This Agent was informed by the "Gendarmerie Bationale" that the above numed Subjects had been captured at Douar Guled Houses, near Soul al arba an the night of 6 May 1044.

1. PERRONS, Giovanni, Italian primoner of war No. 52220, born is July 1915 at Reggia Calabria, Italy. Subject is interned at Comp 25 at Easta Tadle.

2. DI GIONGIO, Salvatore, Italian prisoner of war No. 50009, born 1 August 1968 at Brindisi, Italy. Subject is interned at Camp No. 25 at Masha Jadla.

According to both Subjects, they were sent from Easta Tadla to work on the form of M.Brignon morth of Fort Lyautey. Here they worked for a few days under terrible and unbourable conditions. Subjects claimed that they could no longer stand the orgal trestment received at the hands of 2. Brignon and his brother and asked to be sent back to Kasba Tadla. Open refusal they reused to work and sere-placed in solitary confinement on bread and water. On the night of 5 May 1944 they offected their escape and began calking morth towards Souk of Arba. On the night of 6 May 1944 they were discovered by Si Sayob ben Abdalleh bas 2 . Arab farmer on his property. They offered no resistance while be supposed the Genderserie. Subjects denied that they were attempting to reach the Spanish border because "this shald not change the situation any." Both Subjects were returned to Camp No. 25 under guard.

This Agent was informed by the "Gendarmerie Nationale" that the above named Subjects had been captured at Douar Ouled Moussa, near Souk el Arba on the night of 6 May 1944.

1. PERRONE. Giovanni, Italian prisoner of war No. 51350, born in July 1912 at Reggia Calabria, Italy. Subject is interned at Camp 25 at Kasba Tadla.

2. DI GIORGIO, Salvatore. Italian prisoner of war No. 52399, born 1 August 1922 at Brindisi, Italy. Subject is interned at Camp No. 25 at Kasba Tadla.

According to both Subjects, they were sent from Kasba Tadla to work on the farm of M. Brignon north of Port Lyautey. Here they worked for a few days under terrible and unbearable conditions. Subjects claimed that they could no longer stand the cruel treatment received at the hands of M. Brignon and his brother and asked to sent back to Kasba Tadla. Upon refusal they refused to work and were placed in solitary confinement on bread and water. On the night of 5 May 1944 they effected their escape and began walking north towards Souk el Arba. On the night of 6 May 1944 they were discovered by SI Tayeh ben Abdallah ben X, Arab farmer on his property. They offered no resistance while he summoned the Gendarmerie. Subjects denied that they were attempting to reach the Spanish border because "this would not change the situation any."

Both Subjects were returned to Camp No. 25 under guard.

AGENT'S NOTES:

It is suggested that spot check examination of travellers be carried out by the police to prevent similar occurrences of the above. It seems strange indeed how anyone dressed in a prisoner of war uniform could possibly circulate unoticed in broad daylight.
