high-level awarenesses that most of us do not receive. They are extremely capable and get wonderful ideas, but need to make sure that these ideas are practical. They are idealistic dreamers and seldom achieve more than a minute fraction of what they are capable of achieving. Everyone is aware of their superior capabilities, and often expect more than these people feel capable - or willing - to give. There is often a great deal of nervous tension associated with master numbers. The keyword is ILLUMINATION and INSPIRATION.

TWENTY-TWO This number is known as the Master Builder. These people have the awarenesses of the eleven, but also have the necessary practicality to carry the ideas out. They are extremely capable and have the opportunity to make their mark in life. They are practical and have an unusual approach to problems, often using lateral thinking to create unique solutions. They are often charismatic and have the ability to inspire and motivate others. They are usually at their peak fairly late in life. The pressures and nervous tension of a master number make it very difficult to achieve well early on in life. The keyword is MASTER BUILDER.

Practice working out the Master numbers of your friends and family. I am sure you will be surprised at how accurate they are.

Of course, knowing the Life Path number tells us something about our client, but doesn't help us penetrate the veil into the future. We will start on that in the next chapter.

Chapter Two

WHAT WILL NEXT YEAR BE LIKE?

As a reader you will be asked about the future all the time. People who come for readings have problems now. Naturally, they are more interested in the next few months, rather than what they will be doing ten years from now. Using numerology, we can very easily tell them about the trends of this year and next year. We can also give the trends of this month, or even tomorrow. This is information your clients want.

We determine the trends of the year by adding the day and month of their birth to the current year. Let's assume we are doing a reading for someone born on April 28th. In 1996 he will be in a 3 Personal Year. This is because:

Month 4
Day 28
Year (1996) 1996
2028 and 2+0+2+8= 12, and 1+2=3

Here is another example. Betty was born on July 17th. In the year 2000 she will be in an 8 Personal Year.

Month 7
Day 17
Year 2000
2024 and 2+0+2+4= 8

Each personal year takes on the general meaning of the number.

- 1 Personal Year. This is a year of new starts. You will have plenty of enthusiasm and energy. You are starting on a whole new cycle of experience. Anything you begin now will last for a long time. You may start twenty new things but will have enough energy and enthusiasm to carry them all along. There is the potential for an important change this year. This could relate to career or personal life. Whatever it is, this change will need to be initiated by you.
- 2 Personal Year. This is a consolidation year. This year all your different activities are brought back to more manageable proportions. It is a gentler year, 'but you will need patience. In a 1 Personal Year you can push and things will work for you., In a 2 Personal Year you need to be patient and allow matters sufficient time. Consequently, it is easy to get frustrated. Spend time with loved ones and also trust and act on your intuition. This is a good year for resolving longstanding difficulties.

- 3 Personal Year. This is a light-hearted, carefree year. It would be great if you could have the whole year off to play. It's unlikely that you'll be doing that, though, as there seem to be many pressures upon your time. All the same, your thoughts this year will be more on pleasant, fun activities, rather than hard work. It's a good year for making new friends and catching up with old ones. It's also a good year for creativity. Do some entertaining or be entertained.
- 4 Personal Year. This is a nose to the grindstone sort of year. It is a year of hard work, where you simply plod along. It's a particularly good year to set a specific goal, as by the end of the year you will have it. If you have no particular goal, it can be a year where you sink deeper and deeper into the mire. Recognise that this is a year of hard work. After a less serious year, you will be needing a challenge and this year provides it in full measure.
- 5 Personal Year. This is a year of change and variety. It would be wonderful if you could go on an overseas trip this year as that would provide the necessary stimulation and excitement you crave. If you are not doing anything as momentous as this, at least do something different. If there is something that you've always wanted to do, but have never quite got around to doing it, this is the perfect year to make it happen. Expect the unexpected, also. You may have someone call you and suggest you both do something really different. Seize these opportunities. If you are not doing something different or exciting this year, you'll feel very unsettled and not really know why.
- 6 Personal Year. This is a home and family year. It is the perfect year to get married in. It is also an excellent year for divorce! If relationships are going well, this year brings you closer and closer together. Naturally, if they are not going well, this year takes you further and further apart. You may find that people close to you will need extra help or advice this year. Be understanding and compassionate. You may find that you are not able to do all the things you want to do this year because of the needs of others. You will find it a pleasure to help others in this way.
- 7 Personal Year. This is a quieter, gentler year. You'll have time to smell the flowers as you go by. It is a year when you will want more time than usual by yourself to meditate and think about things. You may decide to carry on your education in some way, or you may perhaps experience some sort of spiritual insight. This is a non-materialistic year, and it brings its own special rewards. Let other people know when you are planning to spend time by yourself, so that they will understand.
- 8 Personal Year. This is the money year. This is the year you reap the rewards for the work you have put in over the last decade. Ensure that you have some financial goals this year. If you decide you want, say, a new car, you will find that by the end of the year you will have it, albeit at some cost. If you have no financial goals, you will still do okay, but nowhere near as well as you would have if you had taken the time to set them. This years favors all financial activities, good and bad. It is a good year to buy and sell, to invest. However, if you owe everyone in town money, this is the year they will try and collect. Make sure that you have a vacation during the year. People are often inclined

to overdo things in an 8 year, so it is important to have time off every now and again.

9 Personal Year. This is the completion year of a whole cycle of experience. Part of you will be looking back and part of you will be looking ahead, planning for the future. This year will be a pleasant one, but there will be odd melancholy moments as you will have to let go of things that have been around you for some time. It is never easy to let go, but it is necessary as it is making room for the new projects that lie ahead. During the year you will get all sorts of false leads as to where you want to go from here. However, in the last few months of this year it will become blindingly obvious as to where you want to go. You may wonder why you didn't think of it years ago, but these things happen when the timing is right, not always when you think the time is right. By the end of this year, you will have a clear idea of where you want to go and next year, in the 1 Personal Year, you'll be heading towards it. The 9 year is a year of planning, the 1 year is the year of action.

Isn't it amazing the amount of information that you can give people just from the day and month of their birth? All you really need to know are the keywords for the nine numbers. You will find that you will gradually be able to expand the length of these mini-readings as you do them. After doing these for a while you will be in the wonderful situation of knowing exactly what you told someone last time you saw him or her.

"Last time I saw you you were going through an unsettled time. It was a time of change and flux. However, I see that you are now in a more peaceful stage - etc."

Some numerologists call the Personal years "tides". Some years the tide comes in and everything goes your way. In other years the tide goes out and the year is either neutral or negative. The positive tides are: 1, 3, 5, 6 and 8. When you are in one of these years you should push forwards as far as you can. However, when the tide is out (2, 4, 7 and 9) you should be patient and wait until the tide comes back in. The tide goes out furthest in a 4 year, making this the most difficult year of all.

There is another major advantage in knowing people's day and month of birth. You automatically know their Horoscope sign. You can include a little bit of sun-sign astrology with the trends for the next twelve months and give a five-minute reading that will be remembered for a long time. It is easy to learn the dates of the twelve signs of astrology. Simply apply the birthdays of people you know to the different signs. You should be able to fill up half the signs this way. Then it is a simple matter of remembering the in between ones. I found doing this useful in another way as well. I now remember the birthdays of several friends, purely because I know their signs!

HOW ABOUT NEXT MONTH?

It is just as easy to determine individual months as it is years. All we do is add the person's Personal Year number to the number of the month and bring the result down to a single digit.

For instance, the person in our first example was born on April 28th and is enjoying a 3 Personal Year in 1996. In January 1996 he will be in a 4 Personal month (3 personal year + 1 month = 4). Likewise in November (the eleventh month), he will be in a 5 Personal month (3 + 1 + 1 = 5).

The Personal Months do not have as much power as the Personal Year. Their energies extend over a matter of weeks, rather than months. Consequently, we have to weigh up the relative strengths when giving a reading. If someone is in a 4 Personal Year and a 4 Personal Month, naturally things are going to be harder and more restrictive than when the same person is having a 3 Personal Month in the same year. The 3 would tend to lighten some of the heaviness of the 4.

