

Le trespassing or no admittance signs are posted all over the properties which have an approximate acreage of five or six hundred acres. There seems to be one main house with large plate glass windows with a lot of telescopic equipment looking out over the surrounding countryside.

All the natives up there seem to be quite mystified about it all and no doubt this is an unnecessary report to you.

I would be interested to know if you have had occasion to investigate this firm or the apparent owner of it whom I understand to be some sort of an Austrian refugee.

> Reference is made to a letter from Knoxville Office dated October 7, 1948 entitled "Orgonon". Project, Security Matter-X, and to Bureau letter dated June 28, 1947 directed to Clark-Babbitt Industries, Inc.,

75 Federal Street, Boston 10, Massachusetts, concerning the Orgonon Project.

advised that his office had conducted an investigation concerning Organon Project and all members connected with the Project, but his office was never able to ascertain anything of a subwersive nature concerning this Project.

advised that he recently received a letter from from Kingfield, Maine, advising him that she was of the impression that they were working on the atomic bomb at the Orgonon Project.

Kingfield, Maine, advised that is employed as a chemist at the Oak Ridge, Tennessee, Atomic Energy Commission, and she was under the impression that some of the products used at the Oak Ridge Plant were also used at the Organon Project. However, she stated that she had no facts to substantiate the above information and it was purely supposition on her part. Padvised that she understood that a Dr. MEICH and his wife were in charge of the Prgonon Project at Rangeley Lakes, Maine. Further, that Dr. NORCE, who is a chemist at the Project, originally came from Norway, along with Dr. TROLL, and his Secretary, Kiss TISON, who have both returned to Norway. She stated that a local woman by the name of Mrs. RACHER SMITH, who formerly operated overnight cabins and camps near the Project, married a German from the Project and they both are presently residing in Boston, Mass.

advised that she had no information concerning any of the people at the Project, but that she was suspicious because so many foreigners gathered together.

OPIES DESTROYED

Rangeley, Maine, edvised that the Organon Project has been in effect for the past four or time years and is supposed to be a cancer research Laboratory operated by Dr. WILHELM REICH, who gave his address as 9906 69th Avenue, Forest Hills, long Island, New York, and his wife's name is Dr. ILSE CLENDORFF. Their address at Rangeley, Maine, is lost Office Box 527.

stated that another person who appeared to be connected with the Project was WILLIAM E. WASHINGTON, colored, believed to be the same person mentioned in referenced letter from Knoxville and whose addresses are 200 Norfolk Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts, and Rolling Hill Farm, Post Office Box 393, Rangeley, Maine. He stated that Rolling Hill Farm at Rangeley, Maine, is owned by MYRON and BERTHA SCHARF, who list their address as 75 Hancock Street, Cambridge 38, Massachusetts He stated that they are also connected with Organon Project.

advised that Mr. and Mrs. ROBERD SCHARAF of 50 Holland Avenue, Brookline; Massachusetts, are also connected with the Organon Project.

Also connected with the Project is JAMES WILLE, M.D., Box 315, Rangeley, Maine, and who gives his legal address as 252 Dover Road, Manhasset, Long Island, New York, and a Dr. THEODOR WOLF, whose only address is Orgonon Project, Rangeley, Maine.

continued to state that Mr. THOMAS E MOSS is caretaker of ORGONON Project, and that he might possibly be able to furnish the writer with additional information.

Mr. THOMAS E. ROSS, caretaker of Orgonon Project, advised that he was hired by Dr. WILHELN REICH, and that he received his check from the Corn Exchange Bank & Trust Company, Forest Hills Branch, New York; that he believes Dr. WILLE and Dr. REICH are now head of Orgonon Project, but that formerly Dr. WOLF was connected with the Orgonon Project. Mr. ROSS advised that in September, 1948, a meeting was held at the Project and around thirty-four people attended, but that from his observation, he has never seen anything of a subversive nature, and that he has never known any of the Doctors connected with the Project to try to conceal any of the information of the experiments they were making.

Mr. ROSS further stated that the contractor who had formerly built the Organon Project and was presently constructing a new laboratory, is Mr. VERNON COLLINS of Engeley, Maine.

Mr. V. COLLINS, contractor, Rangeley, Maine, advised that he was hired by Dr. REICH and his wife to construct the Organon Project, which is a cancer research laboratory. He advised that he had never had any reason to suspect anyone connected with this Project, and he believes that all of the people connected with the Project are loyal americans.

Mr. COLLINS continued that a number of local people have visited the Project and had the occasion to view the work being conducted, and he personally never knew of anything secretive being conducted at the Project, which excluded himself, or any of his men working at the Project.

No further investigation is contemplated in this case in view of the fact that no derogatory information was developed, and this case is being referred upon completion to the office of origin.

UNITED SIMILS GOVERNMEN! DIRECTOR. FRI RECONON PROJECT, alex Organo Institute Reference is made to Boston letter The original information in this matter was received from . MEMER V. MEMER, Chief, Security Division, USARC, Oak Ridge, Tennessee. His letter stated briefly that an unidentified confidential source had expressed suspicion concerning the Organon Project and members of its staff. Due to the allegations contained therein and as they expressed a desire to be advised of the results of investigation, the Boston Office was requested to make a preliminary check. Referenced letter was the result of this investigation by the Boston Office. As information contained in referenced letter did not indicate that the Organon Project or its staff members were engaged in subversive activities or in violation of any statute within the jurisdiction of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, this office did not deem it necessary to conduct further investigation. Accordingly, the Security Division, USAEC, was notified by letter on Jamuary 20, 1949 of the lack of derogatory information developed concerning this project by our Boston Office and that no further investigation was being conducted. It was requested of the Security Division that this office be notified should it be found that the Organon Project was utilizing radioactive materials as furnished by the Atomic Energy Commission. Ho reply has been received from them to date and it is, therefore, assumed that such was not found to be the case. Accordingly, no further action is being taken in this matter.

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





Orgonon Official Explains A Nation Work at Rangeley Laboratory

RANGELEY — Gates and "no trespassing" signs were eracted at Orgonon institute here solely to guarantee peace and quiet for intensive scientific non-political research, which could not be carried on successfully with constant interruptions, Dr. Eisworth F. Baker, member of the board of trustees of Wilhelm Reich Foundation, has announced

Far from being a sacret, the work of Reich, the science of cosmic orgone energy is today widely known throughout the world, Dr. Baker explained. The foundation was incorporated as a teaching and research institution in Maine. The American Association for Medical Orgonomy with more than a score of physicians was formed in 1948. Reich has taught at University of Oalo, Norway, and was associate professor of medical psychology at the New School for Social Research, New York City. There are co-workers in orgonomy in many other countries.

Plans are underway. Dr. Baker said, to set up various kinds of medical clinics in this region, an infant research center, a children's hospital, an orgone energy accumulator factory, and finally a university of orgonomy on the 280-acre site in Rangeley.

Reich, according to Baker, found in the 1920's in doing psychlatric work with emotionally sick patients there was a disturbance in the flow of energy. The blocked flow of this energy he found to be the core of emotional disease. This formed the basis of many diseases, including cancer, Dr. Baker continued.

It was emphasized that while Dr. Reich claims to have understood the cancer problem in its essentials, he does not claim he has a cure. Orgone-therapeutic treatment can do much in the early stages through the Reich blood tests and the use of the energy accumulator but in later stages cannot radically change the patient's condition although it may prolong life and alleviate pain. This type of research, Baker declared, is not opposed to other kinds of cancer research but, on the contrary, user fruitful results of the work of others.

The emphasis in organomy is primarily on prevention rather than cure.

The observatory was constructed here in 1948 and 1949 for astrophysical research with which Reich is now primarily concerned. There is great hope, Dr. Baker said, that in orgone energy an effective counter measure has been found against ill effects of nuclear atomic radiation upon the organism such as burns, destruction of tissue and blood.

Reference is made to the enclosed report of SA in the instant case dated October 13, 1950.

This report has been made administrative because it has been prepared solely to consolidate in one serial the numerous non-specific allegations by residents in the area concerning the captioned group. The Boston Division is continuing to receive letters from such persons as which are non-specific in detail and lacking in even opinion as to what might constitute the subversive activities alleged.

Recent experience in Maine has indicated that the residents of rural areas in that State are particularly concerned about the current international situation and inclined to regard all persons residing in or passing through the area who are not lifelong residents with suspicion.

The enclosed report is obviously not prepared for dissemination.

WILHELM REICH POUNDATION AT ORGONON TRANCE ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT ORGONON PROJECT changed to WILHELM REICH FOUNDATION on October 15, 1949, at Farmington, Maine, REICH FOUNDATION is a cancer research laboratory. Investigation failed to disclose any activity that would be contrary to the security of this country At Rangeley, Maine 造品大學 On July 18, 1950, the Bureau directed a letter to the Boston Office enclsoing a letter from Rangeley, Maine, which letter requested an interview with an agent of this Bureau were interviewed jointly and advised as follows: They have been suspicious of the ORGONON PROJECT because there seems to be "a cloud of hystery sursomding the BCT 1/2 1950 Albany (Info.) project. " They stated that there is a man on the Orgopon grounds who walks around at might and when anyone approaches him he covers his face so that they cannot see him. They further advised that at Rangeley, Maine, told thom that while he was talking to WILHELL REICH in his office he saw a revolver under some papers on Mr. REICH'S desk. They continued to state that a private airport was under construction at Phillips, Maine, approximately twenty to thirty miles from the ORGONON PROJECT, and they believe it may have some connection with the project. They were unable to see any reason why the project should be interested in keeping records of wind velocity. They stated they were informed by at Rangeley, Maine, that while he was working at the project they used exceptionally heavy wire in wiring up the laboratories of the project and advised that Mr. REICH the President of the foundation, informed him that they were working on the Atomic Energy Project. Both said they had no specific evidence of any disloyal acts or activities pertaining to anyone connected with the REICH FOUNDATION but they felt that if anyone at the project was engaged in any activities detrimental to 🗢 our national security they should be investigated.

On July 17, 1950, the Bureau directed a letter to the Boston Office under the caption, RANGKIRY TAKES, MATNE", enclosing a letter from guét 2, 1950, reporting a foreign clement at the ORGONON INSTITUTE. was interviewed by the writer and advised he owned property adjacent to the REICH FOUNDATION, which is alow known as the ORGONON PROJECT, and although he has never noticed anything that was inimical to our national security there were a number of foreign-speaking people who worked at and visited the REICH FOUNDATION. He said that on one occasion he noticed an amber light that was shining from the ROLLING ACRES towards the REICH FOUNDATION. The ROLLING ACRES is approximately two miles from the REICH FOUNDATION and is \*alleged to be a nudist said he knew of nothing of a disloyal nature pertaining to the REICH FOUNDATION but because of the foreign element at the foundation he thought it best to report this information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Special agent on July 8, 1950, that he had received information from one whom he considered to be reliable, to the effect that several families were vacationing on a mountain top at Rangeley, Maine, and that these persons openly discussed Communism and displayed strong sympathies both for Russia and for Communism. That had advised the received his information through one residing at Rangeley, Maine.

advised that he worked at the ORGONON PROJECT during the Spring of 1949 and that he helped wire the new laboratory. He stated he did all the electrical work in all their other buildings and while working at the ORGONON PROJECT he had never witnessed or heard anyone at the project make any disloyal remarks. He advised they are carrying on cancer research study at the laboratories of the project, as well as treating patients for cancer and other diseases. He stated they have a specially built box lined inside with galvanized iron and on the outside with celotex. He stated a person sits in this box for a period of two hours and breathes the air from the inside of the box through a tube. He stated there has been considerable talk in Rangeley, Maine pertaining to the personnel of the project but he believes it is all hearsay and there is no evidence that anyone at the project has been in any way disloyal to the United States.

On July 2h, 1950, the Bureau directed a letter to the Boston Office under the caption, WMR. O. R. ROWE, Town Manager, Rangeley, Maine", enclosing a letter from Mr. ROWE dated July 15, 1950, requesting an interview with an Agent of this Bureau. Mr. OLIN ROWE stated he had been contacted by some of the townspeople who wanted him to report the WIIHELM REICH FOUNDATION because "It appeared suspicious to them." He stated he could not furnish any information of a disloyal nature other than the fact most of the townspeople are suspicious of the foundation because of the foreign element connected with the foundation.

