


STAIRCASE WINDOW AT Nº 9 KENSINGTON PALACE GARDENS W




Schloss Primkenau, Plans, KGL. GEH. HOF-BAURATH ERNST IHNE, Architect to the German Emperor, Berlin.



As Old as the Pyramids.

PROBABLY the most important point in the construction of a typewriter is the type har itself. In this point most machines fail when put to the test. Many of them have a long single bar of several pieces with the type at the end. Such a bar is uncertain and wobbling in its action, and must strike through a guide of some sort to preserve the alignment of the letters. Furthermore, the type, if struck accidentally against each other, are quite easily thrown off their feet and make a faulty impression. The construction of the OLIVER type-bar is radically different and far superior mechanically, although the principles involved are as "old as the hills." The pyramidical or triangular form of construction (the strongest known) is used. The bar is double and the wide base of the triangle forms a bearing upon which the bar turns.