It is interesting to note that in September the Personal Month is always the same as the Personal Year.

Let's follow our person through his 3 Personal Year.

"As January is a 4 Personal month you may find yourself feeling rather restricted, as if there was a large weight on your shoulders. This is only temporary, but you should take each day as it comes and make sure that you do the work that is necessary. If you put things off they may come back to haunt you later.

"February will be much easier (5 Personal month). There is a possibility of a change of some sort, probably instigated by your own efforts. Expect the unexpected, as well. There could be a number of surprises during the month. Do something different, ideally something you've wanted to do for a long time. Have a few days off if you can manage it.

"March seems to be a home and family month (6 Personal month). You may spend more time than usual at home, possibly beautifying your surroundings in some sort of way. It is a good month for family activities. You may find yourself giving advice to someone close. It should be a good month for ongoing relationships.

"April is a quieter, gentler month (7 Personal month). Although you will be spending some time with your friends (as it is, after all, a 3 year) you will also feel the need for time on your own to think about things. You might enjoy going for walks or researching in the library. It will be an enjoyable month, but is likely to be a bit quieter than usual.

"May will be your best financial month this year (8 Personal month). It is a good time to buy and spend. If you buy something, you'll pick it up for a good price, and, if you sell something you'll get a good price for it. It is likely to be a busy month at work, with a few pressures at times, but you will manage to make some forward progress. Fortunately, you won't overdo things (3 Personal year) and will take a bit of time out for play and relaxation.

"June will see you doing a bit of a reevaluation (9 Personal month). You'll be assessing your progress so far through the year, and possibly making a few changes. You may discard or let go of things that have outworn their use. You'll also be doing a bit of thinking about the future and making plans.

"July will be a progressive, forward moving month (1 Personal month). You'll probably be starting some new activities. This will be either work related or it may well be a new hobby or interest. You'll have plenty of energy and enthusiasm. It is a good month for anything new - and that means relationships, as well (this sentence is included only if the person appears to be unattached). Everything you do this month will be fun, and you'll be progressing as well.

"August is a good month for you, but you may feel a bit more sensitive than usual (2 Personal month). Expect a few delays and heightened feelings. Be patient and by the end of the month you will find yourself pretty much where you want to be. Trust your intuition. You'll be surprised at how your hunches pay off this month.

"September will be a particularly cheerful, happy and sociable month (3 Personal month in a 3 Personal year). Entertain or be entertained. Be a little bit extravagant and have a good time. Your thoughts will be more on pleasure than work this month, so you may need to force yourself to keep motivated at work.

"October will be a busy, demanding month (the second 4 Personal month this year). There are likely to be pressures on you. Take what opportunities you can to relax and socialize. It is a good month for a bit of exercise to release some of the stress and tension that might be around you. Work hard and you'll make good progress.

"November will be a varied, exciting month (the second 5 Personal month this year). You may get the opportunity to travel or have a few days off for vacation. You'll be meeting interesting people and doing things you normally don't. Make the most of this stimulating, exciting time.

"December brings a highly satisfying Christmas season to you (the second 6 Personal month this year). You'll enjoy choosing suitable gifts for the special people in your life, and you'll love being with them over the Christmas season. Make sure that your duties and obligations are all met and enjoy one of the happiest Christmases possible."

As you can see, once you know the keywords for the numbers it is not hard to come up with twelve month forecasts that will impress your clients.

You can even work out Personal days, if you wish. I occasionally do this, 'particularly when people want to know the best day to do something. I suggest that they:

Start anything on a 1 Personal day
Go shopping on a 1, 2 or 3 Personal day
Do something different or take a small gamble on a 5 Per sonal day

Get married or buy something for the home on a 6 Personal day Go to church or study on a 7 Personal day Make investments and pay bills on an 8 Personal day Make public appearances or give gifts on a 9 Personal day Finish projects on a 9 Personal day Bank money on any Personal day

Naturally, I also tell them that they can do anything on any day they choose. However, it will happen more easily if they do it on the right numerological day.

Many years ago I met a numerologist in New Delhi who even advised people on their personal hours! He would suggest they visit the dentist at a certain time, do their banking at another, and so on. He appeared to be doing very well, so there may well be a lucrative niche there for you!

SPIRITUAL DAYS

For some strange reason, people love being told about their Spiritual days. Maybe it's because it sounds religious, or perhaps they simply like having important days pointed out to them. Spiritual days are the positive, red letter days when your clients can move ahead and undertake important tasks, such as getting married, buying a house, travelling abroad and so on. We all have three or four spiritual days every month. I will use an example to explain the process.

1996 is a 1 + 9 + 9 + 6 = 25/7 Universal year.

On January 1st, 1996 the Spiritual day number is 9, as we add 1 (for January) + 1 (for the day) + 7 (for the Universal year). This means that January 2nd, 1996 must be a 1 Spiritual day as it immediately follows a 9 day. January 3rd is a 2 Spiritual day, the 4th a 3, and so on.

Three or four times every month the Spiritual day number will be the same as your clients' Life Path numbers. These are their Spiritual days. On these days the green lights are on and they can take action.


These Spiritual days can be very useful when you are giving a reading. Frequently, clients ask when they should perform a certain important action. If it really is important, the best day is their personal Spiritual day.

Chapter Three


THE PYRAMIDS

The pyramids (also often known as Pinnacles) allow you to give your clients a quick look at the trends of their whole life. All we need is their full date of birth. Let's assume that your client is born on March 12th, 1975.

We begin by drawing the pyramids:




We then insert the person's date of birth, reduced to single digits or Master numbers, beneath the three uprights supporting the large inside pyramid. In this case, we place the month (March, which is a 3) on the left hand side, the day (3, as 12 = 1+2 = 3) in the center, and the year (22, as 1975 = 1+9+7+5 = 22) on the right.



This gives us the basic numbers that we work from. We can complete the chart by doing some simple addition. This client was born on March 12th and consequently has a 3 month and a 3 day. By adding three and three we get six, and this number is placed at the top of the small pyramid which has 3 and 3 at the base. We now add the 3 and 22, which is at the base of the adjoining pyramid. This comes to 25, and you no longer need me to tell you that this reduces to a 7. The number 7 is placed at the top of this small pyramid.


We now have a 6 and a 7 at the top of the two small pyramids. We add these together, and bring them down to a single digit. This number (4 in this example) goes at the top of the center pyramid.

Finally, to complete this first stage, we add the number of the month to the number of the year (3 and 22 in this example) and place it at the top of the outer pyramid. You should end up with a diagram similar to this:



So far, we have not included anything to indicate length of time. We do this by subtracting the person's Life Path number from 36. In our example, the person has a Life Path of 1 (March 12th, 1975). 36 - 1 = 35. This is the age at which this person reaches maturity, numerologically speaking. The number 35 is placed at the top of the first pyramid.

Now we go in nine year cycles. By adding 9 to 35 we get 44. This is placed at the top of the adjoining pyramid. We add a further nine to reach 53 which is placed at the top of the inner pyramids. Another nine is added, giving us 62, which is placed at the top of the outer pyramid. Finally, we return to the base and add three more nines (giving us 71, 80 and 89) which are placed beside or below our original numbers.



We now have the trends of the person's life, and they can be interpreted using basic numerology.

The first stage of the person's life is from birth up until the first age recorded. (In this example, the age is 35.) In numerology, everyone reaches maturity between the ages of 27 and 35. The number they are heading towards (in our example it is 6) shows the area of the person's life that will be emphasized in these years. For the next nine years the number usually changes and this denotes a new area of the person's life that will be emphasized.

Here is a sample reading for our imaginary client:

"Numerologically, you reach maturity at the age of 35. This may sound surprising, but in numerology it takes people quite a while to get properly settled on the right path. From birth up to 35 you are heading towards a 6. This is the number of home and family, so it means that by the time you reach 35 you will be well settled, in a stable relationship, with a family. You may find early on in life that different responsibilities are put upon you as 6 is also the number of home and family responsibilities. It can also be a creative number, and if this applies to you, these could well be highly creative years.

