Magistrate Judge Marianne B. Bowler: ELECTRONIC ORDER entered granting in part and denying in part [30] Sealed Motion as to Dzhokhar Tsarnaev(1). Upon a written request by the defendant, the BOP shall provide the defendant with his daily activity logs; suicide watch logs; psychology data systems files; photographs; commissary file; and/or the BOP central file to the extent the BOP creates any such record. The request is denied insofar as the defendant seeks to prevent the BOP from providing these files to the government until the defendant's counsel has an opportunity to object and until a court order issues. See 5 U.S.C. § 552a(b)(7). Although the defendant and the government submitted their related filings under seal, this court finds no basis to seal this Order. See generally *In re Boston Herald, Inc.*, 321 F.3d 174, 180-181 (1st Cir. 2003). (Bowler, Marianne)
