- 9:25 Left John Doe Madison and Wabash and walked South on Wabash to Adams got on Wabash Street Car to 9th St. got off at 9th St. and walked to the Stevens Hotel
- 9:30 Entered Stevens Hotel got a Western Union Money Order Blank and wrote a message
- 9:48 Went to the Drug store of Stevens Hotel and Purchased a magazine
- 9:55 Left drug store walked south on Michigan Ave. to Van Buren Station. Purchased a slug made a call to Sherman Hotel and asked for a Mr. Zanzuccki
- 10:14 Left Van Buren Station walked up Michigan (South) and entered the Will Play House. The Lad From Our Town was on the screen at the time.
