SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Newspaper circulation in Milan for August, 1946.

1. Ita has been noted that the number of copies printed by the main newspapers in Milan has been decreasing during the last month.

2. The average number of copie printed by these newspapers is the following:

a) Corriere della Sera morning ed.	350.000
b) Corriere d'informazione afternoon ed.	400.000
c) Unita'	150.000
d) Avanti	130.000
e) Il Popolo	65.000
f) Tempo	45.000
g) Lombardo Corriere morning ed.	45.000
h) Lombardo Sera afternoon ed.	140.000
i) Mattino d'Italia	23.000
j) Italia	28.000
k) Milano Sera	120.000

3. Top production of the Lombardo Sera, mentioned in par. 2, sub-par.h, has been 240.000 copies.

4. The daily "Buonsenso" is in critical conditions. It sells about 12.000 to 15.000 copies and it is the official organ of the "Uomo Qualunque" Party.
