SUBJECT: Sergeant Dernand D'ALBY.

TO : BSM, Rome, Palais Vidoni, CMMFI, Corso Vittorio Emanuele.

1. Subject above was stopped by the British on 25 July 1946 and turned over to the Italian authorities who in turn consigned Subject to our Verona office.
2. Reason for arrest is an accusation that Subject in company of a certain Lt. PELDIT (an alleged French Officer?) stole 20.000 liras from Luigia Florinda PADANELLI and Pierina CODA on the morning of 24 July 1946.
3. Subject after being held in the Verona jail was sent to this Office on 7 August 1946.
4. During interrogation Subject claimed innocence to the above charge, stating that he was sent by his Bari office (BSM) to accompany Lt. PELDIT back to Bari.
5. This office called ex-Capt. LUISETTI (Formerly chief BSM, Milan) to identify Subject. Capt. LUISETTI, after speaking to Subject, and after inspecting Subject's "Ordre de Mission" advised this Office to turn over Subject to your office.
6. Capt. LUISETTI also claimed that Subject's "Ordre de Mission" is false.
7. Subject in the evening of same day escaped custody but was recaptured on the evening of 8 Aug. 1946.
8. During the second interrogation Subject still maintained his innocence but could not account for his attempted escape.
9. This office believes that Subject is a deserter from the French Army, using his "Ordre de Mission" for personal purposes and robbery as the affair stated in paragraph # 2.
10. Subject is being sent to your headquarters for disposition. It would be appreciated if this office be advised of Subject's real status, and who Lt. PELDIT is, if there is such an officer in the services of the 2eme Bureau.