Mr. ROWE said that WILHELM REICH has written several articles on the treatment of cancer and that in these writings he has advocated early sexual relations for children in the treatment of cancer. He stated REICH's publications have caused considerable comment in Rangeley, Maine, and that they were barred from the public library in Rangeley because of this theory. Mr. ROWE said that a Miss McGINTY from the REICH FOUNDATION has applied for a teacher's position at Rangeley, Maine, and a Mrs. WYLEY, whose husband is a doctor at the foundation, has applied for a position with the Department of Child Welfare, State House, Augusta, Maine, and the local residents are wondering why these two individuals are seeking these positions. Mr. ROWE continued to state that the REICH FOUNDATION was registered with the Registrar of Deed's Office in Farmington, Maine, and has also been incorporated under four different names in New York. Mr. ROWE described WILHELM

He stated from his observation he neither saw or heard anything that could be considered disloyal to the United States. He said while he was talking to Dr. REICH in the doctor's office he saw a revolver on the top of Dr. REICH's desk that was concealed under some papers. However, he stated this did not arouse his suspicions in view of the fact many of the local residents at Rangeley, Maine, have several different types of firearms that they use for hunting year round. It is a stated that the REICH FOUND TION has been open to the public of the inspection on several occasions and that the local townspeople have been invited to visit Rangeley, Maine, to hear lectures that have been given by the personnel at the foundation. said that he has sold considerable merchandise to Dr. REICH and the REICH FOUNDATION. He stated when they first came to Rangeley Dr. REICH outlined his program which was to take place at the REICH FOUNDATION and also instructed the town officials at Rangeley, Maine, that he intended to set p laboratories and a hospital. Stated that he has seen patients being treated for cancer at the REICH FOUNDATION and that while he was at the foundation no one ever tried to conceal any information or restrict him from seeing any activities at the laboratory. He has nover seen anything of a suspicious nature at the project. He advised that ORGONON has been in existence from ten to twelve years, and he believes that this is the only laboratory of its type in the world.

A sheck was made with the Secretary of State's Office, State House, Augusta, Maine, and no record was found wherein the REICH FOUNDATION was incorporated.

The writer contacted Judge PETER MILIS who was listed as Secretary of the corporation. Judge MILIS is Judge of the Municipal Court in Farmington, Maine, and he advised that he is clerk of the corporation. He has attended several corporation meetings and from his association with all the members and personnel at the REICH FOUNDATION he has never witnessed anything which could be considered detrimental to the national security of our country. He said that he had been requested by Or. REICH to either take civil or criminal action against a WILLIAM FUJIER of Rangeley, Maine, for disseminating information of a disloyal nature pertaining to the personnel of the REICH FOUNDATION. Judge

THIS advised that he personally "could give the REICH FOUNDATION" but that he was worried over the theory of Dr. REICH concerning the sex treatment of cancer. Judge IMILIS stated that ARTHUR GARFIELD HAYES, a prominent attorney in New York City handled all the business for the REICH FOUNDATION in New York where they also maintain a laboratory.

A confidential report dated August 19, 1949, entitled "WALTER J. KOWALSKI, Acting Director, Security Division, COO" disclosed that available directories of educational institutions in the United States do not list an ORGONE or ORGONON INSTITUTION nor do they show any educational facilities at Rangeley, Maine. The names ORGONE INSTITUTE, ORGONON INSTITUTE were checked against the indiges of the Security Office, AEC, Chicage, with negative results.

On August 22, 1949, MYROW SHARAF, who was connected with the Institute, advised that the proper name of the institute is THE ORGONE INSTITUTE, Organon, Rangelcy, Maine. He stated Organon is the name of the property on which the institute is located. SHARAF continued to state that the institute is "an institute of research on organe energy" whose director is Dr. WILHELM REICH. SHARAF stated that he was an assistant at the institute.

Inasmuch as the foregoing investigation revealed no indication that the personnel of the WILHELM REICH FOUNDATION are engaged in any violations of law, this case is being closed.

Copies of this report are being designated for New York and Albany Offices because instant organization is a New York Corporation and maintains personnel and a laboratory in New York City.

The undersigned member of the Board of Trustees of The Wilhelm Reich Foundation, chartered in the State of Maine, would like to bring to your attention the Following facts:

Wilhelm Reich, M.D., Associate Professor of Medical Payobology, Director of the Orgone Institute, President" and bead research physician of The Wilhelm Reich Foundstion, resident of the State of Maine, is the discoverer of the blological or life energy. This discovery was made between 1936 and 1940, as evidenced by the publications of the Orgone Institute Press, Orgonon, Bangeley, To Maine. It'is hatural that a discovery of such importance has provoked much disquesion, consent as well as animosity in many quarters and countries, and especially in the 1.8.A. This belongs to every me jor discovery. However, In the case of the discovery of the life energy by wilhelm Relab, a new element entered the scene which was never before so strongly developed: blopathic individuals who feel personally threatened by the new insights into emotional and biological life, are busy discrediting and slandering the discovery in a quite irrational manner. This would not constitute any sufficient reason to bother you, if it did not book up in many instances with the present danger threatening from the Communists.

These facts are not known to the defamers of Reich's work who usually do not read any highly specialized books. They report Reich's activities which are much talked about though little understood, to the police and to the F.B.T. as "communist", without any pasie in fact, which is a second to the contract of the communist.

Reich's activities have been thoroughly investigated by the F.B.I. in 1941, and again in 1946, when Wilhelm Reich was naturalized as an American citizen. He also was in touch repeatedly with the F.B.I. and the Atomic Energy Commission in regard to drucial research matters some of which are to be treated confidentially under present conditions.

and status that he bondemus the normunists as red fascists and his writings give full evidence that he is a most persistent fighter for self-regulation in education and self-government in society. 



#### Gentlemen:

We believe it is a basic characteristic of a truly free man's mind to some out into the open completely and to have his hands and deeds above board; not to sneak around behind other people's backs, but to give it stright off the bat. Our letter concerns the following:

We, i.e., the scientific and other workers of the Orgone Institute and the Wilhelm Reich Foundation at Orgonon, have lived and worked in this region for some years now. We know most of the citizens in this region, and everybody knows of us. We have brought knowledge, a thirst for further knowledge, a truthful mind, and much money into this region. We have also helped many people in this region medically. We know we are liked and on good terms with most of the people around here. We are decent, homest, hard-working people. Our work is known and highly appreciated in many lands.

Now, after the upheaval around the lecture given by Dr. Elsworth F. Baker at Orgonon in the end of August has blown over, we may be permitted to tell you the following:

A fellow from Oquossoc by the name of "illiam Fowler has succeeded in stirring up rumors about Orgonon, bad, malicious, pernicious rumors. He and some of those who took over and spread his gossip have caused the Governor of the State of Haine and the local FBI to "investigate." Nothing was found because there was no truth in the rumors. However, the same Fowler or somebody else of the same type might get the idea again of disturbing our strenuous work and of smearing our honor. This will not happen again. We are hard-working people. We have no time to counteract malignant gossip by a very few frustrated and ill people.

We do not run a brothel as the Fowlers with their rumors imply; we have nothing to hide, we do not conduct sexual orgies and we are not "communists." Mr. Sharaf did not run after girls in town at night, and Peter Reich did not expose himself in school; he was forced to do so by a group of boys en the school grounds. We do not seduce small children and we do not commit sexual crimes on adolescent boys and girls. We do not "feed" patients to doctors; we do not sleep with another partner every night. We have no machine gums but only a telescope and scientific instruments in our observatory, and when there are lights in the windows at 3 or 4 in the morning, some one is sitting at his desk and taking readings or doing some writing or calculating.



Thus, there to reason to get excited about this in the observatory during the night.

To want peace for our hard work and we are going to get it. We do not tolerate malignant rumors lying down. We are not permitting anyone to spit in our face; we do not retaliate by spitting back, but we insist that people know who the spitters are. This kind of gossiping does more harm to a walf-royerning people than the Stalins and Hitlers who use the slanderers to serve their own ends. It disrupts mutual confidence and peace. Thus gossip and slander help the dictators take over a free country. Slander is not free speech but misuso of the right to free speech. Slander and gossip are threatening the lives of a free people everywhere in the U.S.A. as well as in other lands. This is what shuts people up from telling the truth and being upright. They are afraid of being maligned and gosciped about. But we are not, since we are, as psychiatrists, physicians, and scientists, as well as educators, in the forefront of the fight against the emotional plague which undermines human peaceful living. It is our social obligation to fight rumormongers, in order to save babies from disease and distress. We are highly responsible American citizens doing an important job. Our medical and scientific results and ideas are publicly available in nearly every major library in the land. The way to fight those results and ideas if one dislikes them is by argument and not by gossip. We fight gossip professionally as a cancer in the body social. e must succeed in using this if truth should prevail and govern our lives.

If anyone has any question to ask, we shall be glad to answer him. We shall be happy to do so.

The following interview took place around the time of the State Investigation of Organom by state trooper Hennessy some time and aller Fudge Hills Mad received a phone ball from a Mr. Delancy who shadaw said he was an F. R. I. agent, concerning Organon. Miss Dreger was upset by the interview and reported it on Oct. 25 to Miss Ollendorff and Mr. Sharaf of the Wilhelm Reich Foundation at Organon.

The F.B.I. man showed Miss Dreger his credentials. He said that he had a number of signed statements from some of the people in the term about the camp. He had heard that it was a "nudist camp." Miss Dreger replied that it was not. The agent seemed skeptical and asked: "Sure about that?" Miss Dreger replied that no one made it a practise to go nude, that the children were never nude in tewn or when visitors were around, and there were very few instances of the children being nude at all. 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THE GONOMIC ANTI-NUCLEAR RADIATION ROJECT (ORANUR)

On December 3rd, 1950, a meeting was held in the research laboratory at Orgonial which dealt with the task of concentrating the work of the staff upon the anti-nuclear radiation effects of orgone energy.\* The following medical effects of orgone energy were well elaborated and well known for many years, since about 1940. The eleber aummarized in a report given by Wilhelm Reich to the Trustees of the Wilhelm Reich Foundation at the annual meeting on August 50th, 1950:\*\*

September 6, 1950

To the Board of Trustees of the Wilhelm Reich Foundation Orgonon, Rangeley, Me.

#### Gentlemen:

I am referring to the discussion we had at the last annual meeting on August 50th, 1950, concerning the responsibility involved in conveying the importance of our knowledge about the medical effects of organe energy in case of a renewed strenuous war effort. It is, especially, the great danger of damage by nuclear radiation which constitutes the main worry in the United States. It has been known to me and some of our physicians for a long time that organe energy counteracts nuclear radiation. I would like to summarize the following points which are especially concerned with possible application against nuclear radiation effects:

- 1. Blood System. It is to be expected that a bio-energetically strongly charged organism will resist the damage inflicted by nuclear radiation much better than a bio-energetically weak organism. The bio-energetic strength of an organism is, according to observations over a period of about 15 years now, especially reflected in the behavior of the blood system, particularly the red blood cell system. It has been established beyond any doubt that by means of the organe energy accumulator, the blood system can be charged bio-energetically to a very high degree. Thus, the bio-energetic strength and resistance of the organism are heightened. Many physicians working with organe energy have found invariably that such chronic conditions as chills, colds and so-called low resistance are alleviated if organe energy is applied over long periods of time and regularly. Thus, understandably, also the disposition to pneumonia could be reduced. I omit here more details which can be submitted at any time.
- 2. Tissues. It has been established that orgone energy as applied by the orgone accumulator has a strong vagotonic effect, i.e., that blood supply and turgor of the tissues are greatly increased. From well-known medical principles it follows that well-charged tissues and organs will resist damage to a much greater extent than weak tissues.
  - 3. Wound Healing. One of the most important effects of orgone energy

application is a quack and nearly perfect healing of even severe wounds and burns by means of direct irradiation of the damaged region. For instance, severe damage due to 2nd and 3rd degree burns is alleviated, and the worst effects are prevented if the severely burned region is irradiated with organizating immediately after the accident occurs. Blisters do not occur and the pain is reduced after a few minutes. Wounds due to cuts are healed quickly and cleanly. Old resilient ulcers are healed under the influence of direct organe energy radiation by means of an acute inflammation which sets in the second region and replaced dead tissue by new granulating tissue. This may suffice to indicate the direction in wound healing.

