This letter is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, dated August 1, 2014. You have requested copies of the following records and information:

1. [Documents and information] concerning income, profit, revenue and any other financial benefit derived from documents reportedly taken from the National Security Agency by Edward Snowden by institutions and persons who have been publicly identified as having access to the documents [you provided an attachment that lists the specific individuals/groups].
2. [Documents and information concerning] costs and expenses incurred or projected by all U.S. Government departments, agencies, and offices attributable to documents reportedly taken from the National Security Agency by Edward Snowden.

Your request has been processed under the provisions of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552. A search conducted within the Treasury Departmental Offices failed to locate or identify any records that would be responsive to your request.

No fees were incurred in the processing of your request.

Although an adequate search was conducted, you have the right to appeal Treasury's determination that no responsive records exist. Should you choose to do so, you must submit your appeal within 35 days from the date of this letter. Your appeal must be in writing, must be signed by you, and should contain the reason or reasons why you believe an adequate search was not conducted. Your appeal should be addressed to:
