## MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE.

SUBJECT: Polish Consular Personnel in Milan.

Re : Investigation.

Pursuant to instructions from Supervising Agent, CIC, Milan, Zone 3, based on request by SCI/z, Milan, to investigate Subject, this Agent has compiled the following information obtained from various confidential sources including Pelish 2 Corps Lisison Officers:

- 1. On December 3, 1945, the first group of Polish (Warsaw Government) Consular Personnel, arrived in Milan and took ledgings in an apertment at Via San Michele del Carso (new renamed Via Greppi), #4. They were escerted in Milan by KOLTONSKI, Alexander of the Polish (Warsaw) Embassy in Rome. According to information, 15.000.000 (?) lire were paid to the ewner of the rented apartment. The group was composed of:
  - a. ENDER, Edward b. 18 August 1904 Consul General b. SEIFRIED, Kamil b. 21 June 1908 Vice Consul

  - c. DEBOWSKI, Czeslaw 23 June d. SZPONORSKI, Jan 23 Decem. 1903

  - e. DEBOWSKA, Janina 2 August 1908 f. SABATOWA, Danuta 8 February 1908 g. RACZKOWSA, Maria 16 July 1907
  - h. RIABIS. Natalia 25 July 1909
- 2. Since this original group arrived, several changes have been made. During the early months of 1946 a certain BANDURA, Alexander, born 21 March 1895 in Kunyarya, son of a Jan and Helena CRISSA, Ukrainian Poles, arrived in Milan. BANDURA has been signalled as an NKVD - (MGB) Agent with a mission to cellect Intelligence information as well as to provide Consular Security. He is rumered to be a personal friend of President BIERUT of the Warsaw Government. He came to Italy from Sweden. Polish 2nd Corps consider him as a dangerous propagandist, working against 2nd Corps and the British. In May 1946, a/n spent some time in Venice, where it is rumered

that he was arrested and later released. The concirge of the boarding house at #2, Corse Vercelli, where he had lodgings, informed cellaborators of this Office that BANDURA left Milan for Peland. Pelish 2nd Cerps Officers believe that he had a mission to England with instructions to conduct agitation work against the Peles located in the U.K. and to carry on general intelligence activity. It is also reported that while in Milan, BADURA WAS IN GOOD terms with the Seviet Military Mission and the Seviet Censulate in Milan. He is also reported to be in pessession of a Seviet Identity Card. It has been also reported that he had paid informants who also werk for the Seviet Military Mission.

- 3. ENDER, Edward, has not been seen very much in Milan. He does not do much work for the Consulate. His main mission is scientific research and reporting.
- 4. SEIFRIED, Kamil, is in charge of the Pelish Repatriation Camps in Italy. He was seen taking pictures of Pelish II Corps troops during a parade in Milan several menths age.
- 5. DEBOWSKI, Czeslaw alias KWIATOWSKI serves as an informant and active prepagandist among Pelish treeps. He is an habitual drunkard and is a criminal type capable of anything.
- 6. RAWICZ-JARUCKI, Rafal, b. 4 July 1907 sen of Edward and Lidja DOMBECICA, serves as informant and deerman at the Consulate. He is a deserter of the II Corps.
- 7. RIABIS, Natalia, singer, Via Gievanni BATTESINI # 16, Milan, is attempting to leave for America and desert her post. Fears that she will be discovered and returned to Poland.
- 8. SABATOWA, Damita, was on good terms withthe Vice Consul SEIFRIED until May 1946, at which time, after a quarrel with above ever the disappearance of 10.000 lire from the cash funds was recalled to Poland. It is rumered however that she may return.
- 9. DUBIENSKI, Josef, b. 1886, son of Adolf and Anna BLAU is seen in Milan. Lived with BANDURA at #2 Corso Vercelli. Wears American type Officer's Uniform with insignia of Polish 2nd Lt. (Warsaw). Probably the brother of MARCOVALDI, Adalgisa, living at Rapalle, Liguria. Latter was collaborator of the Germans. During the war she was trafficking in jewels taken from Jewish families in Germany, which she carried to Italy. She was on intimate terms with the Germans at Genea and is rumered to have once been a mistress of FRANK, convicted war criminal of Nuernberg. It is rumered that DUBIENSKI's activity is directed against Polish II Corps soldiers in Italy. He was official guide for the Polish Commercial Mission to the Polish Warsaw Government in Italy in August 1946.