4. Alleviation of Pain. Orgone energy, if applied directly to an aching region, has the effect of at least greatly reducing acute pain. These effect have been studied in such cases as acute pain in cancer, rheumatism, migrain neuritis, cuts, and similar conditions. It is therefore to be expected that immediate application of direct orgone energy irradiation would greatly help to alleviate pains in cases of severe wounds due to shells, bullets, fracture etc.

5. Shock. It has been established that due to the strongly vagotonic effect of organe energy, shock reactions are at least diminished, and recovery is speeded up by total irradiation of the organism with organe energy, since shock is mainly due to a sudden severe sympatheticotonic contraction of the organism.

The above mentioned points are far from giving a complete picture. However, they may suffice to indicate what tromendous benefits could be derived from a general application of orgone energy in cases of emergencies such as atomic warfare, epidemics, etc. Last, but not least, I would like to mention a point which, at present, is no more than a prospect, but a very helpful one. Lack of appropriate financial means has hitherto made it impossible to pursue the following line of research:

Nuclear radiation, for instance radium, is changed under the influence of concentrated orgone energy. The kind and the extent of such change is still very obscure. However, it can be conscientiously stated that these effects or orgone energy upon nuclear radiation could be elaborated in a short time with the appropriate means. Here it may suffice to state that orgone energy represents cosmic energy BEFORE MATTER, in contradistinction to nuclear radiation which is radiation after matter as handled by the Atomic Energy Project. It is understandable why I restrict the communication concerning this point to a mere indication.

Would you be kind enough to transmit this communication to the appropriate authorities of the Atomic Energy Commission. I felt it my duty in these trying times to press toward awakening not only interest but also medical conscience regarding these matters in the responsible military and government circles. It would not take much money to elaborate the abovementioned effects to the satisfaction of medicine and for the safety of our country. I would therefore appreciate it highly if you were kind enough to exert your influence and your position to carry those suggestions to their full realisation.

The approach to the project of experimentation with nuclear radiation effects required clear definition of the pathological functions in radiation sickness which could be linked up with similar or identical lesions in general pathology which had already been made accessible to orgone energy treatment.

in the state of th

Abrasions, lacerations, and burns are not specific nuclear radiation effects. They could be regarded as belonging to general pathology, known to be accessible organe treatment by means of local organe energy application.

The real problem was the specific radiation sickness consisting of deteriorated and degeneration of blood and tissues, of hemorrhages due to inner lesions, of decay of the blood cell system, loss of hair, weight, gonovil decline of biological and final death. Would these specific effects of muclear radiation be accessful to organe energy treatment?

The anti-nuclear radiation research project had to concentrate on this problem it could be divided into three major groups:

1. Is it possible to establish a certain degree of IMMUNITY, as it were, age nuclear radiation effects?

In order to answer this question, one group of mice is to be kept irradiated prophylactically with organe energy over a period of several weeks. Then half a this group is to be injected with radioactive material in half-lethal and the other half with lethal doses. The actual result would answer the question whether preventive organe energy treatment had any chance at all, and if so, to what extended the preventive treatment would be effective. It was assumed that it would not too complicated to draw conclusions regarding human beings from the results achieved in mice.

The outlook on the possibilities of partial immunisation of the population against atomic energy effects well in advance of actual warfare and atomic bomb: thus seemed promising: It is entirely reasonable to assume that highly charged biosystems would at least offer greater resistence to the degenerative processes caused by nuclear radiation. Details could easily be elaborated with the necessequipment and personnel.

2. Is it at all possible to STOP, to undo, or to our nuclear radiation eff: without prior immunization?

In order to answer this question, a large group of healthy mice should be injected with a half-lothal dose of nuclear radiation material. One half of this group should be treated with orgone energy by means of the accumulator, the trement beginning soon after the injection of the radioactive material. This would the model of the assumed situation of a group in the population just having beau affected by half-lethal nuclear radiation in the vicinity of where an atomic beau had been dropped. It is further assumed that this group of people had not suffer any direct burns or other wounds. It would fall under the class of victims which develops the radiation sickness during the weeks following the blast.

The effective dosage of organo energy is to be worked out by either doubling redoubling the time of organotic irradiation or by doubling and redoubling the strongth of the accumulator or by both.

In order to obtain reliable preventive and curative results in the realm of lethal affliction with radiation sickness, it is indispensable to establish the kind of degeneration in tissues and blood. In this realm medical orgonomy is already well equipped, due to 15 years of experimentation with degenerative processes in the cancer biopathy and other diseases. It is highly probable that radiation sickness does not basically differ from other diseases where degenerat of tissue and blood is involved. Only the cause of the degenerative process is different from other diseases, not the process itself, except in regard to the rapidity of the decline.

We know from ample experimental observation that tissue decay due to Xray radition yields, though not easily, to organe energy treatment. Deep burns due to Xi heal out, often completely. It is therefore not precluded that nuclear radiation decay will yield too.

The basic mechanism of this healing process consists in blood pouring into the diseased region, in rejuvonation of the still healthy tissue in the surrounding in sequestration and elimination of the dead tissue and its replacement by new galating tissue.

All tissue degeneration so far studied takes the route of development of T-bo
i.e., bions with little organe energy, from the degenerating tissues. This T-p:
ccss rules the degenerative processes in cancer, and also, as we now find, to ar
even higher degree in leukemia. It is to be expected that it is also at work in
radiation sickness. It is impossible at this time to predict how the experiment
will have to be carried on in order to answer this question practically; but one
T-character of radiation sickness is established, we shall travel in well-known
territory. To teach the new techniques of T-cultivation and T-observation to
physicians and technicians will then be comparatively easy.

5. Where is the borderline, if any, of the efficacy of orgone energy irradi. in lethal cases of radiation sickness?

This most vital question cannot be answered before concrete information has be obtained with regard to questions 1 and 2. It will obtain its proper answer in time, and, so we hope, with as few victims of our ignorance as possible. To redumnecessary dying from lethal radiation sickness it will be most important to devent to the preventive part of the total job, as fully and as efficiently as possible.

A further great possibility consists in constructing bomb shelters in such a

manner that they note by function as or one energy as unlaters thus accomplishing a double effect: first, keeping the paople inside charged, and second, reflecting nuclear radiation to the outside.

- 10. A loosely organized but highly interested fringe of scientific, medical, educational, and other workers on the lost coast, in the Kiddle Nest, in New Yerk Montreal, England, Scandinavia, South America, etc.
- ll. A fully organized and registered Press, the Organe Institute Press, equipment to handle all publication matters and capable of rapid growth, with connections through mailing lists all over the world. The present finances available are of control sufficient to meet fully the needs resulting from the international crisis.

- g. The Organo Institute Diagnostic Clinic and the Organe Energy Clinic is organomic bio-energetic tests and examinations in Forest Hills, New York;
  - h. Training of physicians, educators, and social workers;
  - i. Preparation of the organomic anti-nuclear radiation project;
  - j. Preparation of further building of facilities;
  - k. Guidance in scientific matters on an international scale.

Once the basic possibility is given, it is a matter of equipment and skill as well as organization to cope with disaster. If we circles, powerful as they may be, which are economically interested in suppring the dangerous competition of organomic medicine, will, so we hope, step as a modestly and decently, and will not try or dare to disturb or even to prevent the excuse for such procedure due to pecuniary interests when millions of human live are involved. We know there are such sharks in the world, but even sharks, we believe, how hearts and some degree of consideration. So do not try to smear the great effort. It will only help the murderous enemy of life.

Let us not fail to prepare in time against the disaster which threatens all ous. Let us give full and continuous information to all peoples in the world thread by atomic warfare. There is at present no more sacred duty than this one, only for physicians, but also for military men, if they truly presecute the savior life and freedom. Those who will obstruct or try to prevent this job from fulfillment will show up clearly as the true enemies of mankind, without employ of secret police, political denunciation, or rigmarcle. FRIVENTION OF RADIATION SICKNESS AND DEATH - is the watchword for every decent physician and health admistrator from now enward. The scener this realisation dawns upon the responsible circles in the USA and abroad the better, the fewer victims will there be. WHO DARE TO STAND UP AGAINST IT?

The hour is at land to prove one's contentions of doals by deed beyond work.

Let us not miss this heartscarching task. Let us not for a second forget that

the eyes of all the future, yet unborn generations of mankind are upon us, sear.

In reference to the correspondence forwarded to the Bureau by MYRON R. SHARAF, Assistant in Public Relations, the Wilhelm Reich Foundation, it should be noted that the Bureau's investigation pertaining to the Foundation ceased on September 20, 1950. When SHARAF's letters dated October 26 and November 6, 1950 were received by this office I immediately contacted Special Agent relative to the possibility that further inquiry had been made in this case, inasmuch as the Boston files reflected the same to be in a closed status.

, in advising that no further FBI incuiry had been Special Agent made in this matter, confidentially ascertained from that the latter had conducted some investigation of this organization

further Edvised that in his investigation he had interviewed Miss LEAH DREGER, Rolling Hills Farm, Rangeley, Maine, on October 3, 1950.

As a result of this information I, in answer to Mr. SHARAF's letter, wrote the latter that the interview and investigation which he was then complaining of were not conducted by the FBI. For the information of subsequently the Bureau, that in the early part of December, 1950 Mr. SHARAF advised Agent telephonically called him from Rangeley, Maine about admitted to SHARAF that he had this interview with Miss DREGER. and the substance thereof.

PURPOSE:

To advise you of additional information concerning the captioned organization.

#### BACKGROUND:

Following the receipt of several complaints from private citizens of Rangeley, Maine, an investigation of captioned organization was conducted by the Boston Office in September, 1950. This investigation disclosed that this organization is essentially a cancer research laboratory and failed to disclose any activity contrary to the security of this country.

#### DETAILS:

By letter dated November 13, 1950, Myron R. Sharaf, Assistant in Public Relations of captioned organization, enclosed copies of communications directed to our Boston Office concerning an alleged interview between a Bureau agent and Miss Leah Dreger concerning captioned institution in which the Jureau Agent was charged with acting in a "heavy-handed" manner. The Boston Office was requested to furnish the Bureau with their observation in this matter.

The Bureau is now in receipt of a reply from the Boston Office dated December 16, 1950, which reflects that the above interview with Miss Leah Dreger was actually conducted

There is attached hereto a pamphlet entitled, "Oranur Project" and an order blank.

The Bureau has previously received information from the Wilhelm Reich Foundation which appears to be a personal project of Wilhelm Reich, who signs himself as an M. D. This literature factor and information has concerned what he chooses to call "Orgone Energy" and various other high sounding terms derived from this subject as "organomic" and oranur" which were apparently originated by him and have no scientific meaning other than that which he attaches to them. His definitions are original to say the least and, for the most part, have no meaning or consist of just so much double-talk from the standpoint of accepted scientific theories at this time.

Previous information which has been received has been considered the personal project of an eccentric who has laid broad claims for what "organe energy" can do. Nost any problem or illness can be taken care of, including loss of hair, decay of the blood cell system, and even degeneration itself.