"Between 35 and 44 you are heading towards a 7. This is a more serious number and indicates that you will be doing some learning in these years. This might be returning to school, or it may be night classes, reading or meditation. It could even indicate spiritual growth. Anyway, during these years you will feel the need to have a bit more time to yourself to follow these interests. It will be a quiet, pleasant, happy time and you will certainly be much wiser at 44 than you will be at 35.

"From 44 to 53 you are heading towards a 4. Four is the number of hard work, so there will be a challenge of some sort during these years. Round about the age of 44 you will decide to do something, and this thing, whatever it is, will take a great deal of time and effort. You will have achieved it by the age of 53 and will be able look back with quite a bit of pride and satisfaction at what you have achieved.

"From 53 to 62 you are heading towards a 7 again. This is another more serious stage in your life. It could mark a continuation of the study you did in your late thirties and early forties, or it might be something completely new. Whatever it is, you will take it very seriously and will be dedicated to learning as much as you can.

"Now we come to an interesting stage in your life. For the first time you gain the number 3, and this lasts for eighteen years, right up until you reach 80. Three is the light-hearted, frivolous, carefree number, so this period could well be the happiest stage in your whole life. Everything will have a certain lightness to it. You will be well-situated financially, you will be surrounded by good friends and enjoying as active a social life as you wish. They could also be highly creative years, as 3 is one of the creative numbers.

"Between 80 and 89 you are heading towards a Master number - 22. This means that you won't end up senile, as you will be achieving things that are important in terms of your whole life in these years. Now this chart does not indicate that you will live this long. It simply marks out periods of time. However, I hope you do manage to get into your eighties, as if you do, you will be doing something really worthwhile. Obviously, it won't be anything along the lines of what you are doing now. In fact, you may have no idea of what it is until you reach the age of 80. Whatever it is, it is something you'll take seriously and will take all the way to completion."

That is an example of a simple reading using the pyramids. I chose the person's date of birth deliberately as it shows two important things that you will come across from time to time.

Master numbers always give the opportunity for great progress. In this example it occurred very late in life. Naturally, it is best if it occurs in the middle years. When a Master number occurs in the growing up years it is always wasted. No child is capable of handling the nervous tension and powerful energies of an 11 or 22. Consequently, it is regarded as being a 2 or a 4. Remember that an 11 is also the number of day-dreaming, so there is no guarantee that the person will make use of it. However, a 22 is always used.

The other important thing is when a number repeats itself, giving the person 18 or more years of the same energy. This means that the lesson is not learned in the first nine years and has to be repeated. Not very good news if the number 4 (hard work) is repeated! In the above reading I regarded it as being positive. After all, 3 is a happy-go-lucky, carefree number. However, the real numerological reading for it would tend more towards the person's creativity. The person would have some sort of creative potential, but it takes eighteen years to make constructive use of it. As I want the readings to be positive I ignored this aspect of the meaning, mentioning creativity only as an aside.

Someone born on September 9th, 1971 would have a 9 on every pinnacle. This would appear to indicate a rather tragic, sad life, but this need not be the case. It all depends on how the person uses the numbers they have been given.

Just for Fun

At the Annual General Meeting of the Clairvoyants' Association, they read out the minutes of next year's meeting.

"How could you tell?"

I'm a great fortune-teller. My predictions have proved 100% accurate - 17% of the time.

[&]quot;The other night I looked at a lady's hand and one glance told me that she was going to be really lucky."

[&]quot;She had four aces."

[&]quot;I went to see a spiritualist last night."

[&]quot;Was he any good?"

[&]quot;Just medium."

Chapter Four

CYCLES OF EXPERIENCE

We lead our lives in cycles. The nine-year cycle of Personal years is an example of this. The Cycles of Experience come from our Life Path number. If your Life Path number is, for example, 5 you will lead your entire life in five year cycles making the ages of 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50 and 55 important in terms of your life. Likewise, if your Life Path number is 3, the ages of 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 21, 24, 27, 30 and 33 will be important. The sole exception to this is for people with a Life Path number of 1. Their important years occur every decade, making the ages of 10, 20, 30, 40, 50 and so on their experience years.

The most important years occur when the Life Path number is doubled up. For someone with a 3 Life Path, this would be at the age of 33. For a 5 Life Path person this would be at the age of 55.

In numerology four of the Life Path numbers create what are known as Power Cycles. These are 3, 5, 7 and 9. People on these Life Paths can progress successfully through the Cycles of Experience only if they follow the basic meaning of their number. For instance, people on a 3 Life Path can progress only if they engage in some form of self-expression. 5s need to make constructive use of freedom and welcome change. 7s need to meditate and grow in knowledge and wisdom. 9s must love and cooperate with others.

The cycle of the Life Path number goes even further than this. The person with a Life Path of 5, for instance, can find his or her important moments any time a five appears. This could be on the 5th, 10th, 15th, 20th, 25th or 30th of any month. It may be the 5th or 10th month of the year. This person would live happily in a house with a number that reduced to a 5.

1996 is a 7 Universal year. This means that people with a Life Path of 7 will find 1996 to be a year where everything subtly goes their way. Likewise, 1997 will be just as useful for people on an 8 Life Path.

The different cycles of experience can be very useful when giving a reading as they indicate times when the person's energies will be working for them, rather than against them.

Chapter Five

SERIOUSLY GETTING INTO THE FUTURE

So far we have covered how to determine the trends of a person's life by looking at the Personal Years and Personal Months. We have also looked at the Pyramids. Now we are going to have a much more in-depth look at the next five years of a person's life.

To do this we need to know the person's Essence. This describes the energies that are surrounding a person at any given period of time. To determine this we use the person's full name at birth. (In numerology it is believed that we choose our own name before we are born to receive the lessons that we need to learn in this incarnation. Any name change, such as marriage, nick-names, use of initials, etc. exert an "over-vibration" that has an effect on the person as long as he or she is using that particular form of the name.) In the example that follows, we will use an imaginary person called James William Harvey. As this was the name he was given at birth, we use that, rather than Jim, Jimmy, Bill, Harve, James W. Harvey, or any other name by which he may be known.

We need to turn the name at birth into numbers. This is done using a simple chart:

We place the consonants below the letters of the name and the vowels above. (This is because, in numerology, the vowels on their own are called the person's Soul Urge, and the consonants create the Personality number.) This is complicated slightly by the fact that "Y" is sometimes classed as a vowel. If it is not pronounced (as in "Kay", for instance) or acts as a vowel (as in "Lynda") it is classed as a vowel. However, when it is pronounced (as in "Yolande") it is classed as a consonant.

Here's an example:

We now add up the numbers above and below each name and reduce them to single digits (unless, of course, they total 11 or 22).

We will now make a brief detour as, from James' name we can immediately work out three of his numerological numbers: his Expression, Soul Urge and Personality.

His Expression number tells us what he is naturally good at. This number is the sum total of all of the numbers in his name, reduced to a single digit (unless, of course, it reduces at some stage to a Master number). In James' case, his Expression number is: 6 + 1 + 4 (the top row - vowels) + 6 + 6 + 3 (bottom row - consonants) = 26, and 2 + 6 = 8.

James' Expression number is an 8. This means that he would do well in some financial field. He might go into accounting, banking, insurance, or possibly run his own business. He will want to be involved in financial activities of different kinds.

His Soul Urge number comes from the vowels. 6 + 1 + 4 = 11. This represents James' inner nature. He sees himself as being idealistic and something of a visionary. He will have access to unique solutions and may sometimes surprise other people - and himself - with his ideas.

The final number - the Personality - is of much less importance. It shows how other people will see him when they first meet him. They will see James as being a loving, caring family man (as 6 + 6 + 3 = 15, and 1 + 5 = 6).

You now know the four most important numbers in numerology: the Life Path (from the full date of birth), Expression (entire name at birth), Soul Urge (all the vowels in the name at birth) and the Day (the day of the month of birth). There are several other numbers, such as the Personality, which have less importance. The four main numbers show the main energies in the person's life. He or she will strive to satisfy these.

