SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Yugoslav Activities.

The following information on Yugoslav activity in Belgium has been received from a confidential informant considered fairly reliable:

A. Croatian.-

1. A Croatian association "The Croatian Farmers", has been formed in Belgium with about 100 members. Sections are located at Liege and Eysden-Meries. There is no section at Bruxelles. The organization is both anti-Tito and anti-Monarchist.

B. Communist.

1. The Association "FREE YUGOSLAVIA" has been formed in Brussels with main offices at 118, Rue Theodore Verhaegen. The Board of Directors includes:

2. The purpose of the Association is " All kinds of activity directly or indirectly connected with the Union of Yugoslav citizens living in Belgium, with reciprocal aid purposes, without distinction of race, religion or political opinion, further development of their national culture, with documentary evidence on all questions of interest. The Association, which is a completely independent one, will not take part in the political life of Belgium."

3. Actually, this organization is identified as pro-"TITO" propagandistic unit. Spiro PLAVSIC, who is the President and in whose apartment meetings are held (118, Rue Verhaegen, Bruxelles, St. Gilles), recently made a 15 day trip to Yugoslavia
