

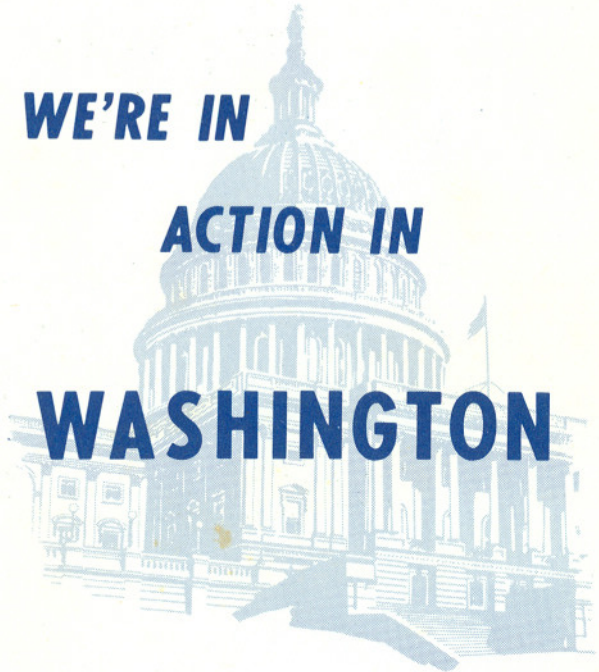

THE ADVENTURE OF SCIENTOLOGY

As a member of that crew of experts on the subject, the Explorer's Club, as one who has plowed keel into Seven Seas, who has ducked shots fired in anger and watched others fail to duck, I can verify that when all horizons are measured, all swamps mapped, all deserts charted and supplied with water and instant rescue, there will yet be a world of unknown frights and glooms and cheers to explore, there will yet be a universe of adventure left, a universe sufficiently powerful to daunt the last few thousand years of thinking men - You. The universe of You.

From the first moment of a co-auditing session the preclear begins to make discoveries - discoveries to him far more important than Balboa's glimpse of the Southern Sea or Columbus' glance at San Salvador. The preclear begins with mystery and ends with knowledge. And even in those few cases where "nothing happens" he at least discovers the pattern of his life - nothing happening.

No matter if one travels the six basic steps or the whole track, the universe of Mind minute by minute opens and unfolds. For this is the adventure of Scientology: to discover not a wrongness as in psychotherapy, to create not a peculiar pattern of individuality, as in education, but to find and come to grips with the totality of Mind itself, its "substance", "meaning" and "vastness" or whether these exist.

To use Scientology "to get well", to "become less nervous", is like using an alpine stock to dig a ditch for a water pipe in the back yard. To use Scientology as a guidebook to the discovery of the Infinity of Infinities is a proper use.

Perhaps you seek to "sell Scientology" to some chair-rooted conservative. Will you? If that person cannot buy adventure he cannot buy Scientology. There may be nothing really wrong with the person who refuses adventure. He MAY be the one who is right. Perhaps it is best to cower behind barriers with grip-shut eyes and hope never to find out. But this attitude will not appeal to the Scientologist. If he is being shot at from some mysterious and hidden quarter of body or mind he wants to stand up and take a good, hard look. If he is being wracked by unknown shivers, he wants to know (a) can he shiver harder, (b) do other people shiver and (c) can he turn it on and off.

The trained Scientologist is the greatest adventurer of all for he adventures into many, many minds. The expertly processed preclear is the deepest adventurer of all for he sees more and faces more in any given instant. But trained or not or processed or not the Scientologist is an Adventurer. Many men as ages go will own Earth. The Scientologist in addition to visiting many universes, doesn't care WHO owns them. And that is the test of he who would walk above kings - the doing is as good as the adventure therein - and that's the way it is.

Washington isn't very hot, especially if you've just seen Arizona. And its civilized.

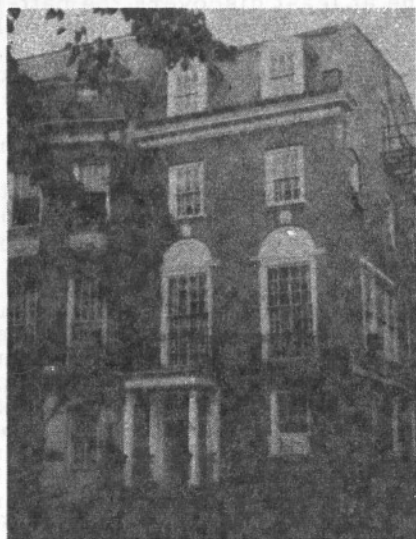
We moved because the bulk of training and processing was coming from the east and we wanted to cut down that travel. Now we've done it and we're all set to train better and process better than ever before.

INSTRUCTION IN SCIENTOLOGY

At 1845 "R" Street, N. W., Washington, D.C., in a ten room building of its own, the Academy of Religious Arts and Sciences is training people to be Scientologists.