The attached pamphlet and order blank appears, however, to be soliciting funds to carry out the expenses of this "organomic" research. We replied: "Rangeley, Maine." "For what reasons?" he asked. "I am going to The Wilhelm Reich Foundation for scientific reasons." We were then asked to come into the effice of the custems house. He then asked us what we thought of communisum, and I said we were against it, and that we were friends of the U.S.A. He then asked me about Dr. Reich's beliefs on that scere, and I replied that Dr. Reich was against communism, and a friend of the U.S.A. How do you know that he is against Atmenmism?" he asked. "Because he speaks and writes against it," I replied. "But isn't it pessible to speak and write against it, and still believe otherwise?" he asked. "Dr. Reich doesn't do things that way," I replied. And then I added that the communists themselves are against him. My wife then said: "The PBI investigated him and everything is all right." He then said that if we were not allowed entry into the U.S.A. it was no reflection on Ms. but because of some doubts which they had about Dr. Reich's beliefs. I then asked who it was that was doubtful, and he replied that if he teld us, it would be giving away things about how they worked. My wife then said that Dr. Reich was doing very important work in cancer, and the efficial agreed that that might be se. I then said that if we were not allowed entry into the U.S.A. it would be interfering with the leukemia research I was doing. He said that he did not intend it that way, but I replied that it would have that consequence in any case. He then said that we should wait for some time in the car, and that he would think it ever. After waiting for some time in the car, the same official came out to applegize for the delay but said that the matter was now in the hands of the assistant executive officer. He then met the man (the assistant executive officer) near where our car was standing, and after some conversation between these two men, we were allowed entry into the U.S.A. All in all'we were delayed for an hour.

On our return to Ganada on the following day, we met the same efficial and we were allowed through without incident.

The name of the U.S.A. official who questioned us was Daniel Obliskey. His maden

was courteous throughout, and my own feeling is that he was acting on instructions from his superiors to feel out the situation and to pass his impressions on to his superior efficer.

There is attached a letter from the Winner Seich Foundation et a Myron R. Sharaf, Assista O ver for Public Relations, ch concerns the pseudo scientific organization of Wilhel Reach. We are quite familiar with this project for which many wild claims have been made, but which has no sound scientific basis. According to the claims of previous literature "orconon energy" can do most anything from preventing loss of heir to curing concer. The terms used by Dr. Reich and his followers are their own inventions and have no meaning other than that ascribed by them. Recause of the claims of Dr. Reich for their antinuclear research, the Atomic Energy Commission looked into the project and described Dr. Reich as mentally unsound.

When literature which had he received over a period of time by the Bureau first indicat. that a solicitation of junds was being made, the Bureau referred this to the Post Office Department. We have not been informed of the action they have tcken.

Insofar as any scientific or laboratory angle is concerned. I do not feel the attached letter should be answerei. It will be noted, however, that the last sentence refers to the detention of Wilhelm Reich in 1941 by the Bureau as an error, the repetitin of which they are seeking to prevent. According to the file (100-14601) Dr. Wilhelm Reich was the subject of a security matter case and was apprehended as an enemy alien on December 12. 1941, and subsequently released.



The officers A. Harris Kenyon, Robert B. heller, and Karl W. Brimmer are, respectively, Food and Drug Inspector, Physicist, and Hedical Officer of the Food and Drug Administration, each being duly authorized by the Administrator to, among other things, make factory inspections and confuct investigations pursuant to the authority granted in section 704 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (Title 21, section 374, U.S.C.A.). Additionally, these three officers were specifically instructed by competent authority in the Food and Drug Administration to make the inspection and investigation in question. At the time of the attempted inspection they fully identified themselves by badges and other official identification and clearly stated their purpose and the nature of the visit.

Acquiescence in such inspections on the part of the owner or custodian of such premises is a legal duty and, further, this office received prior to the attempted inspection a specific written invitation from the Reich Foundation, offering to furnish any information sought if contacted at its place of business.

Several of us have just completed a careful analysis of your two bulletins "The Organe Energy Accumulator" and "The Orange Experiment". From the description of your experiment and the results obtained from Orange, we have some to the following conclusions:

- 1. Such types of experimentation usually are little recognised as long as the results and procedures are of small magnitude.
  - 2. Paychosometic weaknesses need far more definitions than they now have.
- 3. A large scale experiment such as yours affecting a wide area and in a highly populated area of high organs energy content should produce widespread symptoms in a group of the population who are not aware of the probable effects and could therefore not be explained away on the basis of suggestion as so many acception have implied.
- 4. Such a large scale experiment also could not be explained away on the basis of high CO2 content of the restricted atmosphere in a small volume. (See O2 = CO2 therepy methods).
- 5. If the area around Tujunga, Attadens etc. became an area where old allergies flared up violently instead of being alleviated, then the experiment would be ideally proven a success.
- 6. We have accordingly, with the above points in mind, put together a large accumulator using a new kind of plastic insulation and thin sheet steel in many layers which yields to date an indication that it is at present approximately a 100 feld accumulator. We were somewhat surprised to observe the rather large delays in discharge rates of electroscopes and condensers in such a setup.

It is intended now to locate this accumulator in a spot close to the edge of the L.A. area but in a locally isolated spot inside the abandoned steelbody of an old refrigerated truck. Inside this accumulator will be a place for, at first, approximately 5 pounds of borrowed Uranium salts since this material is easily obtained.

If after a period of two months, no large rise in complaints at the local hospitals and doctors offices of the area, and no definite night time luminos sence is observed, the Uranium will be considered to be too weak a source to produce a definite effect and it will be replaced by approximately 20mg of Radium. The whole unit can be locked and no trouble with this very should be encountered in connection with the borrowed radium.

observed in your bulletin, the definite results should show progressively further from the source and very quickly reach the laboratories at Calif. Institute of Technology in Pasadena. When their background count rises, and stays up, there should be no remaining doubt in anyone's mind that the reaction is real, and large amounts of money should then be available for the study of such phanomena. Of course, the lesstion of source and people involved will have to be kept quiet or denied until concrete data have been gathered. This letter is to give you an idea of the pattern of events to come so that if the news carries strange material it will not be unintelligible to you.

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



#### DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

Attorney General Herbert Brownell, Jr., announced today that a plaint has been filed seeking a permanent injunction to prevent interstate shipment of so-called orgone energy accumulator devices.

The complaint was filed in the United States District Court in Portland, Maine, at the request of the Food and Drug Administration.

Defendants are the Wilhelm Reich Foundation, a Maine corporation, and Dr. Wilhelm Reich and his wife, also known as Ilse Ollendorff, all of Tours of the large Rangeley, Maine.

Reich claims to have discovered a form of energy present in the atmospher. for which he coined the term "orgone energy." He claims this alleged "energy" has therapeutic value and is beneficial in the treatment, cure and prevention of a wide variety of ailments ranging from colds and bruises to cancer, bone fractures and the effects of atomic warfare.

Devices for sale and rent are said to accumulate this alleged energy and transmit it to the bodies of sick individuals. The devices include boxes large enough to hold an adult and smaller models such as a "Shooter Box", "Orgone Energy Blanket" and "Orgone Energy Funnel." Over 1,000 have been sold at prices from \$15 to \$225. Also sold have been books and other publications describing the theories and the devices.

The Food and Drug Administration conducted extensive investigations. concluded there is no energy such as "orgone" and that the devices are worthle in the treatment of any disease condition. The devices are charged to be misbranded under the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act because of false and mis-MUEXID AT 1054 leading claims.

The complaint asks that the defendants and all individuals and associations or corporations working with them or for them be enjoined from directly or indirectly introducing or causing to be delivered for introduction into interstate commerce any such devices, parts or accessories or any similar article. The complaint also seeks an injunction against any written or oral act which results in such devices being misbranded.

Senator Margaret Chase Smith called for me today. was tied up at the moment and she told one of the girls in my office that a Mr. AsayRichardson, an attorney at Phillips, Maine, had a story W he wished to convey to the Bureau; he had wanted to talk to the Director and she had suggested to him the Director should not be disturbed on a matter of this type; that she would appreciate it if I could see him and then tukn kim over to someone else.

I did see Richardson and he advised me his law firm represents a Dr. Wilhelm Reich, Rangeley, Maine. He is the founder of the Wilhelm Foundation; is a rather difficult person to deal with; is ,a psychiatrist by professional training; was arrested by the FBI as an alien enemy during the early part of World War II; he doubts Reich was cooperative with us or with anybody else. Recently the Pure Food'and Drug Administration of the Department of Agriculture initiated an injunction proceedings against Reich restraining his transporting his wares in interstate commerce. Richardson stated his client has instructed this motion could not be argued in court for two reasons, namely, the scientific and technical aspects were too involved for the court to pass on and, secondly, national, security was involved in that his discovery paralleled the atomic energy developments. Since national security was involved, according to his client, he thought he should come directly to us. In the first instance, pursuant to his client's instruction, he would like to get together with the agency of government concerned and, secondly, from a selfish standpoint, Richardson wondered if Dr. Reich was the type of person he should become involved with, even in an attorney-client relationship.

I told Richardson I, of course, could not advise him on this; that I would have to check to ascertain if we had any current interest in this matter. Richardson also stated he has an appointment to see the General Counsel of the Food and Drug Administration on Thursday. Richardson we could not advise him as to what he should do with reference to the attorney-client relationship and I did not know if the Bureau had any interest in Dr. Reich and whether we would be interested in even talking to 105-11461-33 him.

I checked and ascertained we have had considerable correspondence and some checks made on this person. He is carrying on cancer research and his research consists of a specially built box wherein an individual sits in the box for a period of two hours and breathes the air from the inside of the box through a tube. Apparently Dr. Reich has become somewhat of a local problem in Rangeley and the Town Manager advised in 1950 that Reich's writings were barred from the public library in Rangeley since he had advocated early sexual relations for children in the treatment of cancer. Senator Smith in October, 1950, furnished information from a local constituent on her suspicion of the Reich Foundation. We simply acknowledged this.

We had checked with the Atomic Energy Commission on Reich's claims in 1951 and the Atomic Energy Commission stated they had looked into his project and described Dr. Reich as mentally unsound. The Immigration and Naturalization people have also been checking into Dr. Reich.

I advised Richardson we had no current interest in Dr. Reich and he might wish to check with Immigration and Naturalization. (Reich has been having trouble with IN&S who have been checking on him). I also advised him he might want to check with the Atomic Energy Commission...... Richardson expressed his appreciation.

Since Senator Smith had stated she would like for me to call her, I did return her call. I told her I had seen Richardson; that we had no current interest in the Reich Foundation; that I had told Richards he might want to check with the Atomic Energy Commission, IN&S and he had already made appointments to check with the Food and Drug Administration. Senator Smith stated she was most appreciative of the courtesy extended to Richardson. She commented on my recent session with her wherein we had discussed the Bureau's activities and stated she had enjoyed that session and she hoped the next time we meet we could discuss a more pleasant subject matter; that she had given an awful lot of thought to our session and she hoped we could get better acquainted and we would find her a very reasonable person. I do not know exactly what this means.

Confidence in justice must be restored.

This birdseys view should be strictly adhered to in the consideration of the material on "COMSPIRACY"; if it were to be handled from a merci political or legalistic, formalistic point of view, it may well be take the political or legalistic formalistic point of view, it may well be take the take that the meaning the WHOLE OF THE POPULATION OF THE USA WOULD HAVE COALLED REFORE COURTS OF JUSTICE in the pursuit of elimination of under conspiring from our lives. However, a prosecution of the majority of population is never possible. It is possible, however, to keep the leacord with human knowledge.

SYNOPOSIS: By reference from the Director's Office, Noise was interviewed in Crime Records on March 23 and again on March 24, 1954. He had come from Organe Institute to present to the Director a number of documents which he alleges are proof of a "red fascist instigated pl against Orgone Institute and the United States. The work of this institute has been discredited by the Atomic Energy Commission, and t Attorney General, at the request of Pure Food and Drug Administration has requested, and reportedly obtained, an injunction to stop interstate distribution of the institute's apparatus and literature. 1666 was advised that apparently this matter did not come within the Burc' jurisdiction. The documents he made available consists primarily of magazine articles and letters showing that the institute's work has attacked from all quarters and has often been labeled a fraud. Moin insisted on leaving the material, stating that he did not see how to Bureau could disclaim jurisdiction without reviewing the matter. He arbised that he could not be notified as to action being taken or co whether any action was being taken. Then he was denied a receipt, asked that the Director write his boss, Reich, to acknowledge receip of the material.