Now, we had better give James a date of birth. How about April 6th, 1964. This means he turns 31 in 1995. His four main numbers are:

Life Path 21/3 Expression 26/8 Soul Urge 11 Birthday 6

For James to lead a happy and fulfilled life he somehow needs to satisfy each of these numbers. The Life Path is the most important as it represents his purpose in life. I give this a rating of 40%. His Expression represents his natural abilities

and has a rating of 30%. His Soul Urge represents his inner nature and is 20%. Finally, the day of the month he was born in is worth 10%.

I would say something like this to James:

"Your Life Path number of 3 shows that you have a need to express yourself in some way, ideally creatively. This could come about through singing, dancing, talking, writing - or in a variety of other ways. With most people it comes through talking. You'd be a natural in any career where your voice was used. Selling and teaching are two obvious examples.

"Your Expression number shows your natural abilities. Here we have an 8, the money number. You would be naturally good at dealing with large scale enterprises and have the potential to reap the financial rewards.

"Your Soul Urge represents your inner nature. You are a bit of a dreamer and have the potential to make your dreams come true. You can be overly idealistic, though, and you also need to ensure that your dreams are practical in the real world. There is always a bit of nervous tension around a Master number, which can be a nuisance at times. Incidentally, if you believe in reincarnation, the presence of a Master number indicates that you are an old soul. You have been here many times before, and have the opportunity to really progress a long way in this lifetime.

"Your Birthday number of 6 represents home and family. For you to be happy you need to be in the right relationship with a satisfying home and family life.

"You also need to somehow juggle these numbers as they do not all get on. For instance, the 3 of your Life Path often lacks motivation. However, this is partly offset by the rigidity and determination of your Expression. Also, the communication skills of the 3 can help you make money. That would be an excellent combination for a commission salesperson, for instance. The 3 and the 11 harmonize very well. The creativity of the 3 is enhanced by the inspiration and illumination of your Soul Urge. Your Life Path and Day numbers harmonize also. Both are creative numbers. You would do well dealing with things that you personally found to be attractive. Your Expression and Soul Urge do not get on. Your Expression is rigid and wants to make money. Your Soul Urge is not interested in that. It is more interested in idealistic or spiritual progress. You need to learn to somehow balance these opposing energies. Your Expression and Day numbers also clash. The 8 wants to be out making money, while the 6 wants to be at home looking after loved ones. Fortunately, your Soul Urge and Day numbers harmonize beautifully. The desire of your Day number to be responsible and care for others is enhanced by the idealism coming from your Soul Urge.

"Your numbers are also "stretched" as they range from 3 all the way up to 11. This means that it will take you quite a while to work out exactly what you want to do with your life. Once you find it though, your progress will be a joy to behold."

Isn't the amount of information you can give your clients from just four numbers amazing? And we haven't even started to tell him about his future!

To determine his future in more depth we fill in the chart shown here:

The first column is easy. We simply enter his age. I'm assuming that we are drawing up the chart after his birthday, so we place 31 in the top box of this column. As I usually look at the next five years, I also place, 32, 33, 34 and 35 under the 31.

We ignore the Transits and the Essence for the moment and go to the Personal Year. We already know that 1995 is a 7 Personal Year for James, so we place that in the top box of this column. I also fill in a total of five years in this column, so write down 8, 9, 1, 2 and 3 below the 7.

The Universal Year is what the world is doing. We are constructing this chart for 1995. The Universal Year for 1995 is 1+9+9+5=6. The world is having a 6 year in 1995. Consequently, I place 6 in this column and beneath it also write in 7, 8, 9, 1 and 2.

The year column is easy to fill in. I simply write 1995 in the top box and the next five years beneath it. However, if I had been drawing up James' chart before he had his birthday, I would have written 1994 in the top box as that is when he last had a birthday. (Naturally, I would also have written 30 in the top box of the age column, as in this instance he would still be 30.)

Now we come to the two long term cycles.

We have not covered the periods yet. Each of these cover 27 years. For the first 27 years of your life your long term period is the month you were born in James was born in April, so was in a 4 Period until he was 27. The next 27 years are covered by the day. In James' case, he was born on the 6th of the month, so we write 6 in each box in the Period column. The next 27 years (54 - 81) are covered by the year. James would be in a 2 Period if he reaches this age.

The Periods are very long-term cycles and have a rather general influence on the person's life. Between 27 and 54 James will be heavily involved in domestic

matters, probably married with children. He may well be active in the community as well.

Next, we come to the Pinnacles, although I usually call them pyramids, because of the shape of the chart which was covered in Chapter Three. James is under a 1 pyramid from birth up to 33. He is obviously learning how to stand on his own two feet and achieve a degree of independence in these years. From 34 to 42 he is heading towards an 8, so his fortunes will start to improve. He is likely to be working hard, but will also reap the rewards of his labor.

Consequently, we write the number 1 in the first three squares beneath the word "Pinnacle". I usually draw a line under the last one to signify that this stage is ending. In the next boxes we enter 8.

We have now done all of the chart except for the Transits and Essence. The Transits are derived from each individual word in the person's name. The first transit letter in our example comes from our subject's first name, "James". The Transit letters start from birth. In his first year of life, James had a Transit letter of "J". This is because the first letter of his name is "J". This number lasts for only one year as J has a numerological value of 1. The next year, his Transit letter was "A". Again, because it has a numerological value of 1, this Transit lasts for just one year. Then we come to the letter "M". This has a numerological value of 4, so it lasts for four years. It takes twelve years to cover all the letters in James' first name, and then we start the name all over again. This cycle repeats all the way through his life.

In practice I don't go through all the letters around and around. I simply look at the numbers above and below his name in my chart. I have a 6 above and a 6 below, totalling 12. I double that to reach 24. If I double it again I'll reach 36, which is older than James is, so that is too far. Using 24 as my starting number, I then go through his first name letter by letter. J is 25, A is 26, M is 27, 28, 29 and 30. E is 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35. The letter E actually covers all the years we are looking at in James' chart, so I write E in every box for the first Transit.

The second box in the row of Transit boxes is for James' second name: William. I add up the numbers above and below the name. In this case they are 19 and 15, which total 34. 34 is within the period I need, so I insert the letter "M" (the last letter in William) in the box adjacent to the age of 34. M has a numerological value of 4, so I can go backwards inserting the letter M in the ages 33, 32 and 31.

Now we have to start his second name all over again, and he has a "W" for five years. We are interested in just the first of those years, and insert the letter W adjacent to age 35.

Finally, we look at his surname. Coincidentally, the name "Harvey" adds up to 34, exactly the same as "William". This means we place a "Y" in the boxes representing ages 31, 32, 33 and 34. ("Y" is the last letter in the name "Harvey" and applies from ages 28 to 34.) We now start the surname again and place "H" in the final box for age 35.

Now, at long last, we can work out the Essence. This is a number derived from adding up the Transit letters and converting them to a single number (except of course for Master numbers).

At age 31, James has an Essence number of 7, as the three Essence letters (E, M) and Y) add up to 16 (E = 5, M = 4) and Y = 7), and this reduces to a 7. Rather than simply write in 7, I usually put it down as 16/7, as this tells me the numbers behind it.

In James' case his Essence does not change for four years. However, when he reaches 35 it changes to a 9 (E, W and H Transits: 5 + 5 + 8 = 18/9).

Our chart is now complete. It may look complicated, but you will find after drawing up a few charts for your family and friends that it is really extremely straight-forward. However, it looks impressive and this helps add value, in every sense of the word, to your reading.

Now, of course, we can interpret it.

"You have an interesting few years ahead of you, James. This year is a 7 Personal year. This is a quieter year than some others, but it is a year of considerable inner growth. You may feel the need for a bit of time by yourself to think about things. You might become interested in spiritual growth, or philosophy. It is compounded by the fact that your Essence number is also a 7. When two numbers are the same you would expect it to be twice as good. Unfortunately, it is usually the opposite. This means that this year you will have a desire for peace and quiet to develop inwardly, but may find it hard to get enough time. Fortunately, the Essence number stays the same for four years, so you will get the opportunity to grow inwardly, steadily growing in knowledge and wisdom, right through the next four years.

