The Auditor's Code

- Number 1. Do not evaluate for the preclear.
- Number 2. Do not invalidate or correct the preclear's data.
- Number 3. Use the processes which improve the preclear's case.
- Number 4. Keep all appointments once made.
- Number 5. Do not process a preclear after 10:00 P. M.
- Number 6. Do not process a preclear who is improperly fed or who has not received enough rest.
- Number 7. Do not permit a frequent change of auditors.
- Number 8. Do not sympathize with the preclear.
- Number 9. Never permit the preclear to end the session on his own independent decision.
- Number 10. Never walk off from a preclear during a session.
- Number 11. Never get angry with a preclear.
- Number 12. Always reduce every communication lag encountered by continued use of the same question or process.
- Number 13. Always continue a process as long as it produces change, and no longer.
- Number 14. Be willing to grant beingness to the preclear.
- Number 15. Never mix the processes of Scientology with those of various other practices.
- Number 16. Maintain two-way communication with the preclear.
- Number 17. Never use Scientology to obtain personal and unusual favors or unusual compliance from the preclear for the auditor's own personal profit.
- Number 18. Estimate the current case of your preclear with reality and do not process another imagined case.
- Number 19. Do not explain, justify or make excuses for any auditor mistakes whether real or imagined.

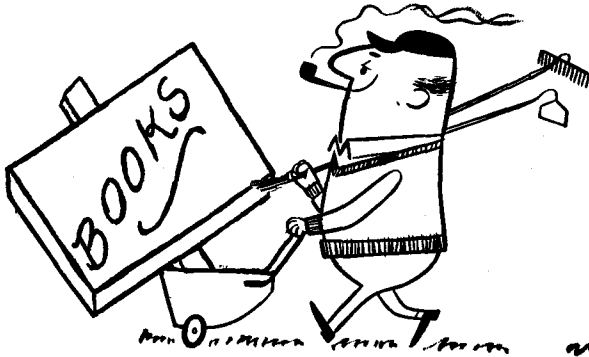

 - Number 6. To discourage the abuse of Scientology in the press.
 - Number 7. To employ Scientology to the greatest good to the greatest number of dynamics.
 - Number 8. To render good processing, sound training and good discipline to those students or peoples entrusted to my care.
 - Number 9. To refuse to impart the personal secrets of my pre-clears.
 - Number 10. To engage in no unseemly disputes with the uninformed on the subject of my profession.

The Church of Scientology Creed

The Code of Honor

No one expects the Code of Honor to be closely and tightly followed.

An ethical code cannot be enforced. Any effort to enforce the Code of Honor would bring it into the level of a moral code. It cannot be enforced simply because it is a way of life which can exist as a way of life only as long as it is not enforced. Any other use but self-determined use of the Code of Honor would, as any Scientologist could quickly see, produce a considerable deterioration in a person. Therefore its use is a luxury use, and which is done solely on self-determined action, providing one sees eye to eye with the Code of Honor.

1.

Never desert a comrade in need, in danger or in trouble.

2.

Never withdraw allegiance once granted.

3.

Never desert a group to which you owe your support.

4.

Never disparage yourself or minimize your strength or power.

5.

Never need praise, approval or sympathy.

6.

Never compromise with your own reality.

7.

Never permit your affinity to be alloyed.

8.

Do not give or receive communication unless you yourself desire it.

9.

Your self determinism and your honor are more important than your immediate life.

10.

Your integrity to yourself is more important than your body.

11.

Never regret yesterday. Life is in you today, and you make your tomorrow.

12.

Never fear to hurt another in a just cause.

13.

Don't desire to be liked or admired.

14.

Be your own adviser, keep your own counsel and select your own decisions.

15.

Be true to your own goals.
