Donegan

THOMAS J. DONEGAN, recalled as a witness, testified as follows:

BY MR. SAYPOL:

- Q Having examined Mr. Brothman on July 22, 1947, did you have occasion recently to examine him again, particularly on these dates: July 14, 17, and 18, 1950?

 A That's correct; I examined him before the Grand Jury on those dates.
- Q That is before this Grand Jury? A Béfore this Grand Jury.
- Q Was the Abraham Brothman that you examined on the dates I have just mentioned the same Abraham Brothman that was examined on July 22, 1947? A It is the same person.
 - MR. SAYPOL: The jury recalls the testimony that was taken latterly, and I take it it need not be repeated is that correct?

 THE FOREMAN: Yes, that's right.
- Q Mr. Donegan, in connection with the performance of the duties described by you a little while ago, in July, 1947, did you have occasion to present before that Grand Jury one Harry Gold? A I did.
- Q I show you the transcript of the testimony, commencing at page 971 and continuing to page 1001, and ask you whether you have examined it and whether that is an accurate reflection of the testimony which you elicited at that time? A That is so.