"Your long term cycles are 6 and 1. Six represents home and family responsibilities. Your Birthday is also on the 6th, so you will have responsibilities of this sort all the way through your life. This is not a bad thing, particularly as you enjoy being responsible for others. Six is also one of the creative numbers, making this period of your life an ideal one for developing any creative or artistic talents you may wish to pursue. The 1 Pinnacle has been there since you were born, and finally leaves between the ages of 33 and 34. 1 represents independence and attainment. It means that by the age of 33 you will be able to stand on your own two feet and achieve something worthwhile.

"1996 is an 8 Personal year for you, James. 8 is the money number, but it is also a year of hard work. This is the year where all the hard work you have put in over the last decade or so pays off. It is likely to be the best year financially you will have had for many years. I believe that we should all set goals for ourselves, but 95% of the world's population don't. Even if you don't normally set goals, this is the one year where you should set a specific financial goal for yourself. You may find the year hard, at times, but by the end of the year you will have achieved the goal. If you don't have a goal in mind, you'll still do all right financially, but will achieve only a minute fraction of what you could have. Make sure to have a few breaks during the year. I think you probably will

anyway, because of the strength of the 7 Essence. However, some people get so involved in the financial potential of an 8 year that they neglect to take some time off.

"1997 is a 9 Personal year. This is the end of a whole cycle of experience that began when you were born. A 9 year is a time of reevaluations. You'll be looking back and also looking ahead. It will be a pleasant year for the most part, but there will also be some odd melancholy moments. This is because you have to let go of things that have outworn their use. None of us like to let go of things, but it is essential that you do so this year to make room for all the new activities that start next year. During the year you will probably get all sorts of false leads. You might feel that you really want to do something, and then a week or two later no longer have any interest in it. In the last three months of the year it will probably become blindingly obvious to you what you really want to do, and in 1998 you'll be starting it.

"This is the start of a whole new cycle of experience in your life. You'll have more enthusiasm, more energy and much more zest for life in 1998. You'll feel as if you've finished climbing up a hill and are now on level ground. Also, you'll know what it is you want to do and you'll be doing it. You may start a dozen new ventures this year but you'll have more than enough stamina and enthusiasm to handle them all. It may sound funny, but in many ways your life starts in 1998.

"In 1999 you'll be in a 2 Personal year. This will be a gentler year than 1998. All of the expansion you did in the 1 year will be brought back to more manageable proportions. You won't be able to push ahead too much this year, though. The keyword for the year is 'patient waiting'. That's definitely an oxymoron. Most of us are anything but patient when we're held back and kept waiting. However, everything happens when the time is right, and you'll find by the end of the year that you are pretty much where you want to be. A 2 year is also an excellent year for close relationships. It is a good year to get married in or to start or maintain a close relationship. There is a sense of harmony and balance in the air, giving you the potential for a rich inner life.

"In this year your Essence changes from a 7 to a 9. This happens on your birthday, so two thirds of 1999 are covered by the 9. This is a humanitarian, caring number, so you are likely to find yourself spending at least part of the year in helping others in some sort of way. 9 is caring for people at large, so you may well be doing something really worthwhile in your local community. Whatever it is, you will derive a great deal of pleasure and satisfaction from it. You will find it highly rewarding in many ways.

"Finally, we reach the year 2000, which is your 3 Personal year. You have a 3 Life Path so you are a 3! This is your year! It is a year for fun and pleasure. Your thoughts will be on spending time with friends, entertaining, being entertained, enjoying pleasant activities, and so on. Make the most of it and thoroughly enjoy the year. It would be great if you could have the whole year off to play. It is unlikely that you'll do that, particularly as you have an 8 Pinnacle, but most of your thoughts will be on fun, rather than hard work.

"It could also be a highly creative time as well. You have significant potential creatively. There are three creative numbers - 3, 6 and 9 - and you have a 3 Life Path and a 6 Day of birth. In the year 2000, you are also enjoying a 3 year and have a 9 Essence. Consequently, the potential for creative achievement will be there, but whether you choose to do it - or not - is up to you.

"Make the most of the next five years. You may feel as if you are plodding uphill until 1998 begins, but then a whole new cycle of experience starts and all of your abilities will be at their peak. I am glad to be reading for you now, rather than a few years ago."

Naturally, if I was giving this information to a client it would be in the form of a conversation, rather than a monologue. If necessary, I'd ask questions to ensure that the other person participated. "Do you understand that?" "Do you have a creative hobby at present?" That sort of thing. The readings are easier to give, and are much more informative, when the other person actively participates. Fortunately, this is usually the case. After all, we are talking about the other person's future. They have asked for the reading, and are paying for it. It is very much to their advantage to ask questions and seek amplification on things that they do not fully understand.

Just for Fun

Prediction is difficult - particularly of the future.

What's a definition of a lucky coin? Any coin that still happens to be in my possession.

Did you hear about the South American Indians who worship the number zero? Is nothing sacred?

Chapter Six

THE LIFE CYCLE

Generally speaking, I find that five years into the future is quite enough for most people. Only very rarely will you come across anyone who wants to know further ahead than that. Most people want to hear about the next few months and want to know about the next few years only in very general terms.

When I was selling computerized horoscopes by mail order I always included two pages giving a month-by-month guide for the next year. This was done by numerology, rather than astrology. All I had to do was work out the person's Personal year and send out a copy of the trends for that particular number year.

When giving clairvoyancy readings on cassette I would frequently also give them the trends for the next twelve months. Many people commented favorably on this and it generated a large number of people who wanted a new reading at the start of every year. Originally, I used these month-by-month guides as a filler to use when people did not give me enough information to work with. However, they proved so popular that I started to include them with all of my mail order clairvoyancy readings.

I find knowledge of the monthly trends useful in doing one-on-one readings as well. It can be very dramatic to say in the middle of a rune stone, ogham, Tarot or some other kind of reading, "In October money matters will go your way." People remember how specific you were. I didn't say, "Money matters will improve during the next year" - I actually specified the month. This can be very powerful.

Here are the Personal months for a complete nine-year cycle. I have deliberately kept them a little bit upbeat in the style I used when giving the mail order readings. You will notice that I make no mention of numerology in these. I talk about numerology only when doing numerology readings. However, I am able to use this information in any kind of reading as long as I know the person's day and month of birth. As mentioned before, I usually simply ask for this information. It can be a very casual exchange that is quickly forgotten.

I might say, "When is your birthday?"

"June 14th."

"Oh, you're a Gemini!"

"That's right!"

"I like Geminis. They are such fun people to be around, always full of ideas and ready to give something a try."

Then I might introduce my rune sticks, my oghams, Tarot cards, or whatever and talk a bit about them. By the time I start on the actual reading my sitters will have forgotten that I know their date of birth. Even if they do remember, so what?

You can use these monthly forecasts in a variety of ways. You may print up yearly guides to give away as advertising material. If you do this, your clients will return year after year to receive the trends for the next twelve months.

You will find with practice that you will be able to create your own impromptu monthly guides that will enhance your readings. If you study the ones I have here you will see that they are all derived from the basic meanings of the nine numbers. Once you know these the quality of your readings will improve out of sight.

It also means that you will never run out of things to say. Every so often you will have a client who contributes nothing to the reading, but just sits there listening. Maybe they are testing you, or maybe they are naturally very quiet people. Maybe they're overawed with your amazing psychic gift. I used to find that when reading for these people I would have covered everything and still have twenty minutes left over. This never happens to me now. In that situation, I simply keep on talking and give them the trends for as many months as are required to fill up the time.

In practice, I don't think it matters if a sixty minute reading finishes in forty. However, I like to give value and feel better myself if I have given the person the full period of time.

You might find it interesting to start by reading the remarks for the Personal year you are in now and see just how closely it corresponds to what is going on in your life.

ONE PERSONAL YEAR

This is a good year for you to get motivated and get something underway. Don't expect too much help from others. Plan, consider and then make a move. Activity and forward progress are the keynotes of this year for you. There is the possibility of an important change during this year that will be initiated by your own efforts. You will be working on expanding your independence and exhibiting your individuality this year.

