NIBS INTRODUCES "NEW TRAINING" IN WASHINGTON!!

With Dave Murray unexpectedly relieved from duties at the Academy in Washington due to private plans and with the large 4th London A.C.C. completed by Ron in Britain, training at the Academy of Religious Arts and Sciences, Washington, D.C. became the first site of the new training and processing impetus now going into effect on all continents. On hand to pilot the new Washington training program is L. Ron Hubbard, Jr., famous to the field and to professional auditors everywhere as the most experienced and most completely informed instructor in Scientology. L.R.H., Jr., ("Nibs") has just arrived from London with a complete new program for the H.C.A. and H.A.A. Academy courses. His info, straight from Ron and the 4th London A.C.C., is the summation to date of How To Audit and What To Audit and contains the data for not only training the H.C.A. and H.A.A., but the best news for students personally that students have ever had - the answers to getting the student into the kind of excellent shape that makes earlier competance in processing and in human relations.

Long considered a major problem in training has been the "case level" of the student. From London where the 4th A.C.C. handled its student cases with extreme success, Nibs brings to the H.C.A. - H.A.A. level the data and know-how of this success.

As the veteran instructor under Ron of twelve A.C.C. units from their beginning in Camden through the last Phoenix unit, it may be a surprise to some that Nibs has also taught extensively at the H.C.A. - H.A.A. level. In the past eight months in England, Nibs has trained several classes all the way thru the B.Scn, and has also worked with many classes of H.C.A. (called in England H.P.A.) students. Of B.Scn.s he has trained nearly sixty.

Assisting L. Ron Hubbard, Jr. on Academy instruction are D.Scn. Ken Barrett and B.Scn. Nadia Binhak. Ken is, of course, extremely well known to the field and to many classes of the earliest H.C.A. courses at Hubbard Professional College in Phoenix. One of the ablest, Ken is high on enthusiasm especially about the latest processes and advances in theory. His vitality and extremely fine knowledge of the whole field of Scientology from its earliest beginnings in Dianetics are becoming abundantly apparent to the present generation of H.C.A. students at the Academy. Your editor has looked in on a few of these classes in the New

Training at the Academy. There is a lot of "live" performance going on there both in classes and in student auditing sessions. Students are finding, in the new codification of processes by Ron and in the new instruction by Nibs and Ken, a practicality and sureness of auditing. These instructors have the kind of experience it takes to teach Scientology, not "authority", "personalities" or any other such mistakenness. That is the total art of teaching a subject to teach the subject, not the teacher.

There's excitement in Washington about the new Academy program - there's a new pace - more happening, more "cogniting" going on there than ever before.

Assisting Nibs and Ken as Indoctrination Week Instructor is London trained B.Scn. Nadia Binhak, one of the nicest people we know, who has contributed her services to the Academy for several weeks now and who we can't pay because she's on a visitor's visa. We hope to change that soon, but Nadia won't let visas stand in the way of the job she loves and is doing so wonderfully. Scientologist Nadia knows that the only pay is communication, but the Academy still hopes to be able to give her some of the particle, money, soon.

The whole student co-auditing program has been streamlined and re-vamped by Nibs and Ken for the best and most thorough handling of all cases.

One feature of this essential part of all training is the assurance that when a student is auditing another student he is not pulled away from the job he is doing until he finishes up on the process or group of processes being done. This gives both students as auditors and students as preclears an immediate experience with the closest possible thing to auditing as and by a pro.

Students are finding the courses, which always kept them very busy, now are keeping them very, very busy! Nibs and Ken, in close touch with Ron, are setting a goal of competance and well-being for Academy graduates that is higher than ever before - this is today's progress in Scientology in action.

4th LONDON A.C.C. TAPES USED IN H.C.A. AND H.A.A. TRAINING:

For the first time, H.C.A. and H.A.A. Courses are receiving hot off the Ampex the latest A.C.C. lectures, comprising the new Professional Instruction Standard. These tapes were released by Ron for H.C.A. - H.A.A. use because they represent a standard of processing, theory and technique, in the new S.L.P. (Six Levels of Processing) which are the full codification of many, many months of successful research by Ron and his personally trained staff and Guidance Center auditors.

Ron holds material back only as long as it is not ready, and when it is ready he shoots. There was a serious question for some time as to the possibility of releasing some of the new material which turned up and on which Ron has been working since Phoenix. We weren't sure it could be communicated to a student. The material is hot! Ron does not say there is not more information to be turned up in the future in these researches into life. He says merely that we are for-

tunate that what we now have can be communicated at all! It isn't the kind of stuff that you would serve up to a Ladies Auxiliary (not the first lecture) or the Elk's Club either. It's not for the general public until the general public gets the gradient scale of material that characterizes good dissemination of material and is the method used at the Academy and in any successful training. Indoctrination Week is a standard operating procedure for training, and a good tip for groups in the field on introducing new people to Scientology.