<u>PECOPMENDATIONS: (1) That the material left by Moise be reviewed in </u> Crime Records to make sure it does not pertain to any matters within Bureau's jurisdiction.

(2) That any material which it is not deemed a just to retain be returned to Orgone Institute.

(3) That attached letter acknowledging receipt of the material be sent to Reich.

By reference from the Director's Office, Voise was interviewed by Special Agent of Crime Records, at 5:40 P.K., on March 23, 1954. His mission was that Moise, representing Reich, had been sent to turn over to the Bureau a large number of documents, from the archives of Organe Institute, which allegedly proved a "red fast instigated plot" against the United States. Moise insisted he desired to give this material personally to the Director and he could not impediately be convinced that this was impossible. Fe could not discouraged from trying again and the interview was terminated.

Again by reference from the Director's Office, Moise was interviewed by Special Agent at 10:35 A.H., on March 24, 1954. He had decided to make the information available to Special Agent and he produced from his suitcase a large number of documents such ... copies and clippings of magazine articles and correspondence which purported to show that the discrediting of Peich's work is the result of a "red fascist instigated plot." The magazine articles consists. primarily of items from popular publications such as Colliers, Satu Evening Fost, Saturday Review of Literature, and the Journal of the American Medical Association, exposing the work of Reich for the fromthat it is. A brief examination of the documents failed to reflect anything within the Bureau's jurisdiction, and Loise was so advised. He was persistent, however, in his request that the Bureau accept to material and review it thoroughly. He made the pertinent point that 🎥e did not see how the Bureau could advise him definitely that it he no jurisdiction unless the documents were reviewed. He was given 🐀 interstand that if the Bureau did accept the information, he could abe advised as to what action was being taken nor even as to whether any action was being taken. He was satisfied with this and stated t he merely wanted to make the information available for the Bureau's files. His request for a receipt was refused on the basis of police he requested that the Director write a letter to Dr. Reich acknowle

Moise explained that, as a result of tinjunction obtained against his work, Reich had decided to flood the East Coast with rain to prove the value of his experiments. One of the applications of "orgone" energy ostensibly is the control of weather conditions.

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

Tou will recall that on 3-24-54 William S. Moise, representing captioned individual turned over to M of Crime Records certain documents which Reich and Moise allege to be proof of a "rea faci instigated plot" against Orgone Institute. Moise maintained that the Bur could not possibly arrive at the conclusion that this material does not relate to any matter within the Bureau's jurisdiction without examining the material. On 3-29-54 SA received a registered package from Hoi: containing additional similar material.

Files reflect that the work of this Institute has been discred by the Atomic Energy Commission and the Food and Drug Administration rece obtained an injunction to prevent them from distributing their literature and apparatus. A thorough review of the material left by Moise shows it merely a collection of the articles and letters which have been written exposing the Institute for the fraud that it is. It is, therefore, being recommended that the material be mailed, registered, return receipt requested, back to Reich, and letter so advising him has been prepared.

The Bureau has also received a telegram dated 3-30-54 from 11: Allendorf of the Wilhelm Reich Foundation stating that the Bureau will b kept informed of developments in connection with the injunction against the foundation. In view of the background, it is not deemed advisable to acknowledge this or similar communications in the future.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the material left by Moise be returned registered material return receipt requested, under separate cover, and attacletter so advising Reich besent to him.

That the current telegram from Ollendorf and similar communications in the future not be acknowledged.

It will be recalled that on March 25, 1954, William Solloise stopped at the Bureau to present us with a great humber of documents proportedly showing a conspiracy against the captioned foundation and the United States. These documents were reviewed, and it was found that they pertained to nothing within the Bureau's jurisdiction. were returned to the foundation by registered mail.

Since above foundation is a pseudo-scientific organization which has been discredited by the Pure Food and Drug Administration and the Atomic Energy Commission, an earlier memorandum recommended that we not acknowledge further communications from them dealing with similar matters. The recommendation was approved.

We have now received from Moise a statement concerning the delivery by him of this material to us. also states a receipt was promised. Actually, he was specifically informed that none could be given him. Since this statement is a carbon copy and in view of the earlier recommendation, it is not deemed advisable to reply.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the statement from Koise not be acknowledged.

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# ONLY FORMALITIES COUNT (From Reich's The Murder of Christ)

The closer the future victim is to the Kingdom of God with his knowledge, the surer will he be chosen to be murdered by the pestilent character. All this goes on with not a single soul, not even the murderer himself, being aware of what is happening. Sun or to believe in a Soul of the Universe or in Universal Love or whether one has lectured here or lectured there, whether one has been decent all his life and committed only the blunder of meeting accidentally a pestilent sniper shooting from ambush. Nothing matters, since the true motive is the murder of Christ who could actually accomplish the dreaded realization of the Kingdom of God on Earth. It does not matter whether Jesus actually proclaimed himself as the King of the Jews or not. It is merely a pretext, and everybody is aware of this; therefore, nobody mentions it or does anything about it. The established law is geared to eternal seeking of the Kingdom of God, but not to the finding of the Kingdom of Heaven, not to the ways of Christ who knows the ways of the Kingdom of God. Only formalities count. Every appearance of fairness and precaution not to commit a judicial murder will be carefully guarded in order to commit the murder in the "proper, legal" ways. No one should ever be accused of injustice. The record of honor must remain clean. Everybody knows what has been done, and nobody moves a finger.

Much later, when the victim will have been long dead, when his screams to heaven in the evocation of God will have been silenced forever, when the myth of "justice done" will have evaporated, historians will dig out the facts, when all is fairly safe; and it might happen that a Pope kneels on the grave of one of the victims to restore his posthumous honor. Thank you, Sir! we hear the victim whisper. And God once more turns away from his Godlike creation, Man, and continues to send his prophets to preach in vast, empty deserts. Mocenigo is forgotten. Nobody investigated him, nobody even thought him guilty. though a few may despise him. More, there will be many that will tell you that Christ has been justly crucified, for he has acted as a common rebel against established government, that he had unnecessarily provoked the scribes, that he would better have sat still and quiet and left the souls of men alone in peace to sit it out forever and ever after. And books will be written and read by the multitude, books that tell you how to escape the truth about the Murder of Christ, how to obtain peace of mind. Don't touch it, ever!

# THE BOARD OF SOCIAL PSYCHIATRY (March, 1954)

By WILHELM REICH, M.D.

The socially pathological acts of the Emotional Plague belong before a Board of Social Psychiatry. The criminal results of an emotional conspiracy belong before a Board of Justice. Politicians, that is people who are not concerned with factual truth but solely with interests of power, have no access to either the factual functions nor to the judicial consequences of an Emotional Conspiracy. This is an entirely HUMAN affair. This affair transgresses all party lines with their narrow interests of vote-getting. It is a matter of international interest today, and not only one country; it transgresses national borderlines, just as Life itself transgresses all human borders and factional limitations. This is the new fact in the lives of all of us. This fact has far reaching consequences.

It is of great importance to recognize the emotional element of conspiracy as the true basis of its merely political manifestations. Human emotion, and not politics, is a primary function of society everywhere.

From this it follows that the Board of Social Psychiatry serves a more basic function in society than the Board of Justice. It is one of the New Facts in our lives that is becoming evident now. We begin to recognize that true justice must finally step out of its present, merely formalistic, legalistic procedures and include the human, the emotional, the factual element, in other words, the Fundamental element underlying the administration of social justice in human affairs; only great justices were able to practice it heretofore. Confidence in justice must

be upheld. True justice must never be a matter of chance, or a matter of the private opinion of judges or attorney generals.

This birdseye view should be maintained in consideration of the material on "Conspiracy"; if it were to be handled from a merely political or legalistic, formalistic point of view, it may well be certain that nearly the whole of the population of the u. s. a. would have to be called before the courts of justice in pursuit of the elimination from our lives of underhanded conspiring. Prosecution of the majority of the population is not possible nor desirable. What is possible, however, is to keep the law in accord with progress in human knowledge.

All this is part of the BIOLOGICAL REVOLUTION to which all of humanity finds itself subjected over the past few decades.

It is obvious that humanity is emotionally, that is, bio-energetically, sick. Politics and Powerdrunkeness are symptoms of this social disease; Power-drunkards are not and cannot be the judges of power-drunkenness, just as little as thieves can be judges of the social ill of thievery; nor can professional mass murderers be the counsels and judges of the social ill of mass murder. But cured power drunkards, cured thieves and cured mass murderers may well become excellent guides in Social Pathology.

Human ills belong to the vast, uncharted realm of Social Pathology. It is only Physicians and Educators, operating at the SICKBED OF SOCIETY who dare hope to exterminate this disease in a manner commensurate with this great task of medicine and education.

It will be possible, but it will not be easy, to keep the political power drunkard off the confines of this task by one single, simple question: "WHAT WOULD YOU, POLITICAL POWER SEEKER, ACTUALLY, FACTUALLY DO TO ELIMINATE THE HUMAN EMOTIONAL SICKNESS OF THE MAJORITY OF PEOPLE EVERYWHERE?" It can be shown that those who are out today to gain power by persecuting political foes would, once they themselves were put in the place of their enemy, be forced to act exactly the same way as the conspirator has always done out of ignorant politiciandom or out of malignancy.

# SUPREMACY OF BASIC RESEARCH (April 16, 1954)

By WILHELM REICH, M.D.

### Introduction

I owe my friends, coworkers and students, as well as all patients concerned, an explanation of why I did not appear in court as a "defendant". I did not appear as "defendant" (of WHAT?), because, after having experienced the FDA for eight years, I knew their motives and intentions, and I refused to be made a butt of malignancy. I would have gone in any case of a bona fide struggle. Still, I would not have permitted Basic Research to be judged or adjudged in court and in absence of discussion, in other words, by a hidden court dictate of hidden "control" experiments. I would have certainly damaged the standing of our science. And I would have, certainly, emerged as an already "convicted" defendant under the suspicion of "fraud" with the threat of a suit for fraud following. In this manner, however, I have maintained my honor, my work, I have not been convicted by "consent" or by "conviction". The case was decided without my participation in this unconstitutional act against truth; an act of aggression which would force the public to believe that I have spent in cash, unpaid time, effort and risk as well as pain, some 400,000 dollars worth in 18 years for my discovery; that I have donated the medical use of the OR energy for purposes of research, only in order to ... commit fraud which did not pay a cent. What utter, preposterous, stupid nonsense, perpetrated by people unworthy to be called public servants of the people, using district attorneys, judges and some few reporters.

WHO ARE THE CONSPIRATORS BEHIND THEM?

## Summary of the Clifford Injunction

I am directing this communication to all who know my work and to those who, in the course of events, will learn to know about it. This is only a survey of the factual situation; an extensive presentation will be published at a later date.

