THEY LOVE CLEARING!

One of the largest and best Congresses ever held ended July 6, 1958 at the Shoreham Hotel in Washington, D. C.

The Congress program covered clearing and became in fact the most complete coverage of Scientology and clearing ever organized.

The Congress began with the presentation by Ron of fifteen clear bracelets to some of the clears attending.

From this beginning Ron went on to cover in nine fact-packed hours of lecture, the entire subject of Scientology and Clearing. All the data needful for a complete understanding of the subject was outlined and the data necessary to production of clears was given in full.

According to those attending, Ron's lectures have never been more brilliant or better received.

This is the first Congress ever filmed. Shot by professional cameramen in 16 mm sound color, the first six hours comprise a living record of the historic event. This film will be shown through the field, containing as it does, a complete and simple presentation of the subject for the general public as well as the professional Scientologist, a spanning of interest and presentation of unusual accomplishment in itself.

The Congress lectures were also fully taped for release of 3 3/4 inches per second professional recording. The tapes contain the full text of the Congress. *

The Congress was ably organized by Dr. Richard Steves and excellently carried forward by the central organization staff.

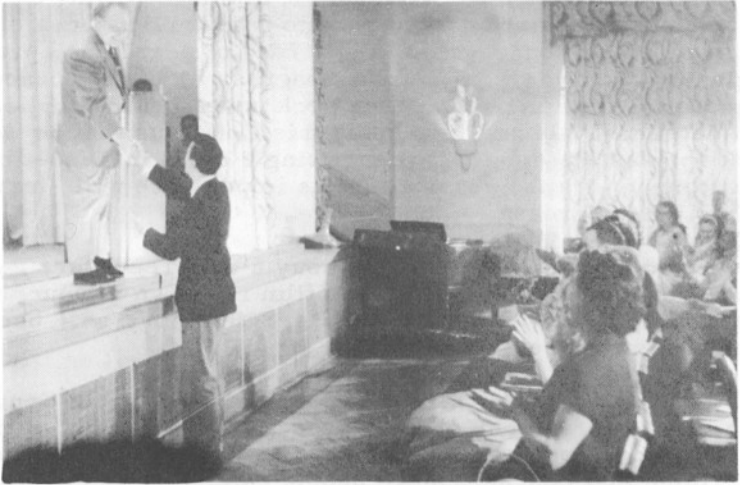

Dear Ron,

Thank you for your note which I received this morning. That's right. Just about 1% of the population here have been through our hands. But a lot more than 1% know of Scientology. In this connection it is rather interesting to note that up to a few weeks ago our ads in the paper made no mention of "Scientology" as such. We always have around 130 telephone calls per two weeks. But one day I got the idea of running an ad which said: "Learn about SCIENTOLOGY." The word SCIENTOLOGY carried the biggest space in the ad. We were stunned to discover that the calls were up 50% as a result of this ad.

This proved that we are becoming extremely well known for what we are.

We seldom have less than a hundred on each Free Course and of these 30 to 35 take the Advanced Course. It works out that there are permanently 90 to 100 students on the Advanced Course. At the same time, running continuously, we have a Basic Auditor's Course which is really a Communication Course with a maximum of 20 students. Three of these students are leaving for Melbourne and the HPA Course at the end of this week.

We also have a dozen study Groups run by HPAs and Basic Auditors in the Metropolitan area. These groups are led by people coming in off the Advanced Course.

Our clinic does a good job with a couple of Intensives per week on the average.

To sum up: We are maintaining our position in space very nicely. My aim is to get this place running so that it will run without too much attention from me. Then we can start fanning out. If this can be done successfully, there is no end to what we might accomplish.