The only place in the world where all three levels of Scientology training may be obtained, the Academy grants certificates as follows: HUBBARD CERTIFIED AUDITOR, HUBBARD ADVANCED AUDITOR, HUBBARD GRADUATE AUDITOR.

Refining its training and certificates upon five arduous years of experience in Dianetics and Scientology, the Academy program is bringing auditors to a level of ability hoped for for years but just now achieved.

Receiving personal lectures from L. Ron Hubbard, associating daily with the best auditors and instructors five years have produced, the courses follow a pattern laid down almost a year ago and which has varied little since.

Dr. Dave Murray, respected everywhere for his patient ability with students, is Director of Training and himself trains that most important level of Course, the basic H.C.A. Dr. Dick Steves, whose fast action and enthusiasm have become well known, instructs the H.A.A. (formerly B.Sc.n.) Course from which the student does not pass until he is stably exteriorized. L. Ron Hubbard personally directs the H.G.A. Course (the Advanced Clinical).

Superintendent of the Academy is Mary Sue Hubbard whose sweetness and understanding and charm have become well known. It is to Mary Sue to whom the applicant should apply for entrance.

The Academy was founded to train people in Scientology. That is what it does and that is all it does. It was founded and organized in this way and was placed where it is, in Washington, D.C., because it has a big job to do.

A new student usually arrives on a Sunday and locates a room in the neighborhood of the Academy (where rooms are plentiful and inexpensive). He enrolls at 8:00 A.M. on Monday morning (any Monday morning). He then enters a week's indoctrination course where he receives careful personal coaching by a staff auditor and some professional auditing. It does not matter what course he is to enter, he receives this week so as to achieve an auditing presence and knowledge of basics to aid him and his fellow students in their later training.

After his indoctrination week he enters the course into which he enrolled and for the remainder of that course works from eight o'clock in the morning to nine o'clock at night becoming as proficient as possible. The H.C.A. Course is eight weeks long. The H.A.A. Course is five weeks in length. The H.G.A. Course is six weeks long. In the H.C.A. Course the week of indoctrination is considered part of the course.

All necessary texts are furnished him. All materials are included in his enrollment fee. His certificate and ordination fee in the Church of Scientology are also included in his enrollment fee.

After passing his examinations and the review of his own case, the student is certified. If not already ordained he may then apply through the Church of Scientology of Washington, D.C., a considerable advantage, for its ordinations are official with the United States Government and becomes a permanent and indisputable record (Washington, D.C. is the only place in the United States where this is possible.)

The general curriculum of all courses contains much data in
ABILITY MINOR 6

addition to Scientology, covering the history of various religious arts and sciences. The student is coached in the conduct of rites and ceremonies. He is given ample practice in individual and group auditing. A routine requirement for the upper certificates, a casual part of the examination, is the performance of a few miracles.

Enrollment fees are payable in advance and full payment of fee is a condition to certification. The fee of the H.C.A. Course is \$500.00. The fee of the H.A.A. Course is \$285.00. The fee of the H.G.A. Course is \$800.00.

PROCESSING BY EXPERTS

Scientology at its best is Scientology applied by the staff of the Hubbard Guidance Center. Coached by Ron, every step of every case considered in detail every day by the assembled auditors, each preclear understood and processed against before and after testing by an expert, the results are what they should be - excellent.

The goal is ABILITY. The end of the intensive is the agreement by the staff that something and many things have happened with the case.

Directed by capable Dr. Julia Lewis the Center contains in its files a startling record of what teamwork amongst good auditors, a good director and Ron can do.

Raises in intelligence from fifteen to twenty points is routine and usual during a twenty-five hour intensive. Changes in personality from ten to ninety points are common in these intensives. Rises in self-determinism from 5% to 80% are expected. Reaction time improvements are so ordinary that they are no longer commented upon. A usual change is found in the general feeling of security of the individual or a return of long-dormant artistic interest and ability.

Magic is being woven by the staff of the Hubbard Guidance Center. Here is created human ability. The most priceless gift in its power to bestow is exteriorization and the knowledge, the complete assurance of one's fear and indecision of a lifetime; and exteriorization with stability takes place during the majority of intensives.

No longer centered on illness and its eradication, these auditors are free to weave a better lifetime, a better world for the preclear. It is incidentally true that most psychosomatic illnesses vanish or reduce during an intensive and remain so but this is not the business of the center and is not the reason for its existence.

Many have been audited, few by experts. It is not possible to obtain an accurate idea of what Scientology can do until Scientology is wielded in expert hands such as these at the Guidance Center.

Ron organized this staff to demonstrate what Scientology can really do. He has been saying for years what results should be. He is showing what they should be now in the Hubbard Guidance Center at 1845 "R" Street, N. W., Washington, D.C.

A twenty-five hour intensive is well worth its cost of five hundred dollars. A seventy-five hour intensive is invaluable at \$1,250.00. These are the only two things offered at the Center. No hourly rate auditing is done, but can be procured nearby at the Scientology Foundation. The center is interested in as good a result as possible per person.

