
- Country Ambassadors are local organisations promoting craftsmanship. They are members of the Foundation's network

#### **HOW CAN AN ARTISAN PARTICIPATE?**


#### Criteria

- ✓ The artisan must be based in Europe
- ✓ They must create and produce their own pieces
- ✓ Their workshop must be accessible to the public (even if only by appointment) or their work should be on show in galleries



- ✓ They display handcrafted objects (permanent collection, temporary exhibition, etc.)
