SUBJECT: Secret Field Police

TO : GSI (b), 2 District

1. The enclosed letter is a denunciation sent to this office by Dr. CORBELLINI.

2. It would be appreciated if this office is informed if any of the subjects mentioned have been arrested. It may be that they have been successful in evading capture as Feld Polizei by posing as POW's. It is also believed that STAMMER, Roberto and BURGER, Hans escaped and are residing in the Bolzano province. BURGER is from Bolzano and speaks Italian.

3. This information has been relayed to CIC Bolzano province.

4. Enclosed are letter and photographs identifying several of Subjects.

Gentlemen:

Some time during the early part of June 1945 I presented a letter to Captain LONMON "del Comando Alleato" of VOGHERA (PAVIA) stating that a search of my house was made by the German Secret Police, following a denunciation by a group of Fascists. Since I have received no answer to this letter, I want you to intervene in order to locate the German Agents who organized the search and thus find out who denounced me as leader of a partisan band operating in the zone of VOGHERA and TORTONA.

During the course of my anti-fascist activities in the Spring of 1943, I had to leave Milan. I moved to a suburb of S. Gaudenzio di Cervesina (PAVIA) WHERE after 8 September 1943 I engaged actively in partisan work. I believe that the Fascists of Cervesina denounced me to the Secret Police whose headquarters were at NOVI LIGURE.

On 30 October 1944 my house was surrounded by Military of the "Brigata Nera" of VOGHERA. A group of German Agents entered the house and proceeded to carry away documents, money and other items of value. They then destroyed all my furniture. Fortunately only my servant was arrested. I was lucky enough to be able to escape.

The damage amounted to nine million lire. The Germans are certainly in some concentration camp. If I could locate them, I would be able to find out who denounced me. I suspect an Italian person. If it is that person who denounced me, I would like to be reimbursed for the amount of the damage.

The Secret Police of NOVI LIGURE depended upon the "Comando Generale" with headquarters at the Hotel, Regina, Milan. The organization was composed of the following men:

Marescialle STAHRER, Roberto - Commander. Has fair knowledge of Italian. Was in possession of false identity card issued at Trieste.

Marescialle WINKLER, Ernest - Second in command, a brutal person.

Sergeant BURGER, Hans - Native of Bolzano, speaks Italian.

Gefreiter MULLER, Joseph

Sergeant GLEIER - no other identity.

Corporal KNOPF - " " " "

MIETE - Interpreter.

EMSTREIT, VOGEL TZANE - Drivers.

My money, which had been deposited in the Bank of Milano, was confiscated by SCHMITH, an officer UHPBP of the "Commissariato Germanico", Via Mascheroni, Milan, Feldpost 58027.

Attached are photographs found among the papers in Villa Levantinal, Novi Ligure which was the headquarters of the Secret Police.

Information reveals that the above named Germans were taken prisoner in the vicinity of Milan. Some say that STAHER and BURGER escaped dressed in civilian clothes. Among the photographs which I gave to Captain LONMON of Voghera were some of STAHER and BURGER dressed in civilian clothes. I believe that said photographs were given to the "Comando Inglese" of Pavia.
