INTERNATIONAL HEADLINES: The CIA-backed invasion of the Bay of Pigs in Cuba is a disastrous failure, strengthening Fidel Castro's ties to the Soviet Union. East Germany erects the Berlin Wall to stop a flood of refugees to the West. The USSR fires a 50-megaton hydrogen bomb, the biggest explosion in history. Amidst deepening Cold War tensions, President Kennedy asks Americans to build nuclear fallout shelters. The U.S. sends its first military companies to South Vietnam.

NATIONAL HEADLINES: The youngest elected president in history, John F. Kennedy, stirs thousands of college students with his creation of the Peace Corps. Shortly after Soviet cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin becomes the first man in space, the U.S. follows with brief flights by Alan Shepard and Virgil Grissom. The civil rights movement mobilizes some 70,000 *freedom riders* to help integrate facilities in the Deep South.

FADS AND FASHION: Yo-yos are the year's biggest-selling toy. *Monstermania* — the popularization of monster model kits and magazines inspired by horror films — reaches its peak.

SPORTS: Roger Maris outpaces Yankee teammate Mickey Mantle to break Babe Ruth's single-season home run record. The Yankees defeat the Cincinnati Reds in the World Series. Vince Lombardi's Green Bay Packers dynasty begins with an NFL title-game victory over the New York Giants.

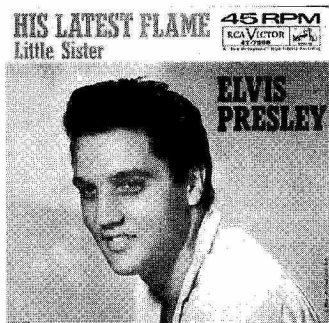
MOVIES: The film version of *West Side Story* earns the Oscar for best picture; Sophia Loren is named best actress for her role in *Two Women*. Audrey Hepburn stars in *Breakfast At Tiffany's*. Other popular movies include *101 Dalmatians*, *Guns Of Navarone*, *The Absent-Minded Professor*, and *El Cid*.

TELEVISION: Federal Communications Commissioner Newton Minow calls commercial television a *vast wasteland*. The golden age of TV Westerns continues, as the three most popular shows are *Wagon Train*, *Bonanza*, and *Gunsmoke*. *Hazel* and *Perry Mason* are other favorites.

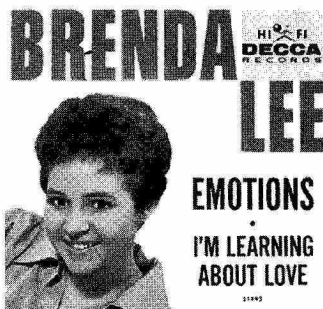
THEATER: Lerner and Loewe's *Camelot* is the year's blockbuster Broadway musical, and becomes the symbol of the Kennedy administration.

BOOKS: Theodore H. White's *The Making Of The President 1960* is a best seller, a Pulitzer Prize winner, and a journalistic trendsetter. *To Kill A Mockingbird*, by Harper Lee, wins the Pulitzer for best fiction. Joseph Heller's *Catch-22* is an instant classic.

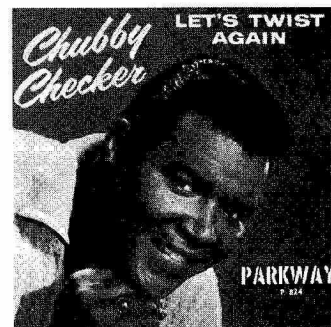
