PERSPICACITY

UPON REFLECTION, ASKIT issues and serves this perspicuous decision, finding the above individuals in default, after having been charged pursuant to UNDRIP Articles 27, 34 and 40, and the time of 15 days having elapsed.

The Charges

The Respondents listed above are charged with the task of changing Paragraph 82 of the Affidavit of the Director General of the Biologic and Radiopharmaceutical Drugs Directorate within Health Canada which states:

"The terms and conditions may be amended at any time. Furthermore, this authorization may be revoked if new information does not support the safe and effective use of the product."

based on the evidence submitted to you by ASMIN member Dr. Julian Northey.

The Respondents failed to do so within 15 days of receipt of this emailed Notice, so the result is a Judgment by Default including but not limited to:

- 1. Violation of UNDRIP;
- Violation of British Imperial Policy by enforcing mandates on an Un-Conquered, Un-surrendered People, with whom neither ONTARIO, nor CANADA have a Treaty;
- Trespassing, where the Respondents bear the Burden of Proof that they have a prior, superior Title to the Land of Turtle Island on which CANADA rests;
- 4. Cultural Genocide.

The above named Respondents, again having failed to appear, are found to have contravened all of the above charges, by Default.

Fines

The fine to be collected by Commercial Lien or Litigation in Ontario Courts,

which must now comport with Indigenous Laws, per UNDRIP as ratified by

Canada via Bill C -15, is \$50,000 for each woman or man in the above list,

individually.

Further, each Respondent is to be removed from their official Posts, and their

decisions are null and void, effective forthwith.

Further Fines

Each next attempt to violate this Order will result in an additional fine of \$50,000
