Mr. Nakamoto's attorney, Ethan D. Kirschner of the Los Angeles firm Kirschner & Associates, makes the following statement: "If a private citizen like Mr. Nakamoto can be targeted and victimized by a reckless news organization, it could happen to others. Mr. Nakamoto's claim against Newsweek will also remind the journalism community of their continuing legal and ethical responsibilities to the broader public."
