In accordance with reference to your letter dated April 5, 1960, regarding the President's request that the Loyalty Review Board review such cases as may have been identified before the Tydings Subcommittee, and in accordance with my letter dated April 10, 1960, the following unverified information concerning Lifantsoff-Lee is contained in the files of this Bureau.

Based upon the testimony of Senator Joseph R. McCarthy, which testimony is set forth in the Congressional Record dated February 20, 1950, the following information appears concerning Paul A. Lifantsoff-Lee:

Paul A. Lifantsoff-Lee, Case No. 56. This individual was born in Russia and naturalized in San Francisco in 1929. His former supervisors on non-government jobs had recommended him unfavorably. The only favorable references he had was from three Russian individuals still in government employment. He roomed with one of the Russians who had recommended him. The Navy Department informed the State Department that this individual had secret State Department documents in the room shared by him and the other Russian. An investigation was instituted, the outcome of which I do not know. However, this individual was still in the State Department as late as December, 1950.

The above information is furnished for your confidential information
and should not be disseminated to any unauthorized agency or individual. This
should not be considered as clearance or disapproval.

No further action is being taken by this Bureau in the absence
of a specific request.