The person desiring auditing should arrive in Washington, D. C. on Sunday and find a room in the famous Connecticut Avenue neighborhood of the Center where rooms are cheap and plentiful. He should then report to the Director of Processing at 8:00 A.M. Monday morning for contract, testing and assignment. During the remainder of the week he will receive conference coached auditing, interview with Ron and many new experiences. On Saturday afternoon he is tested again and unless the Director requests him to stay on for another week, the individual has completed his intensive.

TAPES

As the tapes available today are rather an impressive number covering very broadly an unlimited subject, perhaps a suggestion would be helpful on what to get first and what to get next.

The professional auditor should have in his possession the PROFESSIONAL COURSE Tapes, should keep professionally familiar with this material. They comprise twenty-six half hour lectures carefully prepared by Ron for dissemination of the top level material of Scientology.

Then, the professional auditor should either have been trained recently in Phoenix, OR should be in advanced training in Washington, OR should have also in his possession the BASIC COURSE OF SCIENTOLOGY, ten one hour lectures covering the Six Basic Processes.

Then he should have Ron's lectures to H.P.C. by renting one or two reels at a time - two hours to the reel. By doing this the professional auditor can keep well up on his data and technical information.

A Scientology group, containing several old hands and many newcomers, finds most successful the CONGRESS Tapes, and an extremely sound group plan is to take the Congresses in order, one after the other. Here is a complete and extensive group program in itself. Over the period necessary for presenting these and allowing for the repeating many times of the Group Processing Tapes contained in the Congresses, this doesn't work out as a very expensive proposition, as the group will grow, and the ability to contribute increases. A group should have in mind the wise plan of sending quite regularly, possibly at the expense of the group, a student or two in to Washington for H.C.A. Training. They will find this, upon the return of the trained, modern H.C.A. the best investment in existence.

An inexpensive group plan also is to use the Rental Library to get the Public Lecture Series and Public Processing Series, ABILITY MINOR 6

which are combined. A reel has on one side a Lecture by Ron, and on the other side a Group Audit by Ron. It makes a very successful evening, and one of them repeated often makes an even more successful SERIES of evenings.

MEMBERSHIPS

The Hubbard Association of Scientologists, International is the membership organization of Scientology. Having some hundreds of charter members, the H.A.S.I. is the controlling body of Scientology practice.

Membership in the H.A.S.I. is in three categories. These are General, \$8.50: Special, \$25.00: Professional, \$25.00. All are for one year.

The General Member receives ABILITY and various bulletins, CERTAINTY MAGAZINE, published by the London Office, has a 10% discount on books and tapes. The Special and Professional Memberships both receive all issues of ABILITY, and every two weeks THE PROFESSIONAL AUDITORS BULLETIN (Ron's own comm line to his auditors), CERTAINTY MAGAZINE and a 20% discount on books and tapes.

Exactly the same membership arrangements and discounts and publications are available in the HUBBARD DIANETIC RESEARCH FOUNDATION. The only difference is that one should specify which organization. The H.D.R.F. is mainly interested in the uses of psychotherapy and is not interested in religion in any way. Dianetics still flourishes. It has a different goal.

A Professional Membership is necessary in one or the other organizations to keep certificates in full force.

BOOKS

A full Dianetic and Scientology library would include about two score volumes. The basic would be THE ORIGINAL THESIS by L. Ron Hubbard, a fact which may surprise you since it was written in 1947. (This is sent to all new or renewing members who do not have it and who ask for it with their membership). (\$2.75)

The next would be DIANETICS, 1955! by L. Ron Hubbard. (\$3.75, the new edition)

The third would be THE CREATION OF HUMAN ABILITY by L. Ron Hubbard. (\$5.00, U.S. edition)

These, for the retail price of \$11.50 would start one into more discovery and adventure than has been available to Man in the past.

A more complete list would add DIANETICS: THE MODERN SCIENCE OF MENTAL HEALTH (\$4.00) and SCIENCE OF SURVIVAL (\$5.00), both by L. Ron Hubbard.

An even more complete list, one which was REALLY interested in philosophy and whereas, would include a very great but very deep book SCIENTOLOGY 8:8008 by L. Ron Hubbard. (\$2.50)

An entire list of Dianetic and Scientology publications would include about two-score volumes. Amongst them would be many out of print rarities.

The things which you should be doing: (1) get the \$11.50 trio above and when you've a good grip on them, get (2) DIANETICS: THE MODERN SCIENCE OF MENTAL HEALTH and SCIENCE OF SURVIVAL. Then (3) come to the Academy for an H.C.A. Course. Then (4) build yourself a fine, remunerative practice and congregation in your area, get a lot of experience and cash from auditing and (5) take the H.A.A. and H.G.A. Courses and go out and start a school in your area and with this and your congregation, gradually take over the leadership in social projects in your area. As an H.G.A. you would, of course, be eligible for a doctor's degree.

The first step on this highroad is the obtaining and understanding of the three books first mentioned above.
