Selling 'Freedom' helps Julie pay the bills

JULIE Ford is employed in the hotel industry, along with her husband David. They joined the BNP after the European Election. Last September Julie's hours at work were cut because of a fall in bookings and she started to look for a part-time job to make up her income.

"I was going to get some pub work but it was all late hours and it would have meant me struggling to meet my early morning shifts at the hotel." Julie from East Kent, thought she would try selling *Freedom* and has

sent in a report of her progress.

"As I like to talk about politics and especially to correct people's misconceptions about the BNP, I thought I would try selling *Freedom* and see if I could supplement my income that

"I spent three mornings leafleting our estate with the 'If only I could seek asylum' leaflet. If someone was out in their garden I would stop and talk and if they were receptive I asked if they would like Freedom each month.

"I then started actually knocking on doors, putting three hours aside every Tuesday morning and two hours from 6pm to 8pm each Tuesday evening.

"I had eight firm sales from speaking to people leafleting and got another 18 from that first day. After five months I now have a round of 125 which is growing every month. It takes two Tuesdays to service the existing round and I spend the third Tuesday in the month canvassing for new sales. My target is a round of 200 by January 2006.



"I have had just six people drop out, and well over half pay for their paper with a pound coin and tell me to keep the change. I clear over £60 every month tax free and there's no travelling because my sales are all within walking distance.

"I like selling *Freedom* because it feels like I'm doing something to help the BNP. I'm also my own boss and can be flexible when I work and how long I work. It's extra money that Tony Blair doesn't know about and it helps towards paying the bills and keeping our heads above water."

THE 200th anniversary of Lord Nelson's famous victory over the combined French and Spanish fleet at Trafalgar, falls on Friday 21st October.







