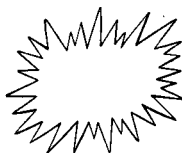

SUCCESS WITH CUB SCOUTS

Our Cub Scout Pack consists of six Dens. Each Den has six to eight boys ranging in age from 8 to 10 1/2 years. The Dens meet once a week at one of the boys' homes to work on Scout books, handicraft, to learn new songs, tell stories, and to make up skits to entertain the other Dens and parents at the Pack meetings held once a month. At the Pack meetings, the Dens are awarded four separate flags; one for having the best skit, one for handicraft, one for theme of the month and one for having the most parents present for that Pack meeting. Our Den of eight boys had been meeting for several months and doing as well, but no better than the other Dens. Most of our boys were well behaved. Some would rather snatch another's hat and run off with it than listen to what our next project would be, and one always voted against putting on a skit for the Pack meeting.

Almost all of them were late getting projects finished. Then we started having a 15 or 20 minute Scientology processing session at the beginning of each weekly meeting (location-al and creative).

We did the processing as a new kind of game. One game went like this: Let us imagine your school room. Okay. Let us have it empty. Okay. No one in the seats. Okay. No one at the teacher's desk. Okay. No one at the black board. Okay. Look all around the school room and see that there is no one there. Ok. Now be at the front of the room teaching all the empty chairs. Ok. Then we would fill the seats with children; have all the seats empty again; fill the seats with teachers and "you be teaching them"; have the seats empty, etc. At the end of each game we would have the boys touch the floor, touch the wall, touch the chair, touch the table, and touch many other objects. With such a small group, and the same group over and over, it was relatively easy to make sure each boy did each command before getting on to the next.

At first, some of the boys weren't too keen on the new games we were playing, and one of the boys quit coming altogether. I didn't want him to, but the other boys didn't seem to mind. After a few weeks the remaining boys were looking forward to the processing and having fun doing it. The processing continued for nine months.

And what effect did the processing have on our boys? During the last 5 months of meetings, our Den won three of the four flags EVERY MONTH. The boys' abilities had increased to the point that they were able to handle and win on having the best skit, on the best handicraft and on the theme for the month. The only one they did not win was that for having the most parents attending Pack meeting. However, the attendance of the boys was 100% for all nine months! As far as I know, no Den of this Pack had ever had such a record -- certainly not from nothing to almost everything!

The boys were much happier and they all got their work done on time. Besides the changes I could see in them, one mother told me her boy was doing much better in his school work. Another said her little fellow who had been too shy, was now taking the leading part in the Christmas Play his Sunday School was putting on. And also, the parents of other Dens started commenting on how well behaved our Den was. I certainly enjoyed working with the boys and appreciated the changes.