January provides a slow start to the year. Don't worry about it though. Your energy might be lower than usual, and your personal sensitivity will be high. Keep your cool and bide your time.

Chapter Seven

CONCLUSION

I hope you have been intrigued and interested enough to go out and buy some more books on numerology. It is a fascinating subject and has a long and interesting history. It can claim with some justification to be the oldest of the occult sciences. Legend has it that some four thousand years ago, Wu of Hsia was working on an irrigation scheme on the Yellow River in China. One day a large tortoise came out of the river. The design on the shell contained a perfect magic square. Wu and his colleagues were fascinated with this and began to study the implications of it. Eventually, numerology, Chinese astrology, the I Ching and feng-shui all developed from it. It spread around the world and was modernized and Westernized by Pythagoras some 2,500 years ago. (I explain the Chinese system of numerology in *Quick Readings with Numerology*.)

You will find that there are two main schools of numerology: the Chaldean and the Pythagorean. The system I use is the Pythagorean, and I have used it in this book. I feel it is much better to study one system as much as you can before looking at the other. If you look at them both together, you will end up being completely confused. For instance, in Pythagorean numerology A = 1, B = 2, C = 3, D = 4, E = 5, F = 6, G = 7, H = 8, and so on. In Chaldean numerology the letters are given different number values. A, B, C, D and E are the same, but F = 8, G = 3 and G = 3 and G = 4. Chaldean numerology does not use the number 9 in their name calculations. (Maybe that's one reason I don't use their system - both Richard and Webster add up to 9 in the Chaldean system.) It is interesting to explore the different systems - and there are several - but learn one properly before looking at the others. I recommend the Pythagorean system because I feel it is the most accurate and it is also the easiest to learn.

Here is the Chaldean alphabet:

As you can see, there is much more to memorize with the Chaldean system. Now you know why I prefer the Pythagorean system. I like to keep things as simple as possible.

In this book I have included all the ways that I use to predict the future with numerology. There are many other methods that you can find in other books on numerology. Over the years, I have experimented with as many of these as I could find. However, I found that they did not work for me or my clients. After playing with them for a while I dropped them and now use the methods described here.

Some of the more interesting methods I looked at are:

Numerology and the Divine Triangle by Faith Javane and Dusty Bunker. This contains an original system using Pythagoras' triangle. Each side of the triangle contains a square. One square covers from birth to the age of 27. The second triangle governs 27 to 54 and the final triangle covers 54 to 81. It is a fun system to construct, but sadly, the system did not work for me.

Dusty Bunker then wrote Numerology and Your Future which contains a system similar to what I have described here. She also includes a wave-like diagram to pinpoint action points in the personal year and month. I'd recommend any of Dusty Bunker's books because she experiments and publishes her findings. I don't agree with much of it but I find it fascinating to read.

Kevin Quinn Avery, in *The Numbers of Life* relates each letter of the person's name to an astrological element. The resulting numbers are then interpreted along with the pyramids. It is an interesting exercise and I include the table of numbers with the elements in case you wish to experiment with your own name.

Mr Avery mentions that he knows "several dozen good ways" to gain information about his clients' futures using the elements. (*The Numbers of Life*, page 166)

His book also includes two further methods of predicting the future. One of these involves using the Personal Year, Age, Letter Aura and the current pyramid. By adding all of these and reducing them to a single digit, you get an inkling of future trends. He claims that it is "not only informative, but also exact".

The second method involves adding the client's day and month of birth to the Personal year, and reducing the total to a single digit. This gives you added insight into the nature of the year.

For me, many of these systems simply prove that you can make numbers come up to any answer you want. I guess this could be useful for a magician. All he need do is make a prediction of any number and, after a suitable amount of adding and subtracting of the numbers in the volunteer's name and date of birth, prove that they total the number he predicted. Somehow, I don't think people who come for a reading would be very impressed.

This book is solely concerned with numerology. However, you can easily include snippets of numerology in any of your other readings. For instance, if you are using ESP cards use the excellent idea of Rudy Hunter's that was published in *Magick 413* (a bonus insert called *Quick-and-Easy Card*

Readings). This uses numerology in an extremely effective manner. Once you have the person's day and month of birth you can foretell the trends for the next twelve months in any "ology". I use oghams a great deal nowadays. They are still little known, but are growing in popularity. I believe they will become more and more common over the next ten years. At present they are still exotic, strange and - despite being two thousand years old - new. (My book, Omens, Oghams and Oracles explains how to do ogham readings. It is published by Llewellyn Publicationss, St. Paul, MN.) I can use numerology on any of the cards, as each card is numbered. However, I can also gaze intently at any single card or group of cards and give the trends for the next year. In Astrology for the Psychic Entertainer I described an astrological method of determining the trends in a person's life. This plays well by itself, but can be enhanced immeasurably by including the numerological trends for each month as well.

Your clients want help, advice, counsel and empathy. Give them this, along with some of the information in this book and you will help a large number of people. They will recommend you to others and send a steady stream of clients your way.

Just for Fun

BONUS EXTRA

When the conversation turns to numerology and numbers people often ask about "lucky" numbers. Consequently, many years ago I wrote a booklet called You and Your Lucky Numbers. I used to either sell this for a few dollars or give it away as a handout. After upgrading my computer I could no longer print it out and forgot all about it until starting on this book. Fortunately, I found a copy and include it here for you to use in any way you wish. As a buyer of this book I am giving you permission to reprint this report with your name on it as author.

If you are seeking work as a reader print some copies with your advertising material and give them away to your clients. Giving free talks is an excellent way to obtain clients for readings (and someone has written a book on that subject called, funnily enough, *How to make Money giving Free Talks*). Sell this report after your talks. If you price it correctly for your market, most will buy and then you will have your advertisement sitting in their home ready for the time they need a reading.

Barter is a great system. These reports cost cents to print, but you can exchange them for a variety of goods and services. Why wouldn't you exchange a copy for a hamburger or a tube of toothpaste? Not only do you get things that you want for a fraction of the retail price, but the recipient also receives a copy of your advertising material!

Finally, I guess you could use the information in the report and work out your lucky Lotto numbers. If you win, please remember who it was who enabled you to know these valuable numbers.

YOU AND YOUR LUCKY NUMBERS

Numerology is almost as old as man himself. The oldest piece of writing in existence is on the back of a tortoise shell in China, and is on Numerology. Pythagoras, a name you may remember from your school days, brought Numerology up to date 2,600 years ago! So it is a very old science.

Have you ever noticed how some numbers seem to follow you through life? You may have lived in a house numbered 24 for several years, but when you moved you moved into another 24. Many people say "5 is my lucky number", because nice things seem to happen when they use that particular number. That being the case, they certainly should stick to it.

The only problem here is that most people do not know what their lucky number is. This book is entirely on how to work out - and make use of - the numbers most likely to be lucky for you. So it is a practical handbook. I hope it may encourage you to look at Numerology more seriously, but even if you don't, you will find the information here extremely useful in your daily life.

YOUR MOST IMPORTANT NUMBER

This number is called your "Life Path" number in Numerology, and is by far the most important of the four main numbers. It is based on all the numbers in your date of birth. All you do is make a sum, like the illustration below, add it up and bring the final result down to a single digit.

Let's take someone born on the 9th December, 1946 as our example. We simply make up a sum of his day, month and year of birth and add it up. This gives us a total of 1967. We now add up the 1, 9, 6 and 7, which gives us a total of 23. Finally we add

the 2 and the 3 together which gives us a final total of 5. This person's most important number ("Life Path Number") is 5.

9 12 <u>1946</u> 1967 and 1+9+6+7=23, and 2+3=5

There are two exceptions to this rule, unfortunately. These occur whenever your total comes down to an 11 or a 22. These are known as Master Numbers in Numerology and give the person with them special capabilities. Each time you arrive at either 11 or 22, stop there and do not reduce it further. Here's an example:

29 2 1944 1975 and 1+9+7+5=<u>22</u>

My friend, born on a leap year (29th February, 1944) has a Life Path number of 22, so it does not get reduced to a 4.

Already you have all the information you need to work out the most important number relating to you, but before we go on I'll briefly explain the meanings of each number.

