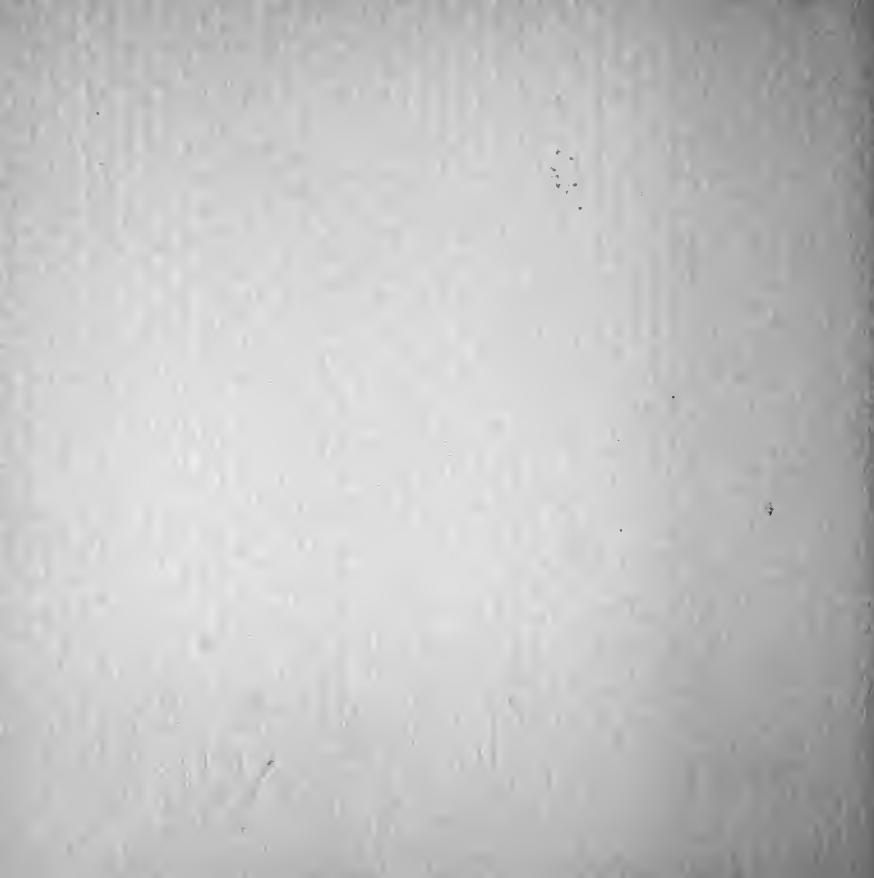

While gentle hearts are won.

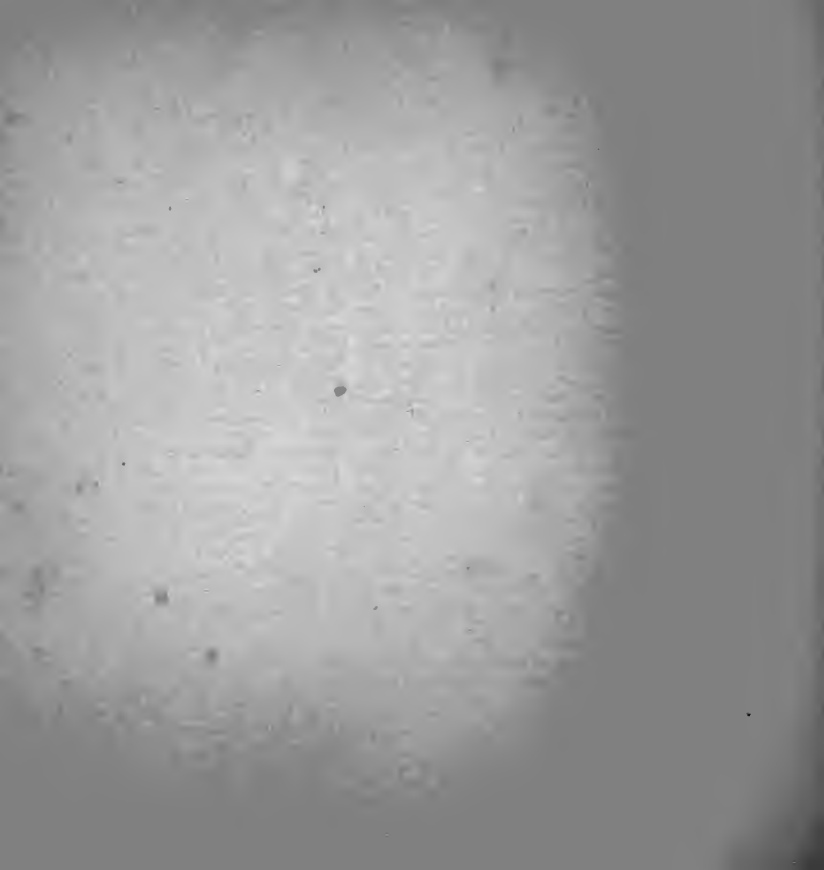

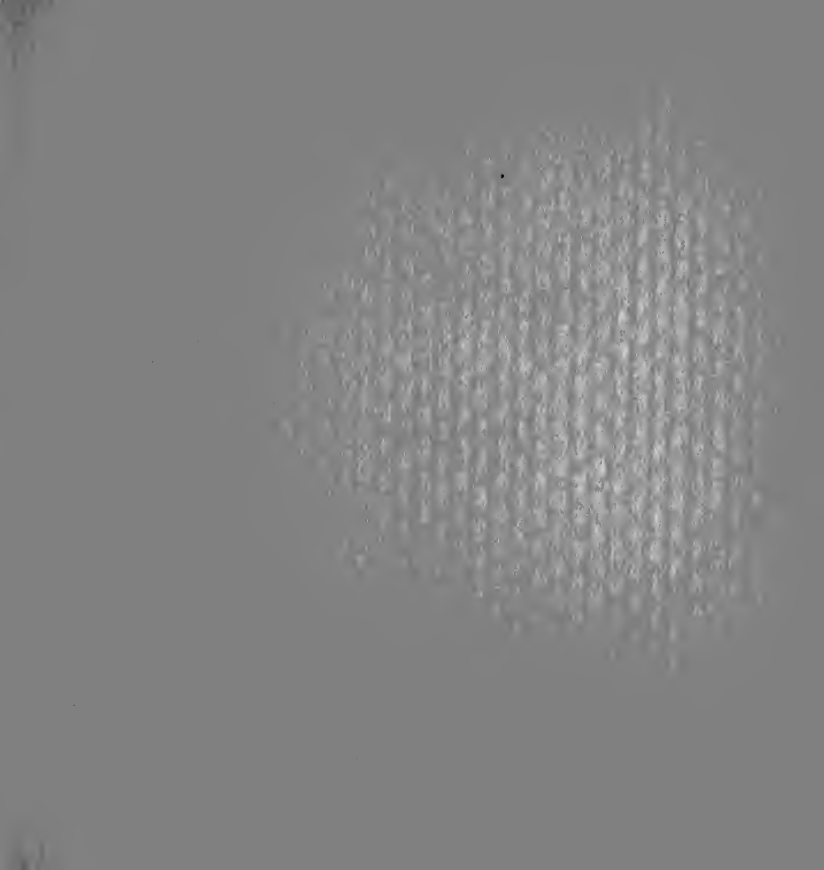