Bob Nichols' group program is a place where information and tips on this echelon is excellently available.

The 4th London A.C.C. tapes cannot for the above reasons be released for use in the field. They must be used in conjunction with the very best in instruction and coaching. One of the finest things an auditor anywhere can do is to conduct a Basic Teachings of Scientology course for the people in his area. This is the very best kind of communication that can be delivered to people regardless of previous training. It is working better for the H.C.A., B.Scn., H.A.A., D.Scn. now conducting such a program than anything ever used in the field. It is a MUST for the auditor building a congregation and running the "communication" ad in his local newspaper. People come to him in numbers, and people, where they get into contact with Scientology want more and they want to do something with the material they gain. Basic principle of freedom: "Let the other guy play, too."

CO-AUDITOR'S MANUAL BASIS FOR NEW PROGRAM

Now in its last stages of printing, the Co-Auditor's Manual of Scientology, a large little gold mine of basic auditing tips, processes, theory, and practicality, forms the basis for the new study programs which intersect with Communicator Bob Nichols service program and the Basic Teachings Courses given by auditors building congregations via the ad and the policy of giving Scientology away to the guy in the street.

We have a growing world community of Scientologists, and it's growing awful fast. Into this possible confusion is injected the battery of programs which are the Stable Data found in Axiom 53, and which align action. We have now people at least in the hundreds who, when you ask them as Ron did in ISSUE 16 "What are you going to do about the atom bomb", don't go into an "eternal comm-lag". They tell you what they are doing about it. One thing they are doing is making some people able.

Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health was written into a world where atomic fission was yet in its early stages. Dianetics, 1955! was written in a world where bombs exist of such fury that a continent could be laid waste. S.L.P. Issue 5, now the basis of training on all continents and the Co-Auditor's Manual are released into a world whose "leaders" are discussing the mere final niceties of where to place the bombs. That we have a job to do is not greatly in question. That it should be done is not questioned by us, but surprisingly is questioned by many in "authority". That your personal use on all Dynamics of the material now

present in Scientology should weigh greatly in the direction of world sanity and the physical security of the planet around which we live is for you to question or not to question as you will. But we can state with complete confidence that the wrong thing to do in this situation is to do nothing. Whatever opinion there might be now extant about the desirability of the continuance of Earth as our playing-field, the opinion extant among Scientologists is that it is to be continued, and not only continued, but raised to a level of civilization which will take the sneer off the word culture, and a level where Man can say of his culture that it is real.

We have an advantage over the "man behind the bomb" the guy who would tell the guy who tells the guy to tell the guy behind the button to push it. We have the advantage of Man's actual intention, which is to live.

BOB NICHOLS' SERVICE PROGRAM GROWING

The immediate and prompt interest caused by the "Reverend Bob's" program for churches and congregations has started us off with a bigger mock-up on "service to services". Bob found he had such a lot of good material coming in from auditors and ministers in several continents that a publication of some sort would have to be mocked up to handle the volume of usable communication at hand. Something on the order of a Church Bulletin. Some of the material is planned to be stolen and is already stolen by Sanborn for ABILITY, but much of it is specific to congregations and for the use of ministers in the field and should go out as such.

In combination with the "Start That Practice" ad (which is "Start That Congregation" also) as given in Ron's article, Bob's program for church activities is doubly potent, and any auditor who has not written to Bob about the program is urged to do so.

One of the things that will come of Bob's program, in addition to the creation of strong activity by the Scientology ministry in the community is the completion of the plans (see ABILITY Issue 15) for "Ability Clubs", which are strictly for the kids, and are a very, very important part of any church program, though not religious but rather recreational in appearance. Of course, as in Scientology religion is not a department separate from but a department of, fun, there wouldn't be any great discrepancy there. We suggest, however, that any Scientology congreation make plans immediately for some sort of Christmas party for the kids, as have D.Scn.s, Rev. Maydole and McNown at their Church of Scientology in Hollywood. This will perhaps be found a good time to take a look at the situation in your area for the forming of an Ability Club.

We don't want to give the kids something that isn't smoothly and well organized for them, and the Ability Club idea is being mocked up with some care, with assistance and ideas welcome from anyone with special interest or success in this field. We don't know of anyone who has had a failure with children's groups. We do want the <u>best</u> for them, however. They are dynamic on all dynamics. The idea isn't particularly that all kids are clear, it's just that kids have a slighter degree of general restimulation, and are very, very fast, therefore, because they

travel light.

DIANETICS, SCIENTOLOGY FREE INFO PACKAGES

We have 7 ministers and 9 practitioners working together in the church.

I wish very much to come to Washington, but I shall not be coming until next spring some time. Glad to hear everything is going so well with you people.


