Reference is made to the report of Special Agent M. DONALD ALDRICH, dated March 13, 1947, at Los Angeles, California, which sets forth an undeveloped lead for the Phoenix Field Division to furnish additional information contained in the files of the Phoenix Field Division in the case of LOUIS Lasteward; BRIBERY; SURPLUS PROPERTY ACT (Bureau file 58-1726), which pertained to SILVERMASTER'S contacts with STEWARD at Phoenix in June, 1946.

LOUIS L. STEWARD, to whom reference is made, was appointed manager of the Phoenix Branch of the War Assets Administration, Los Angeles Region, in May, 1946, and served in this capacity until his resignation, effective August 9, 1946, The Compliance Division of the War Assets Asministration

The facts developed were discussed with the United States Attorney in Phoenix, who declined to institute prosecution and the matter was therefore closed.

In connection with the background of STEMARD, the file reflects that he has been a resident of Phoenix and the state of Arizona practically all of his life. His father is quite well known as a real estate dealer and STEMARD, himself, is a graduate of the Phoenix Union High School, and he also attended the University of Arizona. He was connected with the Arizona Highway Patrol for a short time and was also employed by the Commercial Credit Company in Phoenix. STEWARD, during the war, served with the United States Marine Corps and held a commission in that service. He is presently discharged.

There is no information in the files of the Phoenix office which would indicate that LOUIS L. STEWARD has any subversive connections or that he is a disloyal American citizen. The only derogatory information appearing in the files concerning him is that he appears to have been suspected in numerous cases of "shady" dealings. However, he has never been the defendant in any action involving a crime of moral turpitude.

It will be noted that the report of reference indicates that a reservation was made at the Westward Ho Hotel in Phoenix for NATHAN GREGORY SILVERMASTER in June, 1946, by L. L. STEWARD. It will be recalled that STEWARD at that time was holding the position of manager of the Phoenix Branch of the War Assets Administration and further that SILVERMASTER was also employed by the same federal agency during the same period. It would not appear exceptional, therefore, that STEWARD was contacted by SILVERMASTER or that he had dealings with him during SILVERMASTER'S visit to Phoenix in 1946.

It is further noted, however, that WENDELL WILLIAM WESSNER, who was a constant companion of SILVERMASTER in June, 1946, at Phoenix, and who accompanied him apparently on tours of inspection at various war plants in Phoenix, was not, according to the report of reference, officially employed by the War Assets Administration at that time. It is reflected, however, that WESSNER, according to a 1939 credit report, Retail Merchants Association of Los Angeles, was formerly a repossessor employed by the Commercial Credit Company at Winslow, Arizona, prior to his arrival in Los Angeles in 1938. It is also noted in the report of reference that WESSNER and STEWARD were believed to have carried on a guarded telephone conversation. It is further noted that WESSNER, following his discharge from the Metropolitan Finance Company, was employed by the Lease Transportation Company, in charge of a fleet of trucks on the Lompoc-Santa Maria Defense project at Camp Cook, California.

It is also of interest in this connection to note that LOUIS L. STEMARD is presently the proprietor of the Motor Lease System at Phoenix, Arisona, and that he had connections of a similar nature in Los Angeles or the vicinitial It may be well thought, therefore, that STEMARD and WESSNER were connected in some manner in the lease transportation business.

For the reason that the background information of LOUIS L. STEWARD does not indicate any disloyalty or subversive tendencies, the suggestion is

made that the Bureau may desire to have STEWARD interviewed with the view of developing information concerning WESSNER and SILVERMASTER which would be pertinent to this investigation. However, this action will not be taken by the Phoenix office unless specific instructions to that effect are received from the Bureau. RUC.





Reference is made to my memorandum to you dated April 16, 1947. concerning interviews in this case.

Abraham George Silverman was interviewed by Agents of the New York Office in New York City last night. Silverman was interviewed in his office at Ohrbach's Department Store. He admitted personal friendship with the Silvermasters, Ullman, Adler, Kaplan, Coe, Perlo and Harry White, all subjects. However, he denied transmitting or being approached to furnish or solicit Covernmental information by any of the above persons or any other person. He denied any knowledge or suspicion that any of the above, particularly the Silvermasters, were engaged in espionage for the Communist Party or the Soviet Covernment.

Subject Robert Talbott Filler, III was likewise interviewed by Agents of the New York Office last night. This interview was conducted in the New York Office. Miller denied furnishing anyone any specific data coming to his attention during his employment with the Coordinator of Inter-American Affairs. He denied knowing Jacob Golos, but admitted knowing a woman known to him as "Helen" (Gregory in New York and Washington, but was very evasive as to his relations with her. Filler denied any affiliation with the Communist Party or any activities in connection with Russian espionage.



You will, of course, be kept immediately advised of any additional pertinent information and of the outcome of the interviews with Mildred and Mary Price at Birmingham, Alabama today.

Victor Perlo declined to admit anything and stated that he wanted to see his lawyer before making any admissions. Ullmann, who you will recall is a boarder at the Silvermasters' and who did the photographing at the Silvermaster home, according to Gregory, admitted knowing the names of individuals mentioned to him but stated that he met them through the Silvermasters and that they were merely social contacts. Concerning Gregory, he stated that he knew her as Elizabeth Bentley and that she was a "psychopathic" case.

Subjects Robert Talbott Willer, III and Abraham George Silverman were interviewed by the New York Field Division, but no information concerning the results of those interviews has been obtained. When these results are received, you will immediately be advised.
