SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Yugoslav Army-Activity in Fiume Area.

From a confidential Yugoslav source, usually reliable, the following information on Subject was submitted to this office:

1. Once more it is reported that Russian military technicians in Yugoslav Army uniform are operating in the V.G. The report states that there are about 2,500 Russian military personnel in the area.
2. Since the Yugoslav border was moved to Cantrida, increased troop movements (especially infantry) have been noticed. Many hotels in Fiume have been requisitioned. Intelligence officers were inquiring among the population the strength and position of Anglo-American troops in the VG.
3. It is again reported that the young men (20 to 27 years old) mobilized in late November 1946 in the Istria region and the Slovene coast (Slovenko Primorje) have been sent to the Kreek borders.
4. Recruiting propaganda is continuing in Fiume for volunteers for Spain.
5. Yugoslav Army Military mail number in TUZLA has been reported as being 92593.
