





Search Warrant Return

On January 15, 2014, following the issuance of the search warrant, SA Hannah obtained the cell phones to be searched from the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas Task Force's (HIDTA) Milwaukee Office. The phones obtained were as follows:

1. One (1) black Samsung Model GT-N7000 cellular telephone, serial number RV1C206NN7H
2. One (1) black Motorola Model XT912 cellular telephone, serial number SJUG6476AB
3. One white iPhone Model A1387 cellular telephone, serial number C39GN02QDTDG

Cell Phones #1 and #2 were searched under the authority of a separate search warrant. This warrant was obtained for Cell Phone #3. On February 6, 2014, the DOJ OIG's Cyber Investigations Office's Special Agent Harry Lidsky submitted this phone with a court order to Apple requesting them to unlock the phone. The phone was returned unlocked by Apple on November 25, 2014. SA Lidsky then executed a digital image on the phone a performed a forensic analysis on the image that was completed on December 5, 2014. SA Hannah received the forensic report on approximately January 15, 2015.