If your Life Path number is a 1, you have to learn to stand on your own two feet and achieve a degree of independence. This may not be easy early on in life, but is essential for your progress in this life.

If 2 is your most important number, you have to learn to cooperate and fit in to group situations. You will be tactful and diplomatic, and will be happier inside a partnership, such as marraige, rather than being entirely on your own.

3 is a fortunate number, as it is the number of self-expression. This means that you have to communicate in some sort of way possibly through singing, dancing, talking or writing. With this number you will be learning all the way through life, but may sometimes lack in motivation.

With a Life Path number of 4 you will have to work hard to achieve your goals. You will be well-organised and capable, but could feel hemmed in or restricted at times. 4 is the number that always gets there, but with a great deal of effort.

5 is the number of freedom and variety, so if this is your most important number, you will be versatile and capable at almost everything you attempt. However, this versatility may make it hard to work out what it is you really want to do in this life, so you could be something of a rolling stone, and a 'jack-of-all-trades'. The big advantage of this number is that it is the number of youth, so you will always be young at heart.

With a Life Path number of 6, home and family will be extremely important to you, and your greatest happiness and satisfactions in life will come with people close to you. At times you may be responsible for more than your fair share, but you will always be positive and ready to give a helping hand.

7 is the number of wisdom and knowledge. If this is your Life Path number, you will operate on a slightly different level to most people, which may make you feel apart from others at times. However, you will be growing and learning within, and will ultimately build up a strong faith in life.

8 can be a stubborn, rigid number, but is an extremely fortunate number to have as a lucky one, as it is the number of money. If this is your most important number you will have definite material needs, and will be prepared to work hard to achieve them. Once you have achieved your goals, you will be generous with your money, but it might be a bit hard to separate you from your money before that time!

With a Life Path number of 9, you will be a humanitarian at heart, always wanting to help others in need. This is a very giving number, and you will get great satisfaction out of helping others. However, you must remain aware of your own needs, so do not let others take advantage of your good nature.

11 is the first of the two Master Numbers. If this is your most, important number you will be good at coming up with ideas, but you must make sure that they are practical before trying to put them into practice. This is also the number of illusion and day-dreaming, so make sure that you do actually do something, rather than simply dreaming about all the great things you are going to do one day.

The final number is 22. With this as your Life Path number, you can literally achieve anything you set your mind upon. You should always aim high, as you could succeed on an international

level. This number is able to take parts from all the other numbers and really make things happen. Unfortunately, there is always a degree of nervous tension associated with 11 and 22, which can work against these people's best interests early on in life.

Now, how can we use this number?

Use this number any time you need a single number. If you are in a sweep at work, utilise your Life Path number. Remember, also, that you can use the multiples of it as well, as long as they are reducible to your main number. For instance, if your Life Path number was 5, you could also use 14, 23, 32, 41, 59, 68, 77, 86 and 95 as these all reduce down to 5. Naturally, you could go on almost indefinitely. 1967, as we saw earlier, reduces to a 5. With a Master number you can also go backwards as well as forwards. So, with a Life Path number of 22, 4 could be used just as well as 88.

The Second Most Important Number

This is where things start to get a little complicated. What we are going to do now is turn all the letters in your name at birth into numbers using the following chart.

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

In practice I put the vowels above the name and the consonants underneath. This is because the third most important number is derived from the vowels alone, so it makes it easier at the next step to do it this way. Again there is one exception to the rule and this is with the letter 'Y'. If it acts as a consonant and is pronounced it is classed as being a consonant. If it is not pronounced or acts as a vowel it is classed as being a vowel. The 'Y' in Yolande, for instance, would be classed as being a consanant, but the 'Y' in Larry would be classed as being a vowel as it acts as a vowel.

Let's take someone called John Horatio Connolly as an example. Using the above chart we would put a 1 under the J of his first name. We would follow this with a 6 placed above the O, then an 8 under the H, and finally a 5 under the N. We then carry on in the same manner with the rest of his name, remembering to class

the Y of Connolly as being a vowel. When you are finished, you should end up with a chart like this:

6 6 7 96 6 6 7 JOHN HORATIO CONNOLLY 1 85 8 9 2 3 55 33

Now we simply add up the numbers in each row. The top row totals: 6+6+7+9+6+6+6+7=53, and 5+3=8. The bottom row totals: 1+8+5+8+9+2+3+5+5+3+3=52, and 5+2=7. We now add the total of the top and bottom rows, which gives us 8+7=15, and 1=5=6. John's second most important number is 6.

You may be wondering why I ask you to do this using your full name at birth, especially if you have changed your name by marriage or deed poll. The reason for this is that these numbers are the most important ones for you, no matter what you do with your name later on in life. Later on in this booklet, I'll explain how to use the numbers from your current name.

The Third Most Important Number

We have already done all the mathematics necessary to work out this number. It is simply the total of the top row (the vowels) of the full name. In John Connolly's case, this totalled an 8.

The Fourth Most Important Number

This number requires virtually no mathematics at all, as it is simply your day of birth reduced to a single digit (except, of course, if you were born on the 11th, 22nd or 29th of the month).

Many people use their day of birth as a Lucky Number, but as you have now discovered it is only the fourth most important number. In fact, if we took these four numbers and turned them into percentages the Life Path number would be 40%, the second most important number (known as the "Expression" in Numerology) would be 30%, the third most important number (known as the "Soul Urge") would be 20%, and the day of birth would make up the final 10%.

So, if you are wanting to use just one number, the Life Path number is likely to be four times better than the day of birth, twice as good as the third most important number, and 75% better than the second most important number.

Now that you have worked out the most important numbers for you, let's work out the days that are best for you to make use of them.

Your Lucky Days

First of all we have to work out your Personal Year number. We do this by adding your day and month of birth to the current year. Let's take our friend, John Connolly, as our example. He was born on December 9th, 1946. To work out his Personal Year number in 1988 we would add up the day, month and present year.

9 12 1988 2009, and 2+0+0+9=11

Because we ended up with a Master Number (the 11) we do not reduce it to a 2, but as the Personal Years go in nine year cycles, it is really a 2 Personal Year, but with the opportunity to achieve much more than one could in a straight 2 year.

Each Personal Year has a special emphasis which is related to the characteristics of each number.

In a 1 Personal Year you will be full of enthusiasm and energy and wanting to get started on something new. Anything begun in a 1 year last for a long time. It is a year of new starts.

In a 2 Personal Year you will be carrying on with the things begun in a 1 year, consolidating a little on the foundations made then. It is a good year for psychic development, for getting on with people, and for all close relationships, particularly romantic ones.

In a 3 Personal Year you will not feel like working very hard. The emphasis is on having a good time and enjoying yourself. A good year for making new friends, for learning (particularly hobbies and interests), for social activities, and for creative activities.

In a 4 Personal Year the emphasis changes. In the previous year you did not feel like work, but in a 4 year you are wanting a challenge. If you have something in mind it is an excellent year, as you slowly but steadily work towards your goal. For most people, though, it is simply a year of hard work, even though there will be something to show for it at the end.

In a 5 Personal Year you will be wanting variety, so it is a good year for new interests, new friends, for travel, for dabbling at all sorts of things, and for doing the things you have always wanted to, but never quite got around to before. It is a good year for changing anything - job, house, car, anything.

In a 6 Personal Year the main emphasis is on home and family. It is a wonderful year for getting married in, and if you are already in a good relationship this year sees it develop further. At times you may not be doing quite what you want to do because of the needs of people close to you, but despite this it is usually a good year.

In a 7 Personal Year you will want peace and time on your own to think about things. It is an excellent year for learning, so you may have an urge to carry on with your education in some way. It is almost like a year off, as it is a non-materialistic year. However, it is a special year, preparing you for the busy year ahead.

In an 8 Personal Year the emphasis changes to money and finance. This is a good year for buying or selling anything. If you buy something, you will get it at a good price; if you sell something, you will get a good price for it. As it is a good year for money matters, it is a good year for lottery tickets, lotto, and so on. Remember though, that this is also the year people try and collect from you, so if you owe everyone money, this is the year they try and get it!

In a 9 Personal Year you will be aware of the cycle coming to a close. You will be looking back over the last few years, and thinking about the future. It is an excellent time for making plans, but a bad time to start, as this is a year of 'endings' rather than 'beginnings'. Keep your good ideas until you start on a new cycle next year.

The 11 and 22 Personal Years occur every now and again. They simply add power and energy to the 2 and 4 years. When they crop up make sure to capitalise on them, as they give you a good opportunity to make a large step forward.

The tone of the Personal Year covers the entire year. At the same time, though, each month adds its effect to the whole. For instance, if John Connolly was wanting to know what March 1988 was going to be like, he would add 3 (as March is the third month)

to the 11 (the number of his Personal Year), which gives him 14 and thus a Personal Month of 5. He would be likely to be feeling restless and wanting variety in March, as the effects of the 5 combine with the stronger energy of the 11. March is also likely to be a Lucky Month for him as it is a 5 month, the same number as his Life Path number.

Now we know that in March 1988, John will be in a 5 Personal Month, we can take it down to a Personal Day. Let's try March 25th, for example. We add 2+5 (the day) + 5 (Personal Month)=12, and 1+2=3. March 25th is a 3 Personal Day for John. It would be a good day for him to simply relax and enjoy himself in, as the lack of motivation of the 3 would apply. He may feel in the mood for socialising, or possibly doing something creative. He won't feel much like working.

Now look at John on March 12th. This gives him a Personal Day of 8. (1+2+5=8) He will want to work today and all financial activities are emphasised. If he wants to buy a lottery ticket or place a bet at the races, this is likely to be a much better day for him than the day before or after as it is a money day.

What are the luckiest days for you? Naturally any 8 day is good, but there are other days. The day that has the same number as any of your first, second, third or fourth most important numbers is also good. Remember that the day relating to your Most Important number is likely to be luckier for you than the others. Likewise the second Most Important number is likely to be luckier than the third or fourth, and so on.

Consequently, in any given month there will be a number of days that relate well to you as far as luck and money are concerned. Use them well.

Your Lucky Numbers

This is the interesting part of the whole exercise. You already know your most important - and therefore, luckiest - numbers, and you also know the best days to use them. Unfortunately, for most purposes you need longer numbers than simply one or two digits. If you just need a single number - say for instance to back a horse - use your most important numbers in descending order, and try and place the bet on the right day for you.

However, say you require a six digit number, or maybe a series of two digit numbers for Lotto. All you do is create a number which when brought down to a single digit, equates to your most important numbers.

Let's use John Connolly again. His most important numbers are (in order) 5, 6, 8 and 9. Assume he wants a six digit number to buy a lottery ticket. His best course is to go along to a newsagent and buy a lottery ticket with a number on it that reduces to one of his numbers. If he had a choice of 764356, 764357, 764358 from one book, and 29466, 29467 and 29470 from another, which ticket should he choose? His first choice should be 764357 as that reduces to 5, but he might also decide to buy 764358 (which reduces to a 6) or 29466 (which reduces to a 9). If he could afford to buy just one ticket, he should choose the one that adds up to his Most Important number. To try and put every advantage his way, he should also buy the ticket on the right day as well.

With Lotto numbers you have to work out the numbers yourself. This is also a simple matter. Good numbers for John would be 5, 14, 23 and 32 as they all reduce to his Most Important Number. He could add to this 6, 15, 24 and 33 (which reduce to 6), 8, 17, 26 and 35 (which reduce to 8. Isn't he lucky having an 8 in his name!), and also 9, 18, 27, and 36 (which reduce to 9).

These numbers are likely to prove effective particularly if John uses them at the right time. Want more numbers? No problem. Simply add your Most Important Numbers to your Personal Day number. In John's case, again using March 25th, 1988, we know he is in a 3 Personal Day. If we add 3 to each of his main numbers (5,6,8 and 9) we end up with 8 (!), 9, 11 and 3 (1+2=3). We have already used the 8 and the 9 in John's case, but we can create a new set of numbers out of the 11 and 3. 2, 11, 20 and 33 from the 11, and 3, 12, 21, and 30 from the 3.

This example shows one major exception to the general rule. On March 25th, 1988 John should use the number 8 in preference to his Most Important Number, as it crops up twice - once as one of his main numbers, and again when it is added to his Personal Day number. This is an exceptionally strong money combination, so he should definitely capitalise on it as much as possible.

YOUR CURRENT NAME

It is possible that you are no longer using the name you were born with. For instance, you may have changed it through marriage, altered the spelling of it, dropped one of the names - or even changed it entirely. If this is the case, you should work out the numbers of your current name and you can use these in the same way as the main numbers. Remember that the numbers from the name you were given at birth remain the most important no matter how many times you change your name. People who believe in reincarnation say that we actually choose our own names before we are born to get the experiences we need in this lifetime.

Let's take our friend John Horatio Connolly as an example again. As we already know, his main numbers are 5, 6, 8 and 9. Suppose, that as a child, all his friends called him 'Jack' and the name somehow stuck. He was always embarrassed with the name 'Horatio', so dropped it entirely once he grew up. So he is now known to everyone as 'Jack Connolly'.

Using this name Jack Connolly gains an Expression number of 9 and a Soul Urge number of 2 (the second and third most important numbers). He already has a 9 in his original main numbers, but he can utilise the 2 in working out lucky numbers for himself.

In fact, if he is usually known as 'Jack', rather than 'Jack Connolly', he could also the 7 and 1 from that name. However, he should only do this if he is wanting new numbers all the time, rather than repeating previously used ones. In this instance he would add them to his Personal Day number and use them on that particular day.

YOUR SUCCESS NUMBER

This number is not always a 'lucky number', but can bring benefits if you can make your signature total this number. It is extremely easy to work out your personal success number.

If you were born on a 1, 5 or 7 day your success number is 5. These days are the 1st, 5th, 7th, 10th, 14th, 16th, 19th, 23rd, 25th or 28th of any month.

If you were born on a 2, 4 or 8 day your success number is 8. These days are the 2nd, 4th, 8th, 11th, 13th, 17th, 20th, 22nd, 26th, 29th or 31st of any month.

If you were born on a 3, 6 or 9 day your success number is 6. These days are the 3rd, 6th, 9th, 12th, 15th, 18th, 21st, 24th, 27th, or 30th of any month.

Let's look at John Connolly again. As he was born on the 9th day of the month (9th December, 1946) his signature should total 6. Interestingly enough, his entire name does already add up to 6, so he could be very successful signing his entire name as his signature. However, he has never liked the name 'Horatio', so does not wish to sign his name with the hated middle name in it. We'll experiment with a few possibilities.

This name totals 2, so is not likely to be as successful for him as using his full name. Here's another possibility:

This totals 3 (12, and 1+2=3), so it would be a good name for someone who wanted to be well-liked. (3 = sociability, creativity, getting on with others, self-expression). However, it still doesn't give us the 6 he should have to be successful.

This signature is likely to be the least successful as it totals a 4 (hard work, drudgery, slow and steady progress).

Even using his present name, Jack Connolly, we do not get a total of 6. It looks as if he will have to change the spelling of the the name 'John' or insert a fictitious initial to make the signature total 6.

Isn't it wrong to use an initial that doesn't mean anything? Certainly not if it makes your path through life that little bit easier. There are any number of historical precedents. Even Pythagoras, the father of modern Numerology, experimented with many different names to experience the vibrations associated

with each number. It also does not have to be simply an initial. You may have a favourite name that, when added to your usual signature creates a total equal to your Success Number. If so, use it. If it is important to you that the initial means something, try using the initial of your mother's maiden name, or perhaps the initial of a close friend or someone you have always admired.

To get back to Mr Connolly again. He could decide to use J. H. D. Connolly, John H. C. Connolly or John T. Connolly if he wanted to add an initial. Naturally, the sky is the limit if he wanted to add an entire new middle name.

Another important aspect to your signature is that it should be legible. In graphology, an indecipherable signature denotes someone who has something to hide. Unless that is the image you wish to convey, practice on creating a legible signature.

CONCLUSION