We shall survey:

- A. The procedures of the FDA;
- B. The basic issues involved in the Clifford Injunction;
- C. The factual, legal and moral position of Orgonomy.
- A. The Procedures of the FDA
- 1. From the historical material collected and printed in the Volume A-XII-EP "Conspiracy" "An Emotional Chain-reaction", it emerges unequivocally that the action of the FDA originated not in a bona fide investigation of a new medical remedy, but from the beginning, as a prejudiced, mala fide persecution of a discovery, executed on behalf of powerful pharmaceutic interests, unknown to us because they operate behind the scenes. Their intent was not only to kill the discovery, but to get the discoverer into jail as a fraudulent person; mark well, all this was set before the investigation really came under way in 1947-1948. At that time the conspirators, mechanists in pathology and neuropsychiatrists, were in collusion to destroy Orgonomy with conspirators among politicians.
- 2. This conspiracy on the part of pharmeceutic producers in the U.S.A., using slander and calumni, developed like an emotional chain-reaction; it involved the A.M.A., the Consumer's Union, several prominent newspapers and periodicals, and others; it was a true conflagration on the social scene. This conflagration ran its course on its own power. But, like a forest fire, it was started by a carelessly (or deliberately) thrown burning match; this match fell among tinder-dry wood brush. The match-thrower was the red fascist sniper. He and his followers had to do no more than throw the burning match. As in the affairs of the UN, here, too, the politically organized emotional plague rode toward evil goals on the back of the unorganized emotional plague, in dishonest business, corrupt medicine, politically biased persons, judges, attorneys, etc.
- 3. Once under way in this manner the mala fide nature of the FDA investigation ever since 1947 had all the earmarks of ill-willed, irrational action. This was shown, among other matters, in such procedures as follows:

- a. They carefully avoided to take into consideration any case that was clearly speaking against their preconceived plan to destroy Orgonomy. (See cases by Dr. S. Tropp, Lung Cancer, and others.)
- b. They refused to cooperate with the discoverer who offered to introduce them into the new research territory. They intended, like all bad government, to proceed on mere political authority.
- c. They started the investigation in 1947 with sexual defamation. This was stopped as soon as it was detected, by vigorous protests and withdrawal of our cooperation. (See their behavior at Orgone Institute Press, in Conspiracy.)
- d. They refused to learn what this discovery was all about. Control of discoveries cannot be carried out with such emotional background.
- e. They were doubtlessly pushed by some force in the background which seemed to be interested in the lists of names, the kind of instruments, the nature of the theory. (Who but the political Modju hoodlum would be interested in lists of names?)\*
- f. Their argument of "Promotional purposes" of our literature, easily disproved, was not given up, although they were informed of the fact that all income from the medical use of Orgone Energy Accumulators was not going to private individuals, but was used for research purposes only.
- g. Their argument appeared in the AMA Journal of January 8, 1949, in an article by a *chemist*, Smyth. Thus, *chemists* behind the FDA, and *chemists* in the AMA were in collusion. Every field office of the FDA is directed by a chemist.
- 4. The mala fide nature of the procedures of the FDA has shown up in the end in the character of the "Requests for Admissions" in the complaint, in the following manner:
- a. They did not mention the fact that more than two dozen physicians, duly licensed here and abroad, were experimenting with the medical qualities and promises, as well as the dangers, of the on energy.
- b. They heaped the experiences, gathered by these physicians in the course of some 14 year's work, on the shoulders of one man, WR, in such a manner that it now appeared as if this one physician, WR, had claimed cures for all kinds of ailments which had been published over

the years by dozens of physicians and scientists. Thus, they tried to create in court the impression of deliberate fraud.

c. From about 900 cases over the years, 98% of which were prescribed by their physician, they picked 10 cases for showing their cause, nine of these had applied on the basis of having read the literature, and among them many with non-medical records. Some of these were outright FDA plants. The many positive cases they deliberately omitted, just as they left unanswered my repeated statements on the non-curative, experimental nature of physical on therapy.

d. To the very end they avoided every single successfully treated case; thus proving again that they acted in a conspiracy to defraud the public of their right to the use of an important discovery in medicine.

Thus, red fascists who had thrown the burning match, American pharmaceutic interests, the medical practitioners depending financially on the powerful and ruthless as well as reckless drug manufacturers, medical societies and many others became involved.

## B. The Basic Issues Involved

- 1. Human irrationalism is acting as emotional plague on the social scene to destroy a discovery.
- 2. It is mechanistic technological man, who acts.
- 3. It is the fight between primordial, pre-atomic, cosmic energy (life energy) and atomic (deadly) energy.
- 4. It is a showdown between the forces of LIFE, scientifically still embryonic and the forces of DEATH, powerfully organized.
- 5. In Orgone Energy, cosmic functions including technological problems of space travel and space ships are involved.

### C. The Moral Position of Orgonomy

- 1. As a branch of BASIC NATURAL SCIENCE, Organomy denies the right to anyone to pass judgement on matters of basic natural scientific research either in court, or through any kind of governmental action or decree. This was expounded in the "Response" to the complaint sent in full confidence in the ability of Federal Judge Clifford to realize the nature of the complaint as well as the nature of the Discovery of the Life Energy.
- 2. All man-made law and political organization rests originally, and has always rested, on the operations of the human mind, on thinking about nature. All social organization has rested and will rest upon some

kind of natural philosophy, such as that of Plato, Locke, Hume, Rousseau, Marx, etc. Therefore, to concede the right to pass judgment on matters of basic research and thinking to courts or political governments that appoint judges politically, would inevitably amount to yielding authority on matters of human knowledge to the political powers that be. And this would mean the end of any chance for human freedom, happiness and development. This cannot possibly be conceded. Quest for human knowledge is and will be supreme, no matter how great the ephemeral political power to destroy the searchers for knowledge. The crimes perpetrated by political or psychopathic hoodlunks of the Beria type upon men like Bruno. Socrates, Galileo, must finally be stopped. The discovery of the Life Energy is here in its rightful place.

- 3. Every human being or citizen must have the right to choose the treatment for disease he likes best. He must not be coerced by well-hidden business interests to accept only one kind of treatment, dictated by commercial horsethieves.
- 4. The Clifford Injunction is manifestly unconstitutional. No one in the U.S.A., including judges, has the constitutional right to order the burning of books or their destruction in any other way. Once this would be permitted to happen, any political influence could be exerted upon judges to burn anything that threatens competition. We compete by way of better accomplishment, and not—ever—by way of slander, conspiracy, and political force. Not to resist this kind of procedure means abandoning ones responsibilities as a citizen. This is exactly what the black and red dictatorships succeeded in forcing upon millions of people.
- 5. The unconstitutional nature of the Clifford Injunction also appears in the fact that the complainant was represented by District Attorney Mills, who, from 1949 to 1951 had represented the Wilhelm Reich Foundation; he had not only functioned as its first legal clerk; he had also known the founders personally, he had defended their affairs, and he knew well that no shadow of suspicion of fraud, deliberate or not, could ever fall on the men he had learned to know in those years. He was present, furthermore, at a meeting where the conspiracy of the FDA was discussed before physicians and an attorney-at-law.
- 6. It is to be suspected that the pharmaceutic industry, incited to action by the red fascist sympathizers in 1947, and after the FDA cause had been abandoned in 1950, had revived it under the influence of Mr.

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mars anny ottoalso fine not, ars. Weeks, the Secretary of Commerce who, in the very beginning of his career, had tried to bludgeon scientists into submission. The role of Mr. Brownell is not certain, he probably acted in bona fide, though he should have looked into such a matter of great national importance more closely.

However the background may be constructed, there can be no doubt that this was a clear case of criminal collusion.

# ADMINISTRATION OF COSMIC ORGONE ENERGY\*

REGULATION OF ORGONE ENERGY ACCUMULATOR DISTRIBUTION

according to decisions at the 3rd Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees of The Wilhelm Reich Foundation, August 23, 1952.

1. It is necessary to distinguish clearly the medical use from the non-medical use of orgone energy.

The medical use of the Orgone Energy Accumulator must be under medical supervision, and is defined as the use of orgone energy, i.e., life energy, for the treatment of specific, acute diseases, such as acute colds, arthritis, rheumatism, shrinking biopathies, etc. For medical use, only rented accumulators for a certain, specified time, can be used.

The medical use of the Orgone Energy Accumulator is royalty-free, donated by Wilhelm Reich to The Wilhelm Reich Foundation. Application for the royalty-free use of the Orgone Energy Accumulators must be made yearly to the Orgone Institute, at the annual meeting of the Foundation.

2. The non-medical use of Orgone Energy is administered by the Orgone Institute which, in certain cases, can grant to the Foundation the right to use orgone energy in the non-medical field. Each application for non-medical use must be accompanied by a statement from a physician that the applicant does not suffer from an acute illness which requires medical supervision.

The non-medical use of orgone energy is to be compared with life-

strengthening swimming or other sports, sun-baths, etc., i.e., with such human activities as enhance the natural life energy metabolism in the organism.

The non-medical use of orgone energy is mainly preventive, just as are hikes, sea resort vacations, etc.

The non-medical use of orgone energy accumulators shall, under no circumstances, be submitted to the restrictive practices of the medical profession.

- 3. Procedure to obtain the medical use of organe energy:
  - a. Medical report from applicant's physician as to the nature of medically supervised illness.
  - b. Decision of the Orgone Energy Research Clinic whether or not to grant the medical use of the Orgone Energy Accumulator.
  - c. If the decision of the OERC is positive, the application will be handled in the usual way, i.e., after receipt of notarized application and the initial payment for the accumulator rental, the applicant will receive the accumulator through the central distribution place. All financial matters such as billing, etc., will be handled by The Wilhelm Reich Foundation in Rangeley. Medical users have to renew their application after two years' use.
  - d. In cases where there is doubt as to whether the accumulator is wanted for medical or non-medical use, the final decision rests with the Orgone Institute.
- 4. The income from the medical use of the Orgone Energy Accumulators can be used only for the purposes of basic natural scientific and medical research within the framework of The Wilhelm Reich Foundation.
- 5. The non-medical use of Orgone Energy i.e., Life Energy, is administered by the Orgone Institute, which can sell accumulator devices just as well as rent them. However, the rented devices are limited to certain periods of time, at the discretion of the Orgone Institute.

## An Administrative Law Needed

The responsible officers of The Wilhelm Reich Foundation are keenly aware of the necessity to give the discovery of the Cosmic Orgone Energy, and the devices which derive from this discovery, a practicable and appropriate legal administrative form. However, it is neither possible nor advisable to subsume devices which operate according to primordial on energy laws under the Food, Drug and Cosmetic act which

is administered by the Food and Drug Administration. OR energy is neither a food, nor a drug, nor a cosmetic, nor a device in the usual sense of the word as defined in the act on foods and drugs.

In order to reach a legally as well as factually valid decision in this matter, it is hereby submitted to obtain a first orientation by comparing the action of the layering of an Orgone Energy Accumulator to the layering of an atomic pile. The energy at work is basically the same. In the Orgone Energy Accumulator, the cosmic energy acts in its original, primordial form; in the atomic pile, it acts as secondary energy after—or liberated from—matter. However, the inter-action of alternative layers of organic and metallic materials is, in principle, the same.

Therefore, it is hereby proposed that a government agency which has no power and authority over atomic energy as developed in the atomic pile, including its devices, should likewise have no power and authority over the primordial cosmic energy and the devices derived from it. We are dealing in both cases, in the case of the primordial as well as the secondary—aftermatter—energy, with the same cosmic force.

Should the Atomic Energy Commission not be designated as the proper agency to deal with the Primordial Cosmic Orgone Energy, we would propose the creation of a new agency which would administer lawfully all matters and devices pertaining to the Primordial Cosmic Orgone Energy.

I am taking the liberty of transmitting to you my "Response" to the complaint filed by the Food and Drug Administration regarding the Orgone Energy Accumulator. My "Response" summarizes my standpoint as a natural scientist who deals with matters of basic natural law. It is not in my hands to judge the legal aspects of the matter.

My factual position in the case as well as in the world of science of today does not permit me to enter the case against the Food and Drug Administration, since such action would, in my mind, imply admission of the authority of this special branch of the government to pass judgment on primordial, pre-atomic cosmic organe energy.

## RESPONSE

Regarding the Request of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to Enjoin the Natural Scientific Activities of Wilhelm Reich, M.D.

In order to clarify the factual as well as the legal situation concerning the complaint, we must, from the very beginning, distinguish concrete facts from legal procedure to do justice to the facts.

Factually, the FDA is NOT "The US Government". It is merely one of its administrative agencies dealing with foods, drugs and connectics. It is not empowered to deal with Basic Natural Law.

ORGONOMY (see Bibliography on the History of Orgonomy") is a branch of BASIC NATURAL SCIENCE. Its central object of research is elucidation of the Basic Natural Law.

Now, in order to bring into line the legal procedure with the abovementioned facts, the following is submitted:

The common law structure of the United States rests originally on Natural Law. This Natural Law has heretofore been interpreted in various ways of thinking, metaphysically, religiously, mechanistically. It has never concretely and scientifically been subjected to natural scientific inquiry based upon a discovery which encompasses the very roots of existence.

The concept of Natural Law as the foundation of a secure way of life, must firmly rest upon the practical concrete functions of LIFE itself. In consequence, a correct life-positive interpretation of Natural Law, the basis of common law, depends on the factual elucidation of what Life actually is, how it works, what are its basic functional manifestations. From this basic premise derive the claims of natural scientists to a free, unmolested, unimpeded, natural scientific activity in general and in the exploration of the Life Energy in particular.

