Memorandum for the Officer in Charge:

SUBJECT: Rumors of Uprising.

RE : PCI and PSI.

- 1. Information from confidential sources discloses a renewal of rumors of an uprising by the Communist and Socialist parties.
- 2. Unconfirmed and not too reliable information states that in the case of a defeat in the June elections, the Communists and Socialists are ready to assume government control by use of force.
- 3. Combat squads of fanatic elements will effect acts of reprisal against:
 - a. Fascists who evaded epuration.
- officers. b. Better known monerchist elements, especially
- c. CCRR and RCF officers and functionaries of the PS who shall be abducted from their own homes now under surveillance.
 - d. Personalities of the opposing parties.
- 4. The military leaders of the movement are alledged to be:
 - a. LONGO, Luigi.
 - b. MOSCATELLI.
 - C. BARONTINI, Elio.
 - d. BCLDRINI @ "BULOW" (FNU).
 - e. "AMMAZZALOSSO" (NU).
- 5. Another rumor states that all military officers, both Italian and Allied, are kept under constant surveillance for speedy elimination with the advent of a revolution.
