SUBJECT: COMMUNIST ACTIVITIES

TO : Captain Paul PATERNI, SCI-Z

1. A French national, whose real name is, DELHAYE, Eugene Jules, contacted this office on 25 November 1945. Subject claimed that he was sent by Special Agent Tousignant, CIC, Marseille with the message that Subject could be of use to this detachment in Milan.
2. Subject claims that he is a journalist for a French newspaper, as well as an agent for the French "Deuxieme Bureau."
3. He also claims that his interest in wanting to work for this office is purely for monetary compensation.
4. Subject claims to have penetrated the Communist Party in Northern Italy and could be of use to this organization or any other Allied organization.
5. This Agent informed Subject that this office was naturally interested in all political parties and their activities. He informed Subject that if a sample of his work could be given this Agent, this Agent would attempt to evaluate it and refer it to the interested parties who would inform this Agent if they were interested in Subject's work.
6. On 3 December 1945, Subject who had contacted Communist elements in Milan came to this office with the following report, whose translation from French to English is attached: The report reads:

Information on the Italian Communist Party

Constantino SEPTINO, editor of the "Milano Sera" tells me (communist opinions):

and

Sergio DALLA PASQUA, via Fiori Chiari, 18, accompanied by a propagandist and by two communist followers were telling me:

"The majority of the people understand nothing of the actual Italian political situation."

"Fascism is certainly not dead, particularly in the South."

"Revolution will break out in the middle of winter when the people are hungry and cold."

"The Allies, particularly the Americans have contributed to

make the situation more complex by supporting the dishonest groups."

"Most Italian newspapers do their utmost to disgust public opinion while establishing in a disguised manner a parallel between this actual period and the Mussolini era."

"The popular party (communist) of the country is acting already and shall act in a bloody manner against the forces of Fascism."

"The revolution will be bloody."

"It is certain that the communist forces have their spies who are well placed in Allied agencies particularly in Rome and Milan."

"The communists are clearly against the Allies."

"The communists are powerfully armed."

"They should not misunderstand our inactivity for weakness."

"We are waiting for the war between America and the Soviet Union, it is besides the opinion of the people."

"It is in Milan and Turin that the revolutionary movement will break out."
