SUBJECT: CASSUL, Pierre, alias LUSSAC, Pierre, alias Mr. PETER

TO : AC of S, G-2, AFHQ, APO 512, U.S. Army

1. Reference your GBI. 389.704/1, Subject; Enemy Agents, dated 21 Nov. 1945, Subject above who apperas on the list as No. 1342, was arrested by this Agent on 18 August 1945.

2. Subject at the time was arrested for posing as a CIC agent in Milan and Turin. Subject's apartment was searched by this Agent and Special Agent MUSENGO and found to contain besides other stolen items, cloth illegally requisitioned while using the false cover of being a CIC agent or CID agent.

3. Further investigation by this agent revealed that Subject worked for the GIS and SD d'Orleans (organization composed of agents of French nationality working for the Germans).

4. Subject was confined in San Vittore jail in Milan while GSI(b) No. 2 District was informed and requested to dispose of Subject.

5. GSI(b) authorized this officer to turn Subject over to the French "Bureau de Securite Militaire" for disposition since the latter organization was interested in Subject., and Subject did not appear on GIS list.

6. Subject was turned over to BSM on 2 October 1945, and was consequently transferred to Nice, France on 19 October 1945 for trial as collaborationist, traitor, and an agent of the GIS.

7. No trace of alleged wife appering on same wanted list has been found.
