LET THE PC HAVE HIS FULL END PHENOMENA

From time to time, PC folders from all parts of the world are received at Flag.

Error Summaries are done, and these folders are seen by Ron, by Flag C/S, CS-4 and CS-5.

Some of these folders show well done Standard Auditing all through and in some cases, Ethics action.

Among the errors found, and certainly the least excusable, are those in which Dianetics is not run to the correct end phenomena.

Some of these errors in end phenomena are:

Not permitting the pc to have his full end phenomena, but indicating the F/N too quickly and CHOPPING THE PC'S COG. Result – PC roller coasters, won't hold gains – INEXCUSABLE. See HCOB 14 May '69 *F/N and Erasure* paragraph on cognition. See HCOB 20 Feb. '70 *Floating Needles and End Phenomena*. See HCOB 2 June '70 *Floating Needles*.

Auditing the Pc past exterior. Result – Pc caves in, starts to fear the exterior state, requires a lot of repair – INEXCUSABLE. See HCOB 11 April '70 *Auditing Past Exterior* first three paragraphs. See HCOB 6 May '70 *Blows – Auditing Past Exterior*. See HCOB 22 March '70 *Exteriorization and High TA*.

Chopping up a pc's Exteriorization Intensive into more than one session, thus leaving the PC in the middle of a cycle. Result – PTPs about Exteriorization – INEXCUSABLE. THEN auditing the pc further over the PTP – INEXCUSABLE. See HCOB 30 April '69 *Auditor Trust*. See HCOB 7 April '64 *All Levels Q and A*. See BASIC material about auditing over PTPs, ARC Breaks, W/Hs.

Out Tech in any form is inexcusable. But the above are particularly so because these are BASIC data, and because Dianetic HCOBs are numerous and explicit on the end phenomena. It is F/N-Cog-VGIs-Erasure.

This applies to *all* Grades from Dianetics to Power and beyond.

DON'T AUDIT PAST EXTERIOR.

DO THE EXTERIORIZATION INTENSIVE IN ONE SESSION.