The complaint of the FDA is factually intimately interconnected with a basic social issue which, at present, is reverberating in the lives of all of us here and abroad.

Abraham Lincoln once said: "What I do say is that no man is good enough to govern another man without that other's consent. I say this is a leading principle, the sheet anchor of American republicanism."

At this point, I could easily declare "I refuse to be governed in my basic natural research activities by the Food and Drug Administration." But exactly here, in this constitutional right of mine, the basic confusion in the interpretation of Natural and Common Law becomes apparent.

There are conspirators around whose aim it is to destroy human happiness and self-government. Is now the right of the conspirator to ravage humanity the same as my right to free, unimpeded inquiry?

It obviously is NOT THE SAME THING. I shall not try to answer this basic dilemma of American society at the present. I shall only open an approach to this legal and factual dilemma. It has a lot to do with the position of the complainant, trying to enjoin the experimental and theoretical functions of Life in its emotional, educational, social, economic, intellectual and medical implications.

. According to natural, and in consequence, American Common

#### BASIC DILEMMA OF SOCIETY

Law, no one, no matter who he is, has the power or legal right a

The study and observation of natural phenomena including Life within and without man;

The communication to others of knowledge of these natural phenomena so rich in the manifestations of an existant, concrete, cosmic Life Energy;

The stir to mate in all livings beings, including our maturing adolescents:

The emergence of abstractions and final mathematical formulae concerning the natural life force in the universe, and the right to their dissemination among one's fellow men;

The handling, use and distribution of instruments of basic research in any field; medical, educational, preventive, physical, biological, and in fields which emerge from such basic activities and which, resting on such principles, must by all means remain free.

Attempts such as branding activities and instruments of such kind as "adulterated," in other words as fraud, only characterizes the narrowness of the horizon of the complainant.

No man-made law ever, no matter whether derived from the past or projected into a distant, unforeseeable future, can or should ever be empowered to claim that it is greater than the Natural Law from which it stems and to which it must inevitably return in the eternal rhythm of creation and decline of all things natural. This is valid, no matter whether we speak in terms such as "God", "Natural Law", "Cosmic Primordial Force", "Ether" or "Cosmic Orgone Energy".

The present critical state of international human affairs requires security and safety from nuisance interferences with efforts toward full, honest, determined clarification of man's relationship to nature within and without himself; in other words, his relationship to the Law of Nature. It is not permissible, either morally, legally or factually to force a natural scientist to expose his scientific results and methods of basic research in court. This point is accentuated in a world crisis where biopathic men hold in their hands power over ruined, destitute multitudes.

To appear in court as a "defendant" in matters of basic natural research would in itself appear, to say the least, extraordinary. It would require disclosure of evidence in support of the position of the discov-

ery of the Life Energy. Such disclosure, however, would invoke untold complications, and possibly national disaster.

Proof of this can be submitted at any time only to a duly authorized personality of the US Government in a high, responsible position.

Scientific matters cannot possibly ever be decided upon in court. They can only be clarified by prolonged, faithful bona fide observations in friendly exchange of opinion, never by litigation. The sole purpose of the complaint is to entangle orgonomic basic research in endless, costly legal procedures a la Panmunjon, which will accomplish exactly NOTHING rational or useful to human society.

Inquiry in the realm of Basic Natural Law is outside the judicial domain, of this, or any other kind of social administration anywhere ON THIS GLOBE, IN ANY LAND, NATION OR REGION.

Man's right to know, to inquire, to make bona fide errors, to investigate human emotions must, by all means, be safe, if the word PREEDOM should ever be more than an empty political slogan.

If painstakingly elaborated and published findings over a period of 30 years could not convince this administration, or will not be able to convince any other social administration of the true nature of the discovery of the Life Energy, no litigation in any court anywhere will ever help to do so.

1, therefore, submit, in the name of truth and justice, that I shall not appear in court as the "defendant" against a plaintiff who by his mere complaint already has shown his ignorance in matters of natural science. I do so at the risk of being, by mistake, fully enjoined in all my activities. Such an injunction would mean practically exactly nothing at all. My discovery of the Life Energy is today widely known nearly all over the globe, in hundreds of institutions, whether acclaimed or cursed. It can no longer be stopped by anyone, no matter what happens to me.

Orgone Energy Accumulators, the "devices" designed to concentrate cosmic Orgone Energy, and thus to make it available to further research in medicine, biology and physics, are being built today in many lands, without my knowledge and consent, and even without any royalty payments.

On the basis of these considerations, I submit that the case against Organomy be taken out of court completely.

## OROP EP

#### INTRODUCTION

The following is an exact copy of the original protocol written by Dr. Eva Reich on order ep of March 22 and 23, 1954. OROP EP was planned, executed and successfully concluded with ensuing rainstorm as predicted and designed immediately after the receipt of the "Decree of Injunction" handed down by Federal Judge Clifford of Portland, Maine, regarding the distribution by the WRF in interstate commerce of the Organe Energy Accumulators. This injunction was the final result of a conspiracy behind the scenes, engineered by Red Fascists in 1947-49, complied with and instigated by drug and cosmetic manufacturers, unknown to us, in collusion with some neurologists and surgeons of the New Jersey Neurological Association, also unknown to us, and executed by individuals posing as bona fide inspectors of the Food and Drug Administration of the U.S. Government. WR refused to be dragged into and humiliated in court by such criminal acts of impertinence and bad faith.

The Organe Institute has denied any authority on matters of Basic Research in general and Organomy in particular to either government, court or established commercial interests since matters of Basic Research are, as the basis of our existence, supreme and cannot be decided upon in court. Also: Established knowledge must have no authority ever to decide what is NEW knowledge if factually, painstakingly presented.

OROP EP was designed to protect the intrusion of our scientific territory by individuals and organizations incompetent in our realm of knowledge; it was a complete success. It did not only prove once more

That Organe Energy does exist, but it surpassed itself. The goal to cause rain in the Eastern USA was over-reached by the rain that fell in consequence of this operation in 45 out of 48 states according to weather reports, including Arizona. The artificially produced vain came after a prolonged drought period and stopped again after two days, succeeded by more drought. This second drought was broken during the week ending April 24 by OROP INFANT.

### OROP EP PROTOCOL

Events 3/22/54—Monday:

- 1. Judge Clifford of Portland, Maine, confirms injunction on 3/19/54.
- 2. Fact of injunction is printed on 3/20/54 in several Maine and one Boston paper. However, Dr. WR and I. O. didn't happen to see writeup. Bill Moise and Eva Reich didn't see it either. News reached Tom Ross via social gossip through Fred Campbell on evening of 3/20/54. He told Dr. WR morning of 3/22/54. Thus the WRF didn't know until everyone else that Judge Clifford had said NO to the truth. At 1 P.M. the Marshall of the U.S. Government arrived carrying the injunction.
- 3. At 3:45 P.M. the following telegram was dispatched:

To Ivan Tannchill, U. S. Weather Bureau, Washington, D. C.

"According to the Federal Food and Drug Administration, Orgone Energy does not exist. We are drawing east to west from Hancock, Maine and Orgonon, Rangeley, Maine, to cause storm to prove that Orgone Energy does exist. Consequences of this action are all your responsibility and that of Federal Judge Clifford of Portland, Maine. We are flooding the East as you are drying out the Southwest. You do not play with serious natural scientific basic research."

From the Wilhelm Reich Foundation.

("You" here means "one"; it does not refer to Mr. Tannehill who was friendly toward our work.)

- 4. This telegram was then telephoned to Mr. Kent (Weatherbee) of WBZ, Boston Radio Station at 5:30 P.M. in order to prevent a central silencing by saying, "We just happened to have a storm."
- 5. At 6:30 P.M. Mr. Tony Shannon of the Bangor Daily News was called and the telegram transmitted verbally with a request that if possible both sides of the happenings should be presented. He was informed of further details: That three cloudbusters were used at Orgonon and one at Hancock, all with all 10 pipes extended 16 feet due east in

order to reduce the eastern energy potential. He asked what we meant by the phrase, "all responsibility is yours and Judge Clifford's." He was answered that it had not previously been tried with such a battery, and we did not know how much of a reaction there would be, especially at equinox time. Also that he would be sent a copy of Dr. Reich's response to the judge.

- 6. At 4 P.M. Bill Moise was called at Hancock, Maine, and asked to draw two or three hours from the east. Summary of draws (all cloudbusters with 10 pipes extended 16 feet):
  - 1 hr. 3:30-4:30 P.M. from east, 3 cloudbusters, Orgonon (not moved).
  - 3 hrs. 4:30-7:30 P.M. from ENE, 1 cloudbuster, Hancock (moved).
  - 3 hrs. 6:30-9:30 P.M. from east, 3 cloudbusters, Orgonon (not moved).
- 7. Weatherbee reports 6:30 P.M., 3/22/54:

The weather is settled, fair ... light snow possible to the north ... The temperature 41°, wind SW, rising. Tomorrow winds freshen, no chance for fog. Tomorrow cloudy to north, sunny in Boston—fair to good weather. The weathermap shows one storm center over Newfoundland and a major storm center in the Central Plains and NW. How bad the weather will be is a question. Possible storm Wednesday (3-24) and Thursday . . . Flood potential; barring major cloudbursts, no floods . . . many rivers no longer frozen . . . spring flood potential slight . . ."

8. Rangeley, Evening 3-22/54: Lumination seen in sky during evening draw: A band along Milky Way (Galactic), bright green northern lights with a motor-like noise and tongue-like sheets streaming in from west (while draw from east was proceeding). Night very clear; wind switched to straight east at 6:30 P.M.

Events 3 23 54—Tuesday:

1. Weather report, 7 A.M. Weatherbee, WBZ, Boston:

"Cloudsheet over NE... Yesterday's forecast an error... Clouds are persisting and may even cause slight snow... only a nucleus type of precipitation tonight. Winds gentle southerly... normal temperatures... tonight cloudiness, scattered showers and snow flurries... tomorrow fair, sunny, higher temperatures... barometer 29.2 and falling... low pressure over Great Lakes area... slight rain over the Southwest dust bowl..."

7:30 A.M.: "The cloud blanket looks worse and will hide the sun, a little snow will fall and may turn into rain . . . this looks and sounds worse

8:30 A.M.: "Forecast was for some high clouds . . . warmer airmass was expected from west . . . Cloudiness has gotten thicker than expected, wetter . . . lower . . . nothing important . . ."

## 2. Actual Weather:

Clouding in from eastern sky morning of 3/23. "Sundog" sighted—unusual, at least two refractive rings seen. Newspaper clipping from Farmington, Maine, reports seven sundogs seen (South Paris?).

3. Second Draw performed by WR 2-3:00 P.M., 2/23 54—Tuesday. Purpose: To induce storm along Galactic Plane.

Draw from north-northeast, zenith: all pipes (10) 16 feet, I cloud-buster. Two cloudbusters at lab point NE all pipes open, 16 feet, not moved, one hour.

Immediate results: 2 P.M., snowflurries over top of Saddleback seen. Clouding in from west, wind SW-W.

Snow starts at Rangeley Region 4 P.M. Intense, but relatively brief local storm with remarkably large snowflakes, about a total of 1 and ½ inches fall until midnight.

Unable to get Boston Radio in evening; get distant places—Tennessee, Vancouver, Cleveland, etc. Marked rapid type of fading of radio sounds.

4. On the Social Scene:

Telegram by WR to Tannehill, U. S. Weather Bureau, Washington, 4:45 P.M.

"Snowstorm in Rangeley Region as predicted in telegram of 3/22/54. You can no longer escape responsibility for desert development in U.S.A. We shall pursue subject of desert development to last detail. Evasion no longer will work. Oranur Weather Control will have to win over forces of Chemistry-evil killing planetary life."

(HOW COME?)

6. The Legal Game:

Eva Reich, M.D., a practicing physician in Maine using the Orgone Energy Accumulator was not affected by present injunction acbefore she proceeds (advice WR; not carried out). Injunction only concerns "Interstate Commerce".

