SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT : Yugoslav Commercial Activity.

The following information is based on previous reports and other new material given to these Agents by confidential informants. Evaluation is A-1.

1. The semi- clandestine exportation of technical materiel from Italy to Jugoslavia is continuing. The following articles are usually channeled to Jugoslavia:

- a) Telephone Systems
- b) Telephone accessories
- c) Cables
- d) Inductors
- e) Other electrical materiel

2. This materiel is mainly provided by three Italian Companies, namely:

- a) S/A Allocchio & Bacchini, Milan
- b) S/A Siemens per Elettrocita', Milan
- c) O.L.A.P.(a sub-office of the Siemens), Milan.

3. The main buying Agencies are the following:

- a) "TEPRO", Milan
- b) "INTRACO", Milan

4. "Tepro" and "Intraco" usually send this materiel by truck to Zone "A" (almost always Trieste). Two Yugoslav Companies receive this materiel in Trieste. They are the "Centroprom" and the "Uivod". These Companies have been granted an import-export monopoly between Zone "A" and Zone "B". From Zone "B" this materiel is easily shipped to Jugoslavia.

5. The price of the purchased goods increases 1000%

between the selling Agencies in Milan and Jugoslavia. The difference is cashed by the two companies in Trieste, that, according to informant, turn it over to OZNA.

6. These funds are subsequently used by OZNA for Intelligence purposes in "A" Zone.
