ORGANIZATION AND COMPOSITION OF THE ROAD-BLOCK AT "PAS DE PARADIS"

A MIXED POSTE, FRENCH AND ITALIAN, WILL BE PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHED, 24 HR. DUTY, AT THE "PAS DE PARADIS" AS OF SATURDAY, 5 MAY AT 0900 HOURS.

IT IS MADE UP OF;

- A) A SECTION OF THE 159 R.I.A., FURNISHED BY THE 9TH COMPANY.
- B) A DETACHMENT OF PARTIANS (ITALIAN) FURNISHED BY THE ITALIAN COMMAND OF SUSA

THE MEMBERS OF THE POST IS PLACED UNDER THE ORDERS OF 2ND LT. (INSPECTOR) RATIVAL FROM THE SM, AND IT WILL OPERATE UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE CAPTAIN IN CHARGE OF THE SM.

THE FRENCH UNIT MUST PROVIDE A PERMANENT GUARD COMPOSED OF A NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICER AND THREE ENLISTED MEN.

MISSION OF THE POST

1. TO PREVENT AND CLOSE OFF ACCESS TO THE PLATEAU OF MT. GENIS ALL ITALIANS ARRESTED OR STOPPED SHALL BE TURNED OVER TO THE PARTISAN OFFICER IN CHARGE.
2. TO SCREEN AND DIRECT ALL FRENCH ELEMENTS IN ITALY WHO ARE ATTEMPTING TO REGAIN FRENCH TERRITORY.
3. CONTROL AND VERIFY ALL TRAFFIC;

A- IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED OF MILITARY PERSONNEL

1. GENERAL OFFICERS (AUTOS HAVING STANDARDS) ARE NOT STOPPED

2. COMMISSIONED OFFICERS; IDENTITY CARD

3. NON-COM AND SOLDIERS; ORDRE DE MISSION

B- CIVILIANS- IN PRINCIPLE CIVILIANS MUST BE TURNED BACK IF THEY DO NOT CARRY A LAISSEZ-PASSER GIVEN MILITARY AUTHORITY. (SM)

OTHER DISPOSITIONS- THE INSPECTOR OF THE SM, HIS SECRETARY AND HIS CHAUFFEUR SHALL BE TAKEN CARE OF BY THE 9TH CO. OF THE 109TH R.I.

NOTE; THESE MEN WERE ARRESTED BY FRENCH GUARDS WHILE ATTEMPTING
TO CROSS THE FRONTIER. C C WAS NOT INFORMED OF THEIR APPRE-
HENSION UNTILL THEY HAD BEEN TRANSPORTED BY FRENCH MILI-
TARY VEHICLES ACROSS THE FRONTIER INTO FRANCE WHERE THEY
WILL BE TRIED BY FRENCH COURTS. THE FRENCH MILITIAN, FAYRO IS
AN ITALIAN SUBJECT BUT THE FRENCH WILL TRY HIM FOR DE-
NOUNCING FRENCH PATRIOTS TO THE MUSSOLINI GOVT. AND TO THE
GERMAN GESTAPO.