Mr. Richardson writes up his conditions as if he were to be the legal enforcer of decree. (See Conspiracy, Vol. II.)

WR: Points out that again: The truth doesn't count. Richardson meets them more than half way. Richardson has only one function: To see as a counsel that agents stay within decree. Cancels letter, and via telephone on 3/24 AM tells Richardson he will meet agents himself as long as everyone else is ready to sell out, only wants Richardson's counsel. "Yes or no, whether what they are doing at each step is within injunction."

The main problem discussed: How to meet agents:

- A. All accumulator papers moved to Students Laboratory on 3-24.
- B. All press things except files moved to Students Laboratory on 3-24.
- C. Richardson to be present (agreed).
- D. Mr. Collins, Constable (American Legion) to be present (agreed).
- E. Mr. Farrar, State Trooper, to be present (agreed).

1. Weather Report, WBZ, Boston, Weatherbee, 7 A.M.:

"A fine day, sunny, warmer, temperature in the 50s and 60s. Clouds increasing tonight, raw weather and rain tomorrow. Thursday cloudy, rain in afternoon, or snow. High pressure system in western N. Y. . . . Storm center in Idaho . . . low barometer . . . new center . . . Fine weather, a day worth bragging about . . . Frequent rainy spells to be expected in spring."

8 A.M.: "Tomorrow cloudy, rain, colder, near freezing ... Snow in northern Maine to be expected . . . today wonderful day, best weather conditions."

PM: Can't get Boston Radio again.

2. Actual weather, Rangeley:

Clouds and sun. Clouds drifting north-northeast to southeast, mild corresponding breeze. (Therefore coming from area of draw). Clouds dissipate all day long over Orgonon. Strong drought tendency. Moise reports: Airports at Atlanta, Georgia and South Carolina are closed because of poor visibility. Flew north from Washington to Bangor at 5 P.M. on 3/23, observed: 1) Moisture rolling in from ocean along coast in form of a thick blue haze extending about 5000 feet up and as far as one could see from airplanc. 2) To the southwest one could see high cloud-banks moving toward the north.

3. On Social Scene:

A. N. Y. doctors (orgonomists) confer with lawyer, want to do something, are quite helpless, want WR to go to court in order to reopen the case. They missed the point.

B. Burns of U.P. (United Press) calls 4 P.M. Told by WR he doesn't concede authority on matters of Basic Research to either established science or government or court.

1. Weatherbee Report, WBZ, Boston, Weatherbee, 7:30 A.M.:

"Winds were of gale force today from WNW . . . Clear tonight and tomorrow . . . A storm in Texas . . ."

### Note:

It should not be inferred from one per that procedures such as the newspaper publicity and using the Cloudbuster with political undertones is the usual practice of the Orgone Institute. Rather, once per represented the immediate reaction of a natural scientist who, after spending three decades and several hundred thousand dollars following up the discovery of the Life Energy, was rewarded for his efforts with the slap in the face of the unconstitutional and irrational Clifford Injunction. Even then considerable restraint was shown in that at no time was the full power of the Orgone Institute's Cloudbuster-potential used.

### In Summary:

OROP EP was designed to protest the intrusion into our scientific territory by individuals and organizations incompetent in our realm of knowledge. It took place immediately following receipt of the Clifford Injunction and was designed to cause rain over the eastern half of the continent.

On March 22nd three inland cloudbusters and one on the coast drew a total of 15 cloudbuster-hours from the east with all pipes open and fully extended. This was the first time that such a battery of cloudbusters has ever been used. This draw changed the whole weather pattern, and forecast adjustments followed rapidly.

On March 23rd three cloudbusters drew from the northeast for a total of three cloudbuster hours, again with all pipes open and fully extended. The first draw from the east built up the potential to the west and drew moisture in from the ocean. The second draw drew against the Galactic Stream and built up the potential to the southwest.

Snow began to fall two hours after the second draw, but the existing drought tendency was too strong and it took one more day for it to build up. On March 25th rain fell from one end of the continent to the other, raining in 45 out of 48 states—signifying a successful conclusion to OROP EP.

# REPRINT OF A LETTER TO SUBSCRIBERS TO THE LEGAL FUND

Dear Friends,

New names have been added to our mailing list and some of you have not gotten our first letter, which was sent out with a copy of "OROP Desert No. 2" containing the Clifford Injunction and Reich's response to the complaint of the FDA, the complaint that brought on the injunction. To be brief, for those who may not have heard: On March 19th the Wilhelm Reich Foundation was enjoined from the distribution of orgone energy accumulators and of all literature mentioning the words, orgone energy. (The FDA, though it too operates on orgone energy, had decided that orgone energy does not exist.) Reich wisely declined to enter an arena laid out for the purpose of destroying him and his work. To "defend" important discoveries in natural science before a court which was to act as an authority before even having been a pupil was manifestly ridiculous. Legal action was instituted by the orgone therapists. (It should be pointed out that the therapists are not "defending" anything. They are fighting for the legal right to treat the sick, within the trap, with knowledge and devices put at their disposal by the science of orgonomy.)

Most of the legal fund is supplied, at much sacrifice, by the therapists themselves. The Orgone Legal Fund was established to help fill the continually dwindling reserves.

The therapists' legal action has been meeting with the usual obstacles and delays, and some unusual ones, but success seems assured

for the simple reason that the injunction is unconstitutional—as well as nonsensical. Meanwhile, much of the valuable time and energy of Reich and of other good men is being wasted; and a great deal of money, badly needed for life-saving work and research, has either been lost through the stopping of the sale of books and of the distribution of accumulators, etc., or wasted in dealings with irrational officialdom.

While all this crazy trap activity goes on, and in spite of disturbances by various trap functions, Reich has continued working steadfly, tackling problems that concern the future of our planet and has made vitally important new discoveries of the nature of pon, of drought, of desert—the outer desert and the human, inner, emotional desert—and in a new branch of pre-atomic chemistry. CORE (Cosmic Orgone Engineering) has developed apace. The cloudbuster, operated by Reich and assistants, has many times broken drought in the East, most dramatically in August, 1954 all along the Atlantic Scaboard. (A large area around Rangeley. Maine, has been the greenest in the country for some time now.) The cloudbuster has been used successfully to clean the air of the post clouds so inimical to living things, and it is clear that it can favorably alter the world's desert situation. Drought and desert development, as a result of the ever increasing box in our atmosphere. has been going on at an alarmingly accelerated rate, and, unless something is done soon, a catastrophe is in the offing. (Responsible people are deeply concerned about this state of affairs.) Accordingly, Reich is soon going to the southwestern desert of the U.S. to start operations on the removal of DOB and the drawing in towards the desert of moistureladen air by means of the cloudbuster. Since the southwest desert is thousands of years old, and therefore, so to speak, strongly rooted in. the task of changing it back to a fruitful land is by no means assured of success. But the prospects are very good.

We are in the midst of great upheavals, internal and external. In the light of the cosmic revolution now going on, much of our routine social concerns seem pettier and more ridiculous than ever. Our problems are not "how to win friends and influence people", and so forth; our problems are: non distress (which now goes by names like "virus X", "intestinal flu", etc.); the emotional plague; emotional upheavals such as the sufferings and desperate outbreaks among adolescents; the weather upheavals in the form of increased tornadoes, hurricanes, floods, droughts; and desert development—the growing world dust-bowl.

These things can't and won't be ignored much longer. There is a strong influx of the cosmic into the human social mill. One sees a new

seriousness on faces. People are becoming sick of foolishness at political foolishness, of fruitless, meaningless work, of irrational activity in general. At the same time there is confusion, and continued existen, especially on the part of our "authorities", of our real problems. Much of the confusion is a direct physical result of immobilization by now, but there is also a confusion which is the bewilderment of living in a world which tries to turn its back on apocalyptic events and proceed about business as usual.

The world now desperately needs what orgonomy can do for it, especially in the field of cosmic orgone engineering, and it will be coming to Wilhelm Reich for help. Meanwhile, Reich has not been waiting to have a magnum of champagne launch his cloudbuster in an official ceremony. As a responsible inhabitant of a land, and of a world, in a grave emergency situation, he is going ahead and doing what he can to understand and deal with the emergency. (Others will take notice and follow.)

Since the Wilhelm Reich Foundation is not endowed by anyone, but has suffered loss of funds through the injunction, we have undertaken to collect money not only for the legal fund, but also for OROP Desert, that is, for the work of reversing, through cosmic orgone engineering, the calamitous process of desert development. That is the important work, now, of the world.

We hope many of you will want to participate by sending contributions either to OROP Desert, or to the Orgone Legal Fund. The work of OROP Desert is the more essential of the two, for obvious reasons; the desert is a problem compared to which the injunction is merely a nuisance. ## LETTER TO DR. SILVERT

Dear Dr. Silvert:

I must correct several wrong assumptions contained as professed opinions of the judge in Portland and the lawyer representing the physicians who interferred with the injunction:

1. I have never rented out accumulators, and I have never received a

penny for the medical use of on energy.

2. I have never handled any addresses of consumers, except in my research till 1945. I am, therefore, in no position or authority to order any on accumulators back from the users. Those who prescribe are in charge.

3. I have never sold 1000 accumulators as falsely announced by the conspirators and agents of the pharmaceutic industry. Only about 40

accumulators were sold to my knowledge.

4. I have never consented to the injunction. The clerk of the WRF had, on pressure from the lawyer, Mr. Richardson, informed the DA's office that the WRF was preparing for compliance. I have, thereupon, suggested the suspension of the WRF.

5. I have, quite on the contrary, in my response and in a warning denied the FDA any authority whatsoever on matters of basic natural science in general and on energy in particular. The same is true for both court and government. New discoveries require new administrative laws, lest the established interests be invested with power to prevent discoveries from becoming effective.

- 6. I shall refuse any information whatever to agents of the FDA, since they are highly suspect of being agents of hidden business interests and were stirred into action of a mala fide kind by political Moscow modulums.
- 7. The nature of my work with cosmic energy requires absolute discretion and careful dealing with all matters pertaining to Es. No information, whatever, will be forthcoming from me in these matters.

8. I feel that the on accumulator is a matter of medical concern. I neither construct, nor do I distribute accumulators.

9. It is most regretable that the legal procedure in this matter does not avail itself of the amassed evidence of the criminal conspiracy employed in the injunction using slander, lies, distortion and falsification of facts. It is regretable that the procedure is steeped in legalism and evasion of fact. Truthful procedure, as in the case of the literature, has freed its distribution. Legalistic procedure has caused the bogging down of the accumulator question.

I am awaiting the decision of the higher court before preparing to put the total infamy before the broad public.

MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING (Espionage)

Bureau in receipt of telegram dated 6-17-55 from William Moise, Secretary, Weather Control, Orgone Institute, Rangeley, Maine, leads as follows: "Noscow directed conspirators are trying to obtain information in U. S. Weather Control through New Hampshire Food and Drug Administration Inspectors by dragging subversively our New York Weather Operator Michael Silvert MD and Assistant Magravite before Magistrate 9 a.m. today June 17. Operator ordered to withhold any technical data. Can anything be done to stop them."

Bufiles reflect that Orgone Institute a pseudo - scientific laboratory specializing in cancer research at Rangeley, Maine. Our investigation of this organization in 1950 disclosed no activity harmful to security of U. S. Department in 1954 obtained an injunction against Orgone Institute to prevent interstate shipment of so-called orgone energy accumulator devices as a result of an extensive investigatic conducted by Food and Drug Administration. The devices were misbranded under Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act because of false and misleading claims. Officials of Orgone Institute, including Moise, have in past sent baseless complaints to Bureau by telegram and otherwise. Namo 4-1-54 contains approved recommendation that communications from Orgone regarding injunction not be acknowledged. Bufiles contain no identifiable subversive data regarding Moise. Bufiles negative re: Michael Silvert and Lagravite.

It appears from instant telegram that Orgone Institute has violated New Hampshire than Food and Drug Act, and we are being asked to involve ourselves in something which is not within our jurisdiction.
